Israel Experience Research Project

The Israel Experience Research Project is the tentative title for a new co-operative endeavor among three parties: the CRB Foundation (CRBF), Mandel Associated Foundations (MAF), and the Melton Centre for Jewish Education in the Diaspora of the Hebrew University.

The central purpose of the project is to stimulate and support basic and applied research on the "Israel Experience." Toward that end, the CRBF and the MAF have made available to the Melton Centre \$50,000 and \$25,000, respectively, for the first year of operation (July 1, 1992-June 30, 1993). The project will be operated in conjunction with the Melton Centre. The project will be located at the Melton Centre.

Overall Objectives of the Project

1. The Research Population: Most of the research support by the project will focus upon programs that serve young Jews from the Diaspora.

The Steering Committee (see below), in conjunction with its academic advisors, will consider whether we should further specify the principal research population with respect to such characteristics as age, geographic origin, duration of programs, and orientation of program to first-time or repeat visitors.

2. Nature of the Research: We will facilitate both basic and applied research in the field of the Israel Experience

On the applied or policy-oriented side, we are interested in such issues as:

- improving the marketing of Israel Experience programs;
- assessing the pricing structure of these programs;
- regularly monitoring the level of participation in these programs;
- broadening the Jewish and socio-demographic background of participants;
- assessing staff recruitment, training, supervision, and evaluation;
- planning such innovations as a resource center to serve both practitioners and researchers;
- program evaluation.

Basic research projects may seek to conceptualize, clarify, and operationalize such issues as:

educational objectives;

- measuring the size, duration, and nature of the impact of the Israel Experience upon Jewish identity generally and involvement with Israel in particular;
- the nature of Jewish and Zionist commitment, identity and knowledge.

We expect to be open to research in several disciplines. Advisors from the academic world will help shape the project's substantive research agenda.

3. Developing Research Personnel: We regard the development of additional research personnel in the study of the Israel Experience as a distinct and urgent priority. As such, we are committed to intensively recruiting talented researchers who until now have had only a tangential interest in the Israel Experience.

Programs

4. *Mix of Grant Programs*: We will need to devise programs that will address our research agenda and develop research personnel.

Toward that end, we will need to select a few of several alternative uses of our limited funds. The choices include (but are not limited to):

- a. Research grants to experienced investigators.
- b. Doctoral research grants.
- c. Master's research grants.
- d. Conferences of academicians and practitioners.
- e. Publications, e.g. monographs, anthologies, and occasional papers.

The academic advisors will deliberate with the Steering Committee on these and other possible programs and help decide among them.

5. Recruiting Researchers: We will need to decide as to how best to initiate research. One possibility entails a pro-active posture where we would approach specific researchers with research possibilities. Alternatively, we may want to issue RFPs (Requests for Proposals), or announce open competitions for grants for advanced students or researchers.

Management

- 6. Steering Committee: Overall management of the project will reset with a Steering Committee consisting of Dr. Janet Aviad (representing CRBF), Annette Hochstein (representing MAF), and Alan Hoffmann (representing HU). Prof. Steven Cohen of the Melton Centre will staff the Steering Committee.
- 7. Academic Advisors: The Academic Advisors will help decide upon the following matters:

- a. The research agenda.
- b. The mix of grant programs.
- c. The procedures to recruit researchers.
- d. The review and selection of specific grant applications.
- e. Monitoring and evaluation.




Your assistance in this matter is really appreciated.
