


With everyone else at the International Affairs Commission, I was very disturbed to learn of your present illness.

Irving and I were so thrilled to hear your commentary on Sunday, April 10th. We spoke to Georgette earlier that day and she told us when you would be on.


Your voice sounded so strong and healthy. You were energetic and very clear and certainly your topic was most potent. As Irving said, you made your point beautifully.
