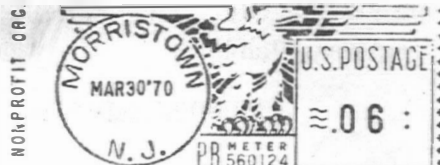

## WHERE WERE YOU?

*Never in recent history have we heard a more pronounced and widespread concern with the burgeoning problem of narcotic affliction and of the general alienation of our youth.*

*To suggest that these problems are the result of simple root causes would not only reflect a total lack of sophistication but downright naivete. I can, therefore, only speak of contributing factors; one of which is an apparent disassociation by parents with some of the legitimate interests and involvements of their children.*

*I have room here for but one example, but I believe that it is a significant one. Last month our Senior Youth Group wrote and prepared a most ingenious and imaginative Friday Evening Service entitled, "The Last Sabbath." They worked feverishly and excitedly and the result was both startling and profound. Few parents were there to laud the effort and to give encouragement. How sad. What a sense of frustration must have gripped these young people.*

*In a recent discussion of the 'Drug Scene' among our upper grade Religious School students, one young person remarked, "My parents joined the Temple. They wake me up for Religious School and tell me how necessary it is, but they, themselves, hardly ever show up at Temple. How phony can you be?"*

*I confess that this does not constitute the whole problem. But if you multiply this single situation a hundred-fold it adds up to sheer tragedy.*
