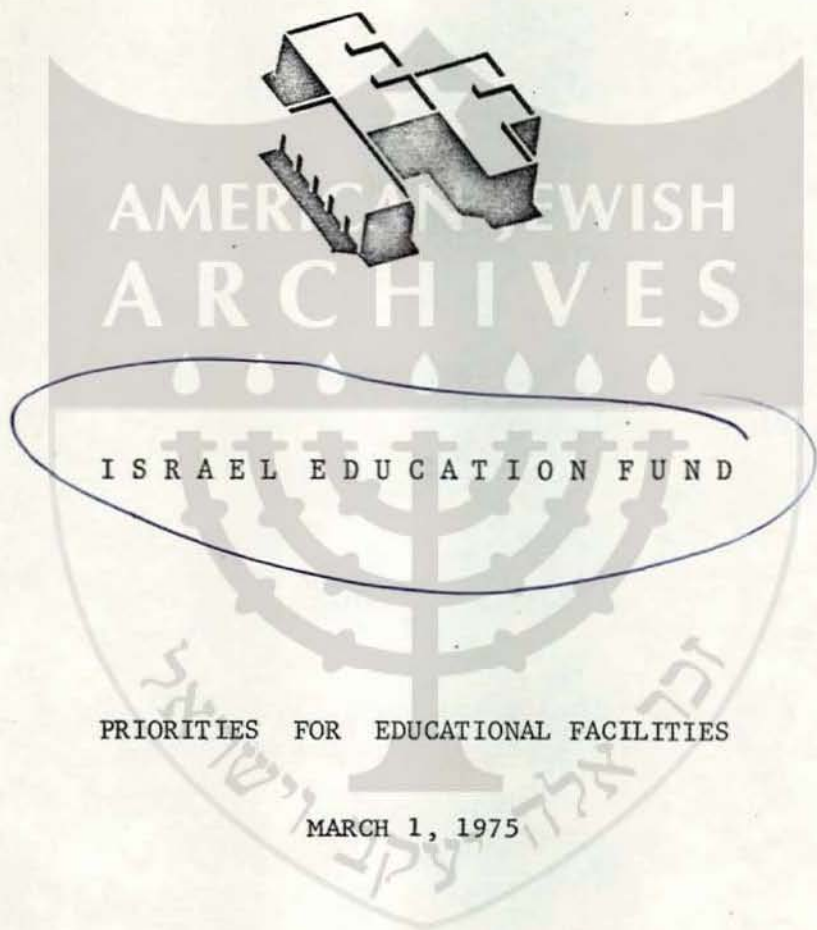

We have been under wraps now for two years with the emergencies. However, I believe we can go full blast the balance of this year, provided the various building restrictions are lifted for our projects.
