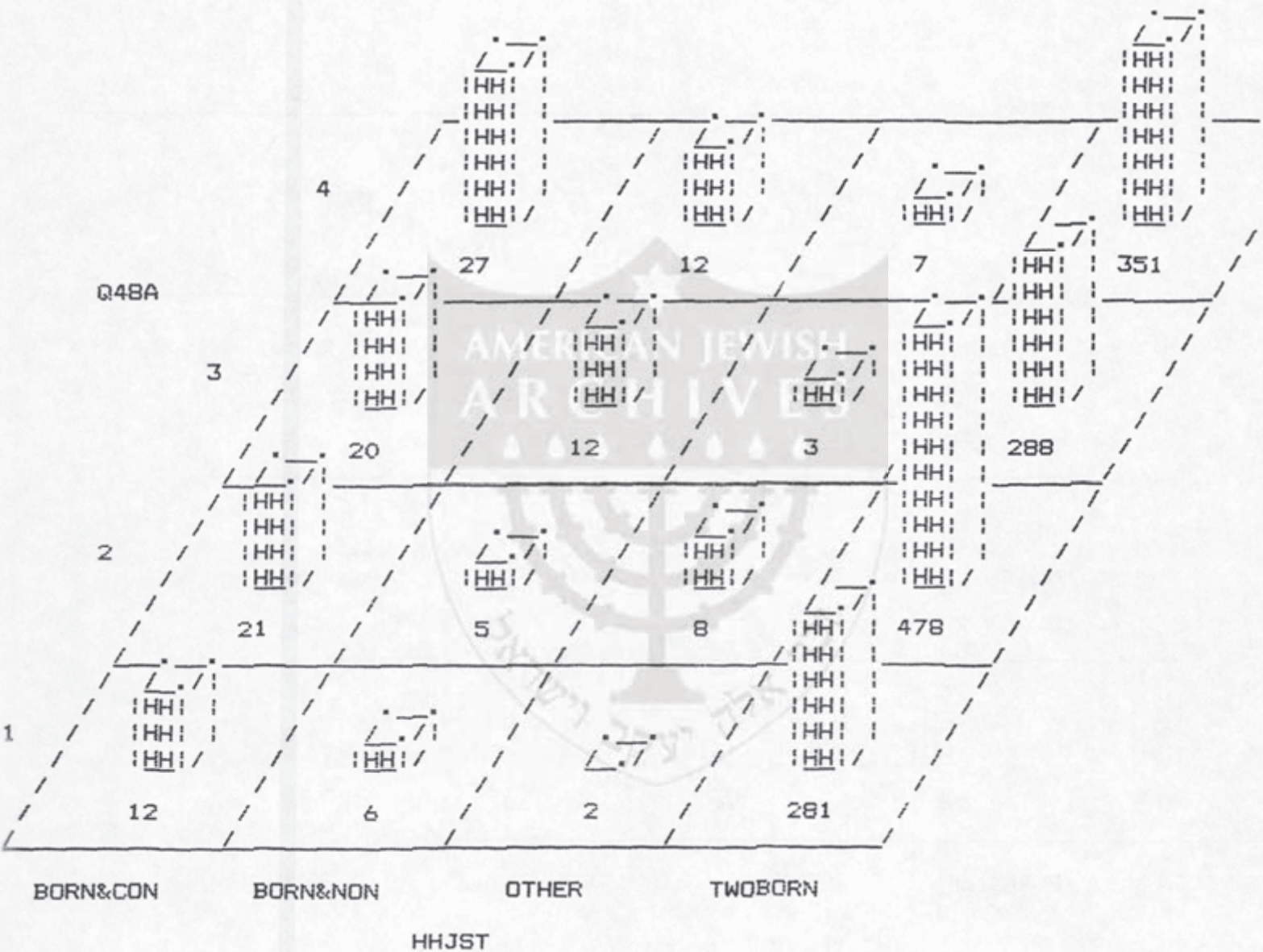

BLOCK CHART OF RESPONSE



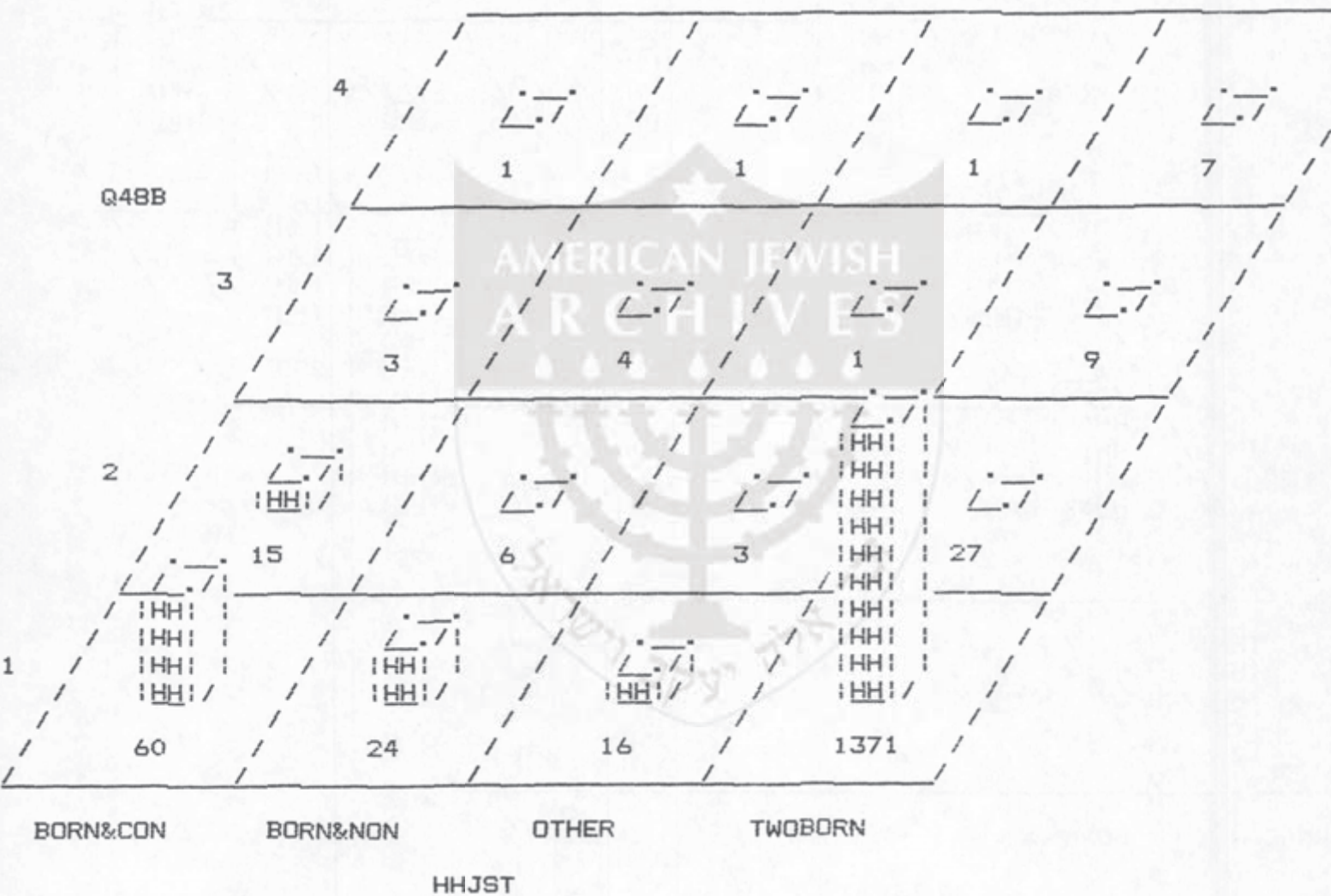


