By late papers I see that Gen Kirby Smith was negotiating for the surrender of his forces to General Canby. If he does surrender the Texas prisoners will undoubtably be released soon - I think they will be released within the next few months. I hope they may, for they have had a hard time of it.

The letters you spoke of having written me within the past year I have not received.

If you should come to Ohio we would be pleased to have you visit us.
