Proposal: To Establish a UJA Speaker's Seminar

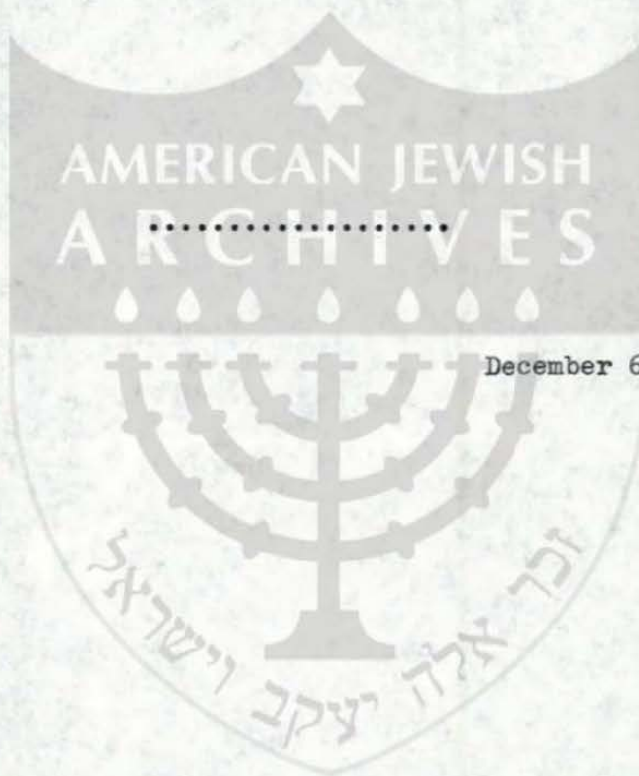
- A. UJA proposes to establish in Jerusalem a Seminar for Israelis who have been requested by UJA to speak or work in its campaign. UJA welcomes the participation of others recommended by sister and related organizations.
- B. An Israeli speaker can be more effective if, besides his own field of knowledge, he is familiar with the broadest scope of human needs in Israel, and the relationship of the UJA campaign to those needs.

- C. A speaker in the United States should be familiar with the historic commitment of American Jews to zedakah and the rebuilding of Eretz Yisrael.

- E. Fundamental fund-raising techniques will be emphasized.

- F. It is also important that speakers understand some common denominators of Jewish life in America.

 5. The leadership of American Jewish life.
 6. The demography and social patterns of American Jewish life.
 7. Commitments of American Jewish life.
 8. The voluntarism of Judaism.
- G. The Seminars and presentations will be brief and directed. UJA will utilize its Israeli staff, and will invite others in Israel who have experience as UJA speakers or staff members or whose fields are related to the needs of Israeli speakers. Field trips, models and tapes, and other media forms will be utilized.

- H. As a working guide, one day should be structured for speakers who will be in the United States for two weeks; three days for speakers or residents for one month; one week for two months or longer.

- I. UJA should be able to initiate this project at the beginning of 1972.

I remember that you said that you would like to do this as late as possible. I was speaking about October, but since you want more time, we altered our plans and we are willing to speak about the period of mid-November. If you are in the position to fix dates, it would be most helpful. The more specific we can be, the better chance we have to obtain maximum results by planning long in advance. The three days of Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, November 22, 23, 24 might be the best three days. How does that sound to you? I would appreciate hearing from you at your earliest convenience.

We are trying to raise even more money next year, and your willingness to give us a help at the very top level of the campaign will be the single most important contribution anyone can make. B. Zvi Sobel is an Assistant Professor of Sociology at Brandeis University. He received his education at Brooklyn College and at the New School for Social Research in New York, and received his M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from the New School. Dr. Sobel's research in the field of sociology has been concentrated in the areas of inter-group relations, contemporary Jewish studies, and the sociology of the Jews. He is the author of various articles and reviews which have appeared in a wide range of scholarly and general journals, including the *American Sociological Review*, the *Journal for the Scientific Study of Religion*, *Midstream*, *Judaism*, *Dialogue*, and others. During 1966-67 Dr. Sobel was Visiting Senior Lecturer in Sociology at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem and Haifa University College in Haifa, Israel. While in Israel Dr. Sobel was engaged in research on Arab-Jewish relationships, and he presently is completing a series of research reports on the recent conflict and its antecedents.

He is married and the father of three children, and resides in *Natick, Haifa, Israel*, Massachusetts.

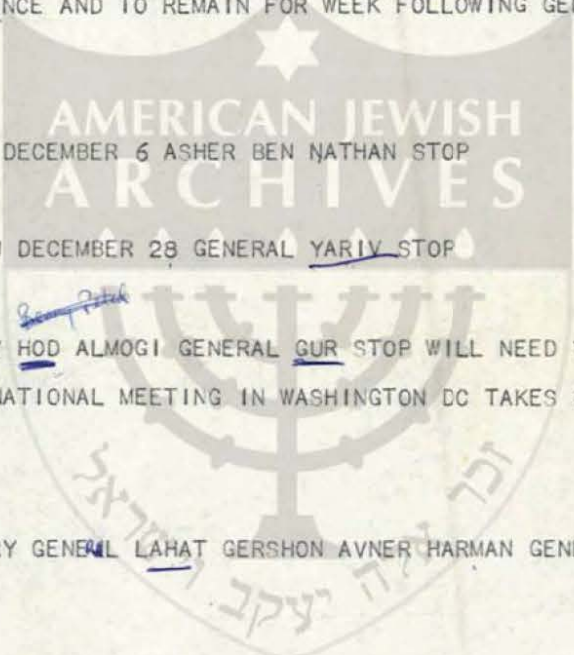
