Deadquarters, Department of the Gulf, New Orleans, July 19" 1864. Alt Senjamin Cohn, clillersburg, Kolmes Co, Ohio, Sir :- In reply to your communication of the 26th ult, enquiring as to the point at which the remains of the fale Col Spiegel of the 120 ord were interned I have the honor to inform you that the Comog Officer of the regiment, to whom your letter was referred, reports that Col. Spiegel was buried on Wilson's plantation near Wilson's Landing, Red River, May 4<sup>th</sup> 1864."
