May 17<sup>th</sup> 1865

Mrs Spiegel

Dear Madam.

Yours of the 12<sup>th</sup> was just rec'd. I forwarded the certificate to Mr Cohen the day I sent your letter. I hope it may be sufficient to enable you to get your accounts settled up.

I have not heard directly from Mr Spiegel since Capt Jones returned from Texas last fall. but I heard about a month ago that all of the members of the 120<sup>th</sup> Ohio were well.

By late papers I see that Gen Kirby Smith was negotiating for the surrender of his forces to General Canby. If he does

surrender the Texas prisoners  
will undoubtedly be released  
soon. I think they will be  
released within the next two  
months. I hope they may, for  
they have had a hard time of  
it.

The letters you spoke of having  
written me within the past year  
I have not received.

If you should come to Ohio  
we would be pleased to have
