Yesterday I had a private meeting with Dr. Joseph Lovinger, a president of the Central Board of Jewish Communities in Greece. AJC has had contact with him for a long time and whenever he is in the States, we arrange to meet. I had hoped to set up a separate meeting so that you would be able to meet him but, unfortunately, he is returning home Saturday evening.

In general, the situation of the Jewish community in Greece is much improved, primarily due to what Lovinger describes as a "180 degree turn" by Papandreou. This was especially apparent when he met with Edgar Bronfman several months ago. Furthermore, relations between the Jewish community leadership and Papandreou are friendly despite the fact that the overwhelming majority of the Jewish community opposed Papandreou in the elections. Lovinger feels that behind this change lies (1) the need for U.S. economic assistance; (2) the hope for U.S. political influence in the Greek-Turkish situation vis-a-vis Cyprus; (3) disappointment with Arab investment, etc., which supposedly should have been forthcoming given Greece's aggressive pro-Arab, pro-Arafat, anti-Israel stance.

Nevertheless, in addition to considering itself a bridge country between the East and the West*, it also considers itself a bridge country between Europe and the Arabs. Greece still considers itself a bridge country between Europe and the Arabs, and while the prospects of exchanging diplomatic relations with Israel are improved, the official policy will remain in favor of a Palestinian state on the West Bank and the Gaza Strip.

There is one other political reality that influences Papandreou's policy and style and that is the strong push he gets from the Communist Party in Greece.

There are in fact three factions in that party -- Moscow-oriented; Trotskyites; Euro-communists. There are also the Anarchists. The Moscow-oriented faction is the strongest and their newspaper slavishly follows the Moscow line. On several occasions there have been charges from these communist elements that Papandreou is really a CIA agent, saying all the right things but doing what the U.S. wants him to do.

*The Greek Government's co-signing with Romania of an appeal to end the deployment of missiles in Europe.

As to anti-Semitism, the media continues to be a major concern... numerous anti-Semitic references in the Greek Orthodox papers, and anti-Israel and anti-Zionist references that spill over into anti-Semitism in the left wing media. Also, from time to time a government official will make an anti-Semitic statement. On such occasions the Jewish community representatives express their concern, meetings are arranged and they usually end amicably. However, the period during the Israel incursion into Lebanon evoked some very shocking incidents and they remain in the consciousness of the Jewish community. It is interesting to note that notwithstanding the very troubling period there were almost no Jews who left Greece. Lovinger feels that Greek Jews are used to anti-Semitic events, and unless they are of a serious nature, discount them.

I inquired again as to the dates of the special commemoration ceremony. It will take place April 29th and they would be very happy to have us attend. In fact, Dr. Lovinger said visits by the AJC, if they are official, are helpful to the community.

He also told me that until recently there were very few intermarriages, primarily because marriages were performed only in the churches and synagogues. Since Papandreu came to power, that has changed and "justice-of-the-peace" type marriages are now available. This has indeed resulted in a small increase in intermarriage. On the other hand, in terms of Jewish education, because of their proximity to Israel, many of their youngsters spend time in Israel studying and a number of them working on kibbutzim as well.

In sum, the Jewish community is prosperous, it feels secure, and is generally optimistic about the future.

I just finished another conversation with Stanley Sheinbaum, a member of our Board in Los Angeles, regarding the position of the government of Greece on the Middle East and the status of Jews within Greece. I had indicated to you earlier that Sheinbaum is a friend of Prime Minister Papandreu and went to visit him after the Prime Minister met with Arafat.

Subsequently, Sheinbaum arranged for Efron to interview Papandreu and understands the meeting went well. A short time later, Mrs. Papandreu came to New York and asked Stanley to arrange a meeting with Jewish women there. He contacted friends in New York and I gather that you know of the results of the meeting and the subsequent easing of pressures on the Jews of Greece.

I suggested to Stanley that he ought to have a direct conversation with you and, or, Rita Hauser to explain his understanding of this situation because it loses something in translation. I would suggest you telephone him the week of Monday, November 22nd -- he is expecting your call. His telephone number is (213)472-9541.

