TEMPLETON PRIZE AWARDED TO LORD JAKOBVITS, BRITAIN'S CHIEF RABBI

WINS COMMENTARY by RABBI MARC H. TANENBAUM

-----

While our nation rightly rejoices in the beginning return of American military forces from the Persian Gulf conflict, an important event in the world of religion should not be lost in our immediate preoccupations.

Last week, on March 6th, Lord Immanuel Jacobovits, chief rabbi of Great Britain and the Commonwealth, was awarded the Templeton Prize for Religion. The most prestigious international religion prize, past winners were of the stature of Mother Teresa, Alexander Solzenitzyn, and Dr. Billy Graham.

Lord Jacobovits is the first Jewish leader to receive the Templeton award which he richly deserves.

A prominent scholar in Jewish medical ethics which he pioneered, Chief Rabbi Jacobovits has been a courageous, if controversial, figure. He urged early on peaceful accomodation between Arabs and Jews. He called on Orthodox rabbis to cooperate with non-Orthodox in combatting their common foe of paganism. The chief rabbi has been a major figure in the cause of Soviet Jewry and in Jewish-Christian relations.

In honoring this distinguished Jewish leader, the Templeton Award brings honor to itself.

Rabbi Tanenbaum, who served for 30 years as director of international and interreligious affairs for the American Jewish Committee, is a weekly commentator over WINS-Westinghouse Broadcasting System. His prize-winning commentaries are heard, according to Arbitron, by some three million people each Sunday.

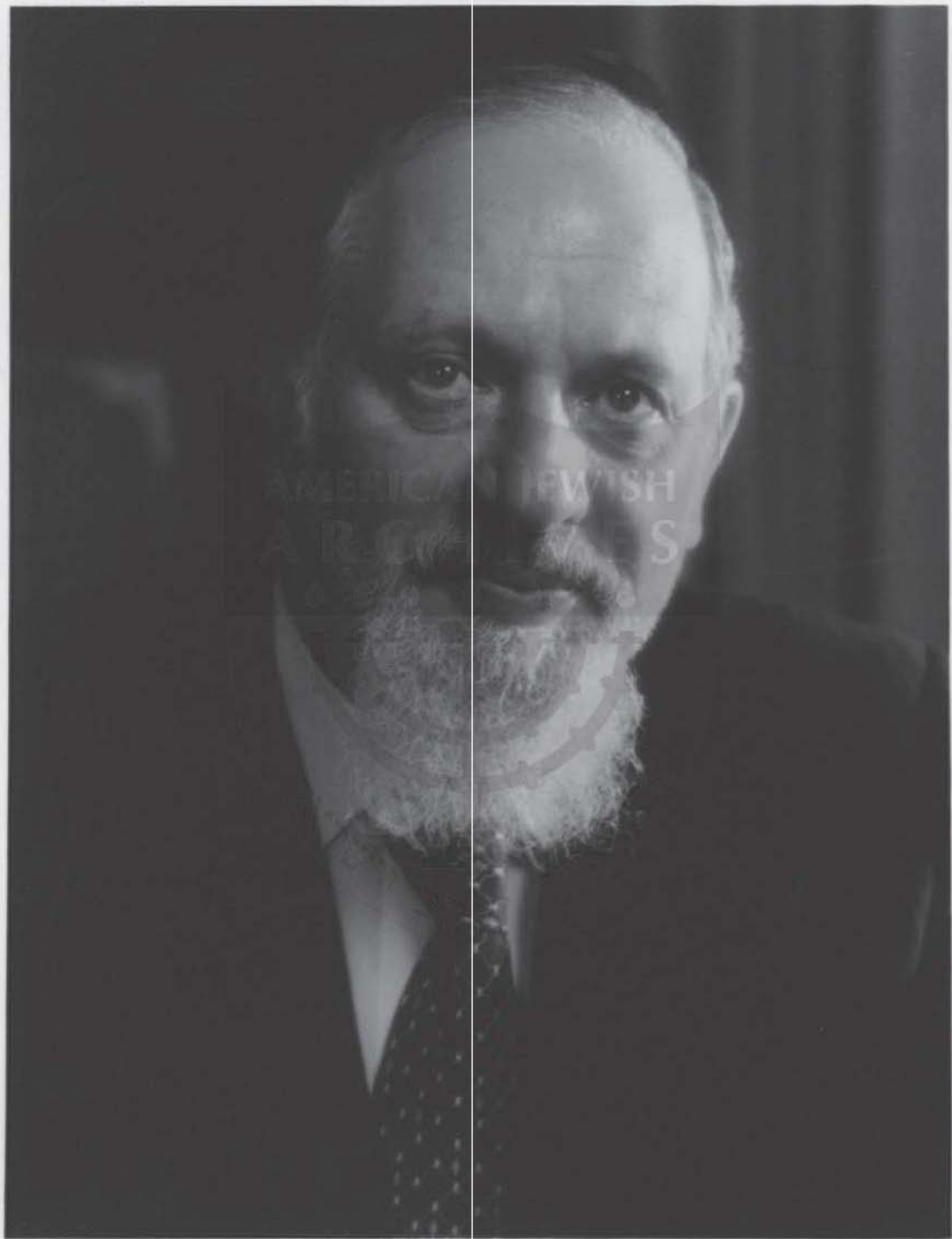

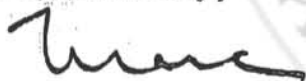
