## From the Rabbi

On Friday evening, June 11th, we will pay tribute to Ethel Gewirtzman as she completes her term of office as our Temple president, and we will install our new president, Irwin Rosen. Serving as Temple president is truly an awesome responsibility which requires a tremendous commitment of time and energy. Though I will have more to say about our outgoing president, Ethel Gewirtzman, at the Sabbath dinner in her honor, I feel that it is important for our entire congregation, including those who may not be able to attend the dinner, to know how grateful we are to her for the leadership which she has provided during the past two years.

To the outsider it may appear that the president's role is purely ceremonial, sitting on the bimah for services and representing the Temple at public occasions. Nothing could be further from the truth. Serving as Temple president is a full-time responsibility which requires keeping track of every aspect of the Temple program and maintaining constant contact with the Rabbi, the Temple office and the various committee chairpersons.