QUESTION 48B: HOW MUCH WOULD IT BOTHER YOU IF YOUR CHILD

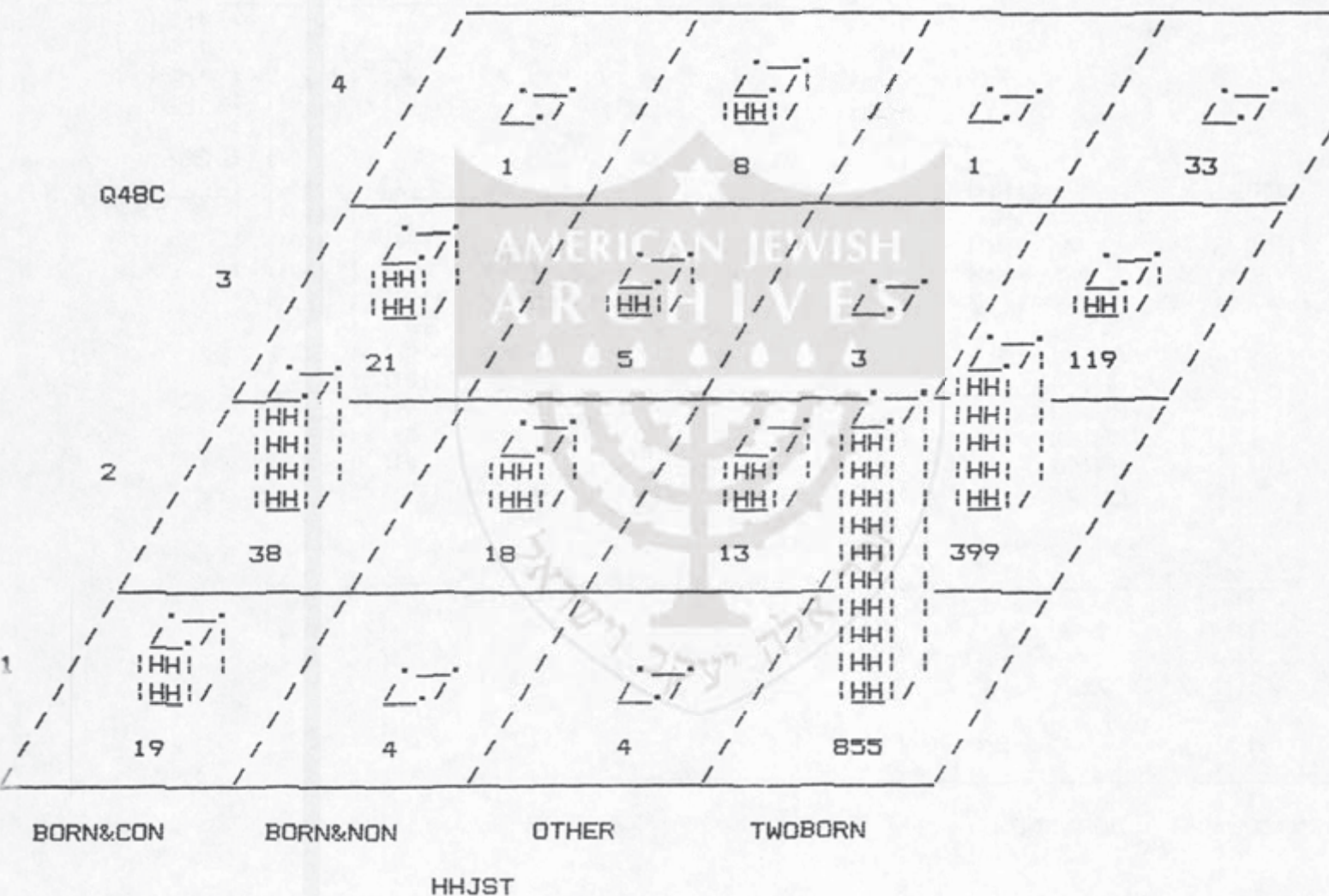


QUESTION 48C: HOW MUCH WOULD