My thought is that Sheinbaum can be a good intermediary for us should we desire to have future contacts with Greek leaders. This might be especially important in modifying the position of Greece with respect to Israel and the PLO. I gather that Papandreu sees himself as a possible connecting link between them, even though that seems highly unrealistic at this point.

Let me know what happens.

AJC PROGRAM NOTES

February 1983

The AJC Domestic Affairs Commission will be meeting in Washington, D.C. on March 22-23. Among the items on the agenda are Social Security, national service and employment and jobs creation.

The Domestic Affairs Department is proceeding with the initial phase of their "Jews on the Edge" program, which will explore the status of poor and vulnerable Jews in the light of cuts in social programs in order to develop social policy recommendations that reflect a knowledgeable "Jewish point of view."

AJC's New York Chapter will be hosting a conference on Social Security on March 2nd for its membership. The audience will be addressed by three authorities on Social Security, whose aim will be to help them better define and understand all facets of this complicated issue.

AJC was the co-sponsor of the recent successful "Seminarians' Conference on Jewish-Christian Relations," held in Dallas in January. This meeting brought together young seminarians from the Roman Catholic, mainline Protestant, Evangelical, Pentecostal and Jewish communities for the first time and resulted in a meaningful exchange of ideas. This session will serve as a model for future conferences in other regions of the country.

On January 25th AJC hosted a press conference to announce the publication of *ISRAEL FOR CHRISTIANS: UNDERSTANDING MODERN ISRAEL* by Rabbi A. James Rudin, AJC's Assistant National Director of Interreligious Affairs. The book was hailed by Rabbi Marc Tanenbaum and two prominent Christian leaders as timely and important in improving confidence and trust between Christian and Jewish leaders and giving insight to the link between the Jewish people and the Land of Israel.

The Department of Public Information and Education is planning several projects in the area of training for Israeli information officers, stemming from a number of interviews conducted with returned correspondents following the Lebanese war, in which criticism was voiced about the performance of Israel's information officers. Courses are being planned in both the U.S. and Israel.

AJC is negotiating with WNET, Channel 13, to prepare study material in connection with the showing of "Civilization and the Jews," a 10-part TV series due to be aired in early 1984, as well as developing a project to bring the message of the series to Jewish and Christian groups around the country.

The Community Services Department will conduct AJC's 1983 Staff Orientation on February 22-24, in cooperation with the Personnel Department. Nineteen new staff members from area offices and AJC headquarters will gather for presentations, panel discussions and affinity group workshops on the agency's goals and objectives, policies, programs and operating style.

State legislators and AJC lay leaders rubbed shoulders at a regional forum in January on "State Governments: A New Power Center for the 1980's" sponsored by AJC's Midwest Region. Robert Jacobs, Midwest Regional Chairman, hosted the event, which featured legislators and lobbyists discussing emerging state policy issues and ways AJC can influence legislative decision making.

The "Hands Across the Campus" program, developed by our Los Angeles chapter, will be the subject of a CBS feature entitled "For Our Times" to be televised later this month in New York, Los Angeles and other major cities across the country. The program focuses on improving racial and ethnic understanding among high school students, and will serve as a model for a similar program to be launched later this year in Miami.

The William E. Wiener Oral History Library will be publishing in March a catalog of 100 oral histories of "American Jewish Women of Achievement." This compilation will be replicated in ten additional AJC chapters, with more to come.

The Oral History Library is also compiling a three-generational history of American Jewish families. Twenty staff interviewers are presently conducting the tapings, and the end result will be a published catalog.

The Argentine government has released the last of 12 political prisoners on whose behalf a group of AJC leaders interceded during a visit to Argentina last May. The delegation also held discussions with Argentine leaders on anti-Semitic episodes in Argentina.

[The AJC Foreign Affairs Commission has reported on the recent wave of anti-Semitic activity in Greece. A member of AJC's Western Region, who is close to Premier Papandreu and his wife, played a key role in arranging meetings between Greek Jewish leaders and government officials in Athens, as well as a meeting with American Jewish women and Mrs. Papandreu in New York City, which led to an easing of the situation.]
