

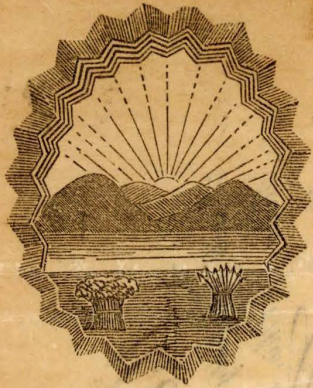

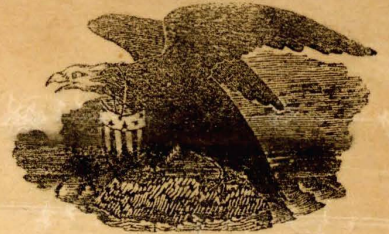

To *Marcus M Spiegel* Greeting:

It appearing to me that on the 18th day of December, 1861, you were duly appointed Captain, 67th Regiment Ohio Volunteer Militia, organized and mustered into the service of the United States under Proclamation of the President, dated May 3rd, 1861.

Now Know You, That by the powers vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of said State, and reposing special trust and confidence in your patriotism, valor, fidelity and ability, I do by these presents COMMISSION you as Captain as aforesaid, for the term of **THREE YEARS**, unless sooner discharged, upon condition that you uniform within the time limited by law, and take the oath, or affirmation, endorsed hereon, within ten days from the receipt hereof, sending a certificate thereof to General Head Quarters; and I do hereby authorize and require you to discharge, all and singular, the duties and services appertaining to your said office, agreeably to law and general regulations, and to obey such orders and instructions as you shall, from time to time, receive from your superior officers.

In Testimony Whereof, I have herunto set my name, and caused the Great Seal of the State of Ohio to be affixed, at Columbus, the 16th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, and in the eighty-sixth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
