"Holocaust: Jews not the Only Sufferers"
Commentary by Georgiyev

Holocaust - classic tear-jerker. Profound sorrow for individuals who lost their lives at the hand of the Brown-shirts. Limited to Jewish people's suffering and struggle for survival. What about slaves.

'The dominant theme of "Holocaust" - that the humble Jew turned out to be the greatest martyr of WWII is all but irrelevant. Jew in the West shown always as a sacrificial lamb shoved through the Big Power's negligence into the gaping mouth of the Nazi monster.'

Jewish survival post WWII attributed to Jews.
Russian - ptd as if USSR solely responsible for saving Jews in
W.W.II - Soviet Army action against ^{Nazi} Germany
