Dear Rabbi Tanenbaum:

We write out of our concern for Black-Jewish relations. The old alignment, which in the past seemed so proper and natural and proved so fruitful, seems now to be threatened. Now is the time, we are convinced, to talk things through. As Isaiah put it, "Come, let us reason together."

We are therefore inviting a number of clergymen to join us for an informal, unpublicized brainstorming session at luncheon at the Stephen Wise Free Synagogue, 30 West 68th Street, Wednesday, October 31, at 12:30 P.M., that at least in our community we can begin a dialogue which, hopefully, will have some spin-offs and redound to the advantage of the Judeo-Christian ideals we cherish.
