

THIRD REFORM SETTLEMENT FOUNDED

The Reform Movement has now founded its third settlement in Israel in a period of only eight years. Har Chalutz is a free enterprise settlement for approximately a dozen families who live on the mountain site near the town of Carmiel in northern Israel. Each family is responsible for its own livelihood. They are living temporarily in trailers, but will shortly build their own homes. The settlers join together each week for Shabbat worship and study and other social and cultural activities of a communal nature. Har Chalutz is a project of ARZA, the Association of Reform Zionists of America.


