Dr. Brachfeld will discuss the manner in which these funds were disbursed by the Federal Food and Nutrition Service during 1976 on such programs as Food Stamps, Child Nutrition, Supplemental Feeding and Commodity Distribution. You'll learn how your tax dollar has been spent. Of further interest will be the nutritional aspects of these programs.

Dr. Brachfeld is the regional director of Nutrition and Technical Services, U.S. Dept. of Agriculture. He holds a Masters Degree in Food Science, Cornell, and PhD in Food Technology, University of Illinois.
