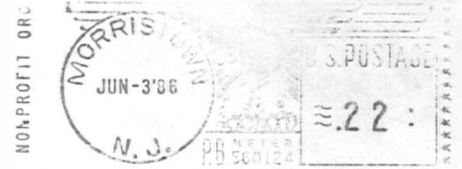

THIRD REFORM SETTLEMENT FOUNDED

The Reform Movement has now founded its
third settlement in Israel in a period of
only eight years. Har Chalutz is a free
enterprise settlement for approximately a
dozen families who live on the mountain
site near the town of Carmiel in northern
Israel. Each family is responsible for
its own livelihood. They are living tem-
porarily in trailers, but will shortly
build their own homes. The settlers join
together each week for Shabbat worship and
study and other social and cultural activi-
ties of a communal nature. Har Chalutz is
a project of ARZA, the Association of Reform
Zionists of America.

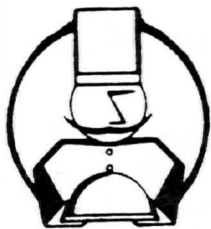