IT BOTHER YOU IF YOUR CHILD

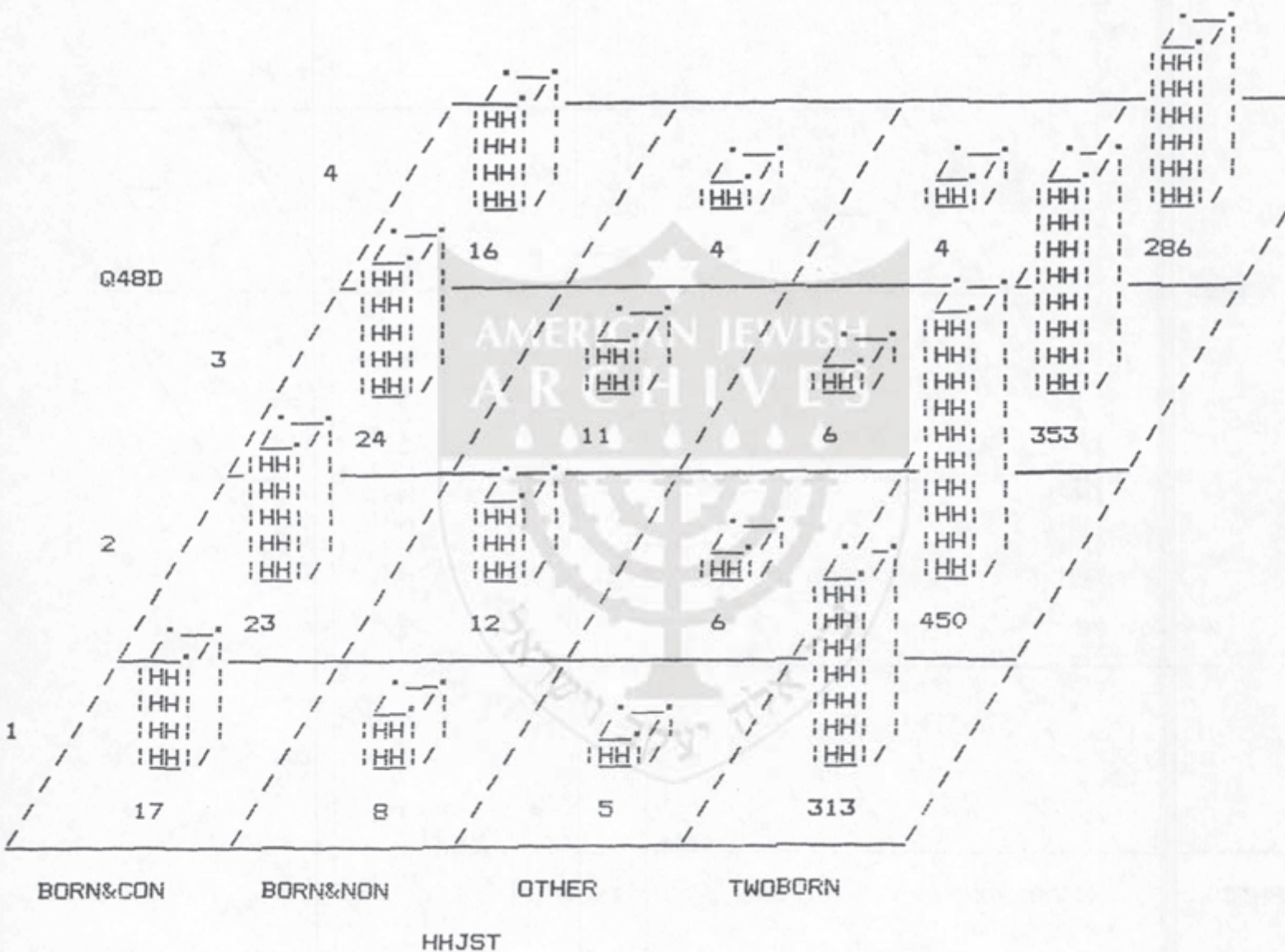


QUESTION 48D: HOW MUCH WOULD IT BOTHER YOU IF YOUR CHILD

