RABBI HERBERT A. FRIEDMAN

Rabbi Friedman who was here on our behalf from December 30, thru February 2, 1977, visited 21 cities. In the course of his visit to these cities, he addressed a number of individual meetings in each city, and participated in solicitations.

Based on our prior arrangement, Rabbi Friedman is to receive \$1,000., for each city he visited on our behalf, ... therefore, a total of \$21,000., is now due him. He has arranged with you to have \$2,500., deposited to his account each month, commencing with February 1, 1977, until the entire sum is paid to him.

Based upon an anticipation of an additional visit to the States during the calendar year of 1977 on our behalf, we will incur additional indebtedness to him for further cities that he visits. Therefore, at the end of the year you should prepare an accounting as to how much we owe him for the year, and how much he has drawn against this amount, and his balance to be settled at the end of the calendar year of 1977.


Dear Herb:

Dear Herb:

After having just returned from the recently concluded Young Leadership Cabinet Mission which was unbelievably successful, both from a solicitation point of view and also from the point of view of creating 27 individuals who are far more aware and understanding of Israel's problems and much more deeply committed to their personal participation in the solving of those problems, I wanted to write you to express my thanks, both personally as the National Missions Chairman for the Cabinet and as Leader of the Mission and also on behalf of all of the people who participated, for your having taken the time to sensitively guide us through the difficult Munich experience.

While a number of individuals were extremely apprehensive about this part of our program and found the experience to be difficult for them, there was common consensus that your presence and the manner in which you handled the entire experience provided a major contribution towards solidifying the group as a whole and set the tone for the balance of the mission.

The insights into the holocaust which you provided reached far into the depths of the mission participants and provided them with a basis for understanding much of what they were to experience in Israel, which basis they otherwise would not have had.

Once again let me thank you for taking the time to be with us in Munich and putting so much effort into making the experience such a meaningful one.

It gives me great satisfaction to be able to write to you and to thank you personally, and on behalf of the community, for your excellent presentation at our Major Gifts Dinner on Thursday, November 17.

Your analysis was trenchant, on target and moving. I know it helped those in attendance to know what their responsibilities were as a Jew at this time in history.

Our meeting was one of those rare instances where the speaker was able to obtain significant increases. Therefore, you moved people. I know you had a little hesitancy about categorizing us as a conservative community, but within the thrust of your remarks, and realizing the situation as it affects Israel, what you said was appropriate.


Dear Herb:

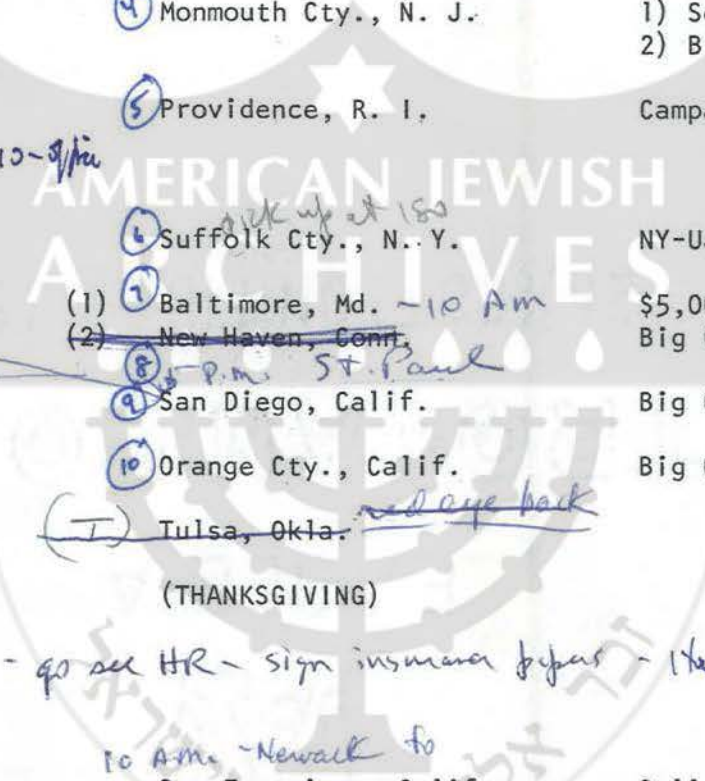

Rabbi Friedman will be talking to a group of pacesetters at 8:00 p.m. at the home of Harry Franco, who is a \$10,000 gift, and is part of the Ely Ashkenazi firm of Sound & Design system.

We have set up the following appointments leading up to the evening meeting:

A 3:00 p.m. appointment with Mr. Ely Ashkenazi at his office in Jersey City. I plan to pick up Rabbi Friedman at his hotel in New York City at approximately 1:30 p.m.

Mr. Ashkenazi gave \$50,000 in 1977; we rated him at \$100,000. This is the largest gift in the community.

Accompanying Rabbi Friedman to see Mr. Ashkenazi will be Mr. Gilbert Schapiro. Mr. Schapiro is the past President of the Federation, and a major part of a \$39,000., 1977 gift.
