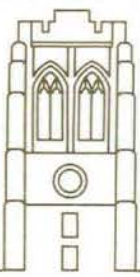




I will try to make the Board meeting Thursday morning. I will, however, have to leave around lunch time since I have a class here at Mason that afternoon.

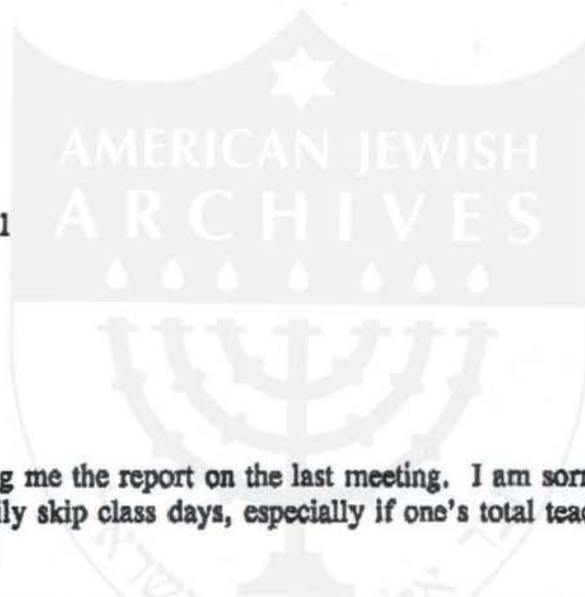