BLOCK CHART OF RESPONSE



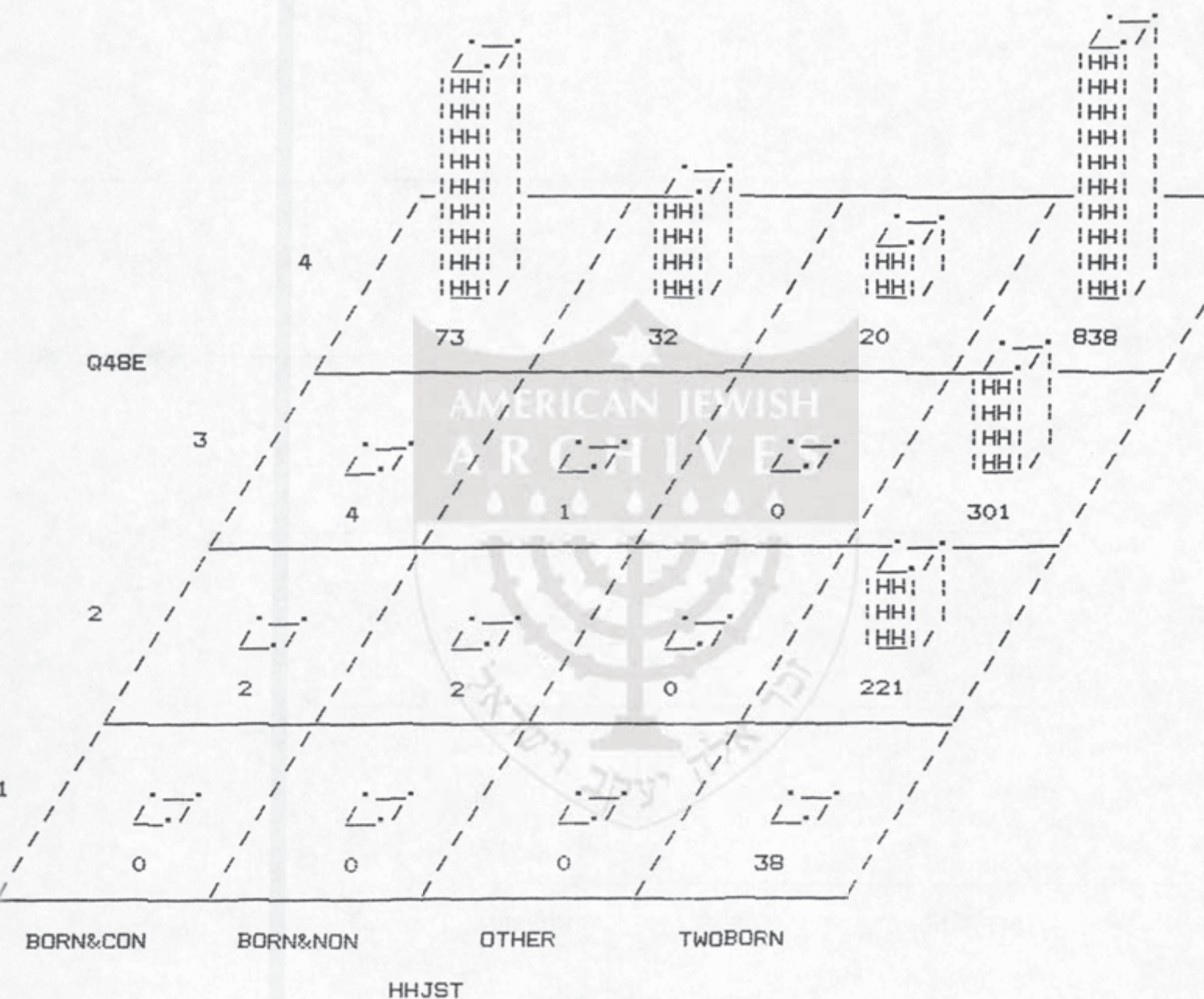


QUESTION 48E: HOW MUCH WOULD IT BOTHER YOU IF YOUR CHILD

