Here are the revised printing and design estimates for the Teachers' Research Report. As you can see, we would be able to print 4 thousand copies, with a 2 color cover and black (with gray tints on the charts) and fall within the budget. (Including the design fee).

The printing fee includes printing some copy on the inside front cover, as we have done on all other CUE publications. Mark informs me we could save a few hundred dollars by not printing on the inside cover. Maybe this material could be placed someplace else.

The cost could change if the book runs shorter or longer than 32 pages. Right now, based on looking at the manuscript, I think we will make 32 pages. This I will have a clearer picture of when the book is designed and the copy run in.



Let me try again:

To print the Teachers Report will cost \$6400 for 4000 copies (and \$5700 for 2000, lest you think we can save money by printing a more appropriate number). That is a lot of cash--and I'm not convinced that there are 4000 people who will actually read it, as opposed to the Policy Brief. Karen feels that were she in on the decision from the beginning, she's not sure we would have printed it. We may have produced it in a more raw form. (I am always in favor of the most polished form, as you know, and the work put into this data justifies a serious format.)

When it came to the Leaders Report, Karen did not feel we could justify the expense of printing a document that is now framed as a "think-piece" with condensed data and the questions it raises rather than a full-scale report with some policy implications. Therefore, the decision to use the same designer to lay out the pages of the LR in the same format as the TR; to design a compatible cover; but to produce a document that is xeroxed with cover rather than printed. Of course, if it turns out to be almost as expensive, we'll have to rethink. But when I look at the audience for teachers, it's really Research Network/ALOHA at the core, and that's not a lot of people.

Does this make sense to you? And if it still doesn't, please explain.

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

The Lookstein Digest is a listserve facilitated by the Lookstein Center for Jewish Education at Bar Ilan University. Subscribers all over the world, including scholars, practitioners and students in the field of Jewish education, use it to engage in discussion on a variety of topics of interest. Apparently a subscriber who received The Teachers Report and The Leaders Report (there must be numerous people on our mailing list who subscribe -- Elie and Leah are also subscribers) posted a notice that the Reports are worth seeing. Since then we have received several requests for copies, citing the posting on the Lookstein listserve.

We have also had requests from school administrators (Ramaz, CHAT) and other organizations, including the Jewish Education Services in New Jersey. There has also been some interest from researchers in the interview protocol used in the survey. A request for the research protocol came from the Allied Jewish Federations in Denver, as they are interested in conducting a similar survey in their own community and would like to follow the model set out by this study.

Thus far, the reports have been sent to about 315 people.
