My dear Joe,

From the wording of your cables to Giora Josephthal and myself, we are aware that you are displeased with us for not reacting favourably in connection with your request to the Government for being represented at the Big Gifts Meeting in Miami. For this, I am entirely at fault and I accept whatever blame there is. However, I would like you to know that I tried my best under the circumstances, but obviously my best did not prove good enough. Nevertheless, I hope it will turn out to be a worthy affair in Miami, and I send you all my good wishes for its success.

From everybody, and especially from Ehud, who told me about his conversations with you in San Francisco, I hear that American Jewry is regarding the latest events connected with our people in Russia and other communist countries rather seriously, which seriousness is expressing itself in all ways, and especially in immediate positive action for the U.J.A. Naturally, all these things are uppermost in the minds of everyone here, and each day seems to make matters even more serious and complicated.

Incidentally, I hope to be in the States for a two weeks' visit towards the end of this month, and I am looking forward very much to meeting with you and Eddie Warburg, to whom I should be grateful if you would convey my very best wishes.

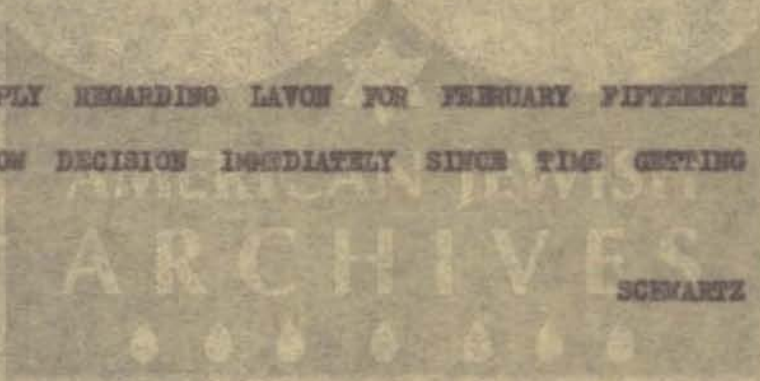