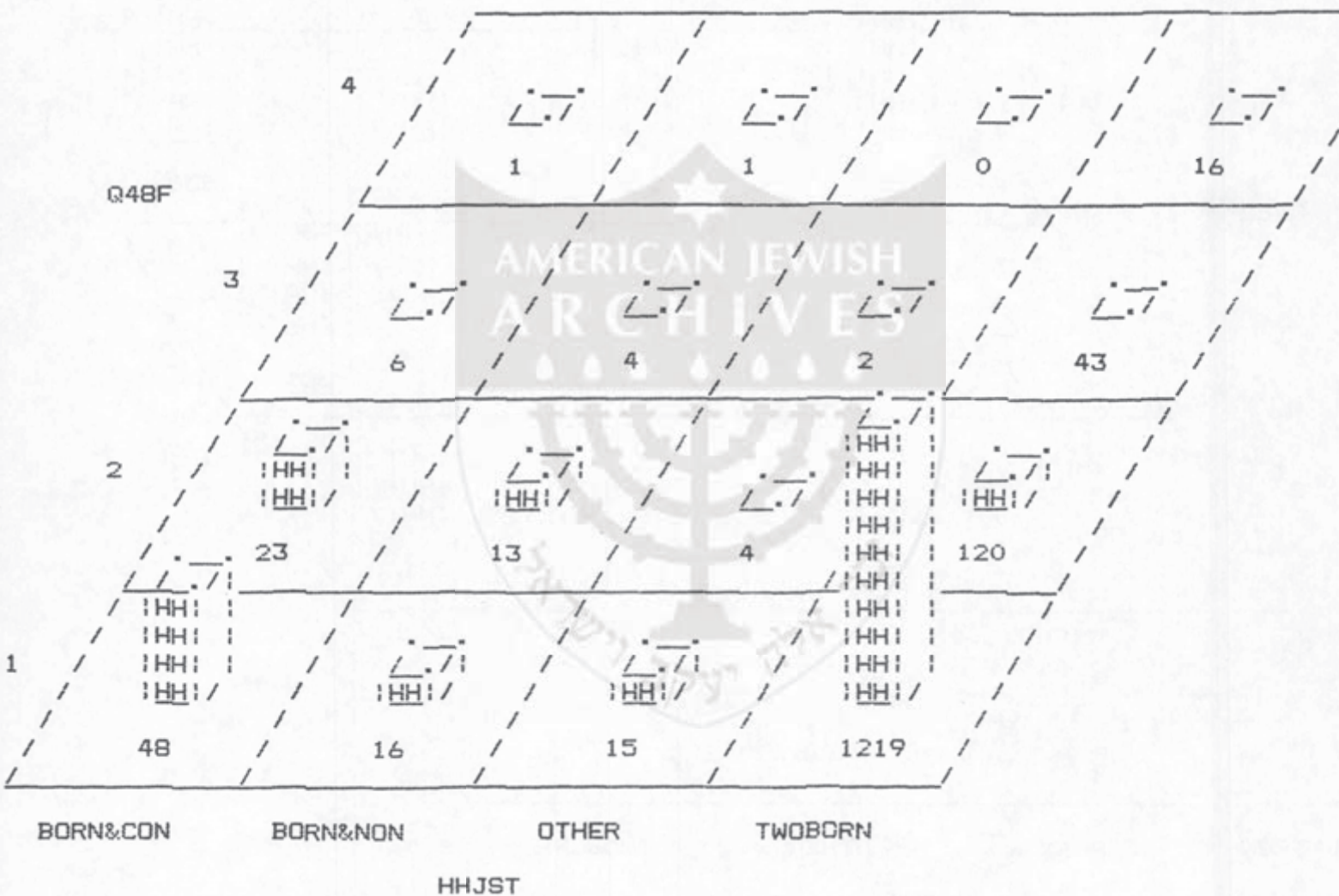


QUESTION 48F: HOW MUCH WOULD IT BOTHER YOU IF YOUR CHILD

