YOUNG LEADERSHIP ROLE IN AMERICAN JEWISH COMMUNITY"

- I Y. L. Types Are: Angry young men Proud young men Creative young men
- II Y. L. Role is: To arouse Ignite Callenge Fight

III Y. L. Tasks:

- A. To Educate: especially new young leaders, re:
  - 1. <u>Needs</u> via missions, slides, books, talk, talk, talk, invite to home
  - 2. <u>Methods</u> to raise money: campaigns should be speedier, and more personal.
- B. To <u>Create</u> a political consciousness i.e. Russian Jewry protests
- C. To Stimulate i. e., set pace by personal gifts to inspire others.
- D. To <u>Determine Priorities</u> especially on; local level, Don't just drift along, acquiescing
  - Examples 1.) are Jewish hospitals really needed?
    - What is best form of Jewish Education? Day schools, - then say so.
