INVOCATION BY RABBI MARC H. TANENBAUM, DIRECTOR OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS, AMERICAN JEWISH COMMITTEE, AT 90TH ANNIVERSARY NOBEL LAUREATE DINNER, NEW YORK MILTON MOTEL, TUESDAY, DEC. 9, 1986

AS WE GATHER TO HONOR ALFRED NOBEL AND THE MERICAN HOBEL LAUREATES OF the PAST 45 YEARS, WE REFLECT ON THE POWER OF KNOWLEDGE AND WISDOM.
