- 9. A number of purchase money notes and deeds of trust securing said notes (mortgage) have been assigned by Jewish Federation Council of Greater Los Angeles, and The Jewish Community Foundation of the Jewish Federation Council of Greater Los Angeles to United Jewish Appeal.

 - 11. b) The Retirement Plan was modified in 1970 resulting in additional benefits for employees at retirement age. A one time contribution of \$600,000 was put into the Plan to partially pay for the additional cost of the new benefits.

The \$600,000 is being amortized and charged to expenses over a period of 10 years. On December 31, 1971, the unamortized balance was \$480,000.

The Israel Education Fund was instituted for the purpose of raising funds for specific educational capital projects and scholarship programs in Israel. The campaign began in 1964 and is operated by a separate department of United Jewish Appeal, Inc. The pledges are to be secured selectively over and above the nominal giving of the solicited contribution and may be paid over a five year period. The results of the operations are predicated on the amounts received in partial or full liquidation of pledges.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly the financial position of the Israel Education Fund of the United Jewish Appeal, Inc. as at December 31, 1971 and the results of its operations from inception to December 31, 1971, in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles applied consistently with that of the preceding year.