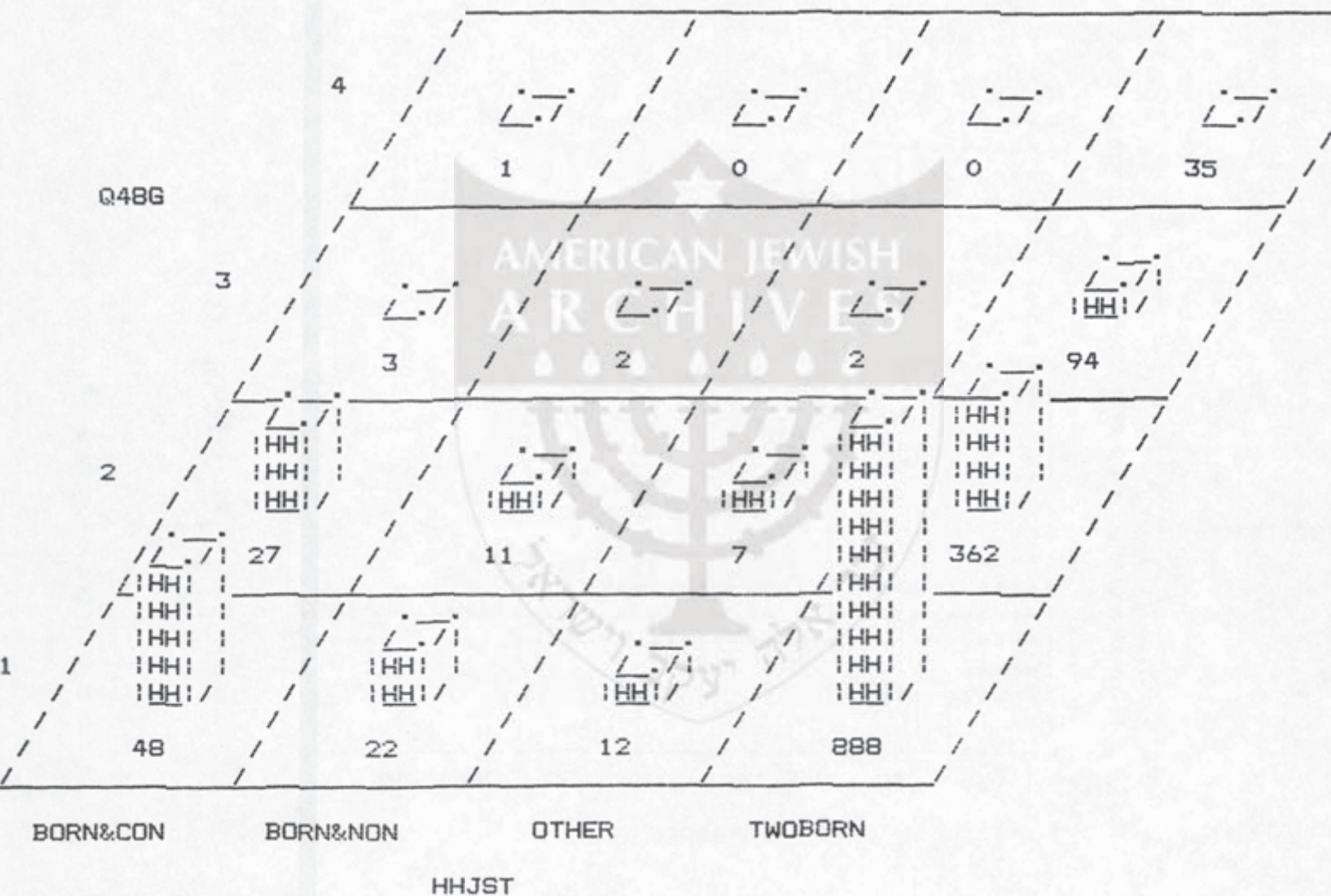




QUESTION 48G: HOW MUCH WOULD IT BOTHER YOU IF YOUR CHILD

BLOCK CHART OF RESPONSE



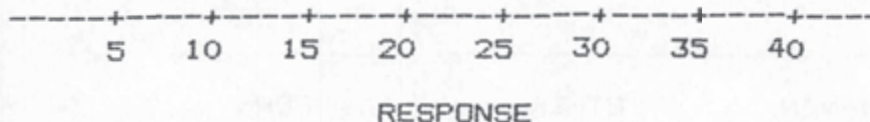


QUESTION 49: WHAT IS YOUR ATTITUDE TOWARD YOUR CHILDREN DATING NONJEWS?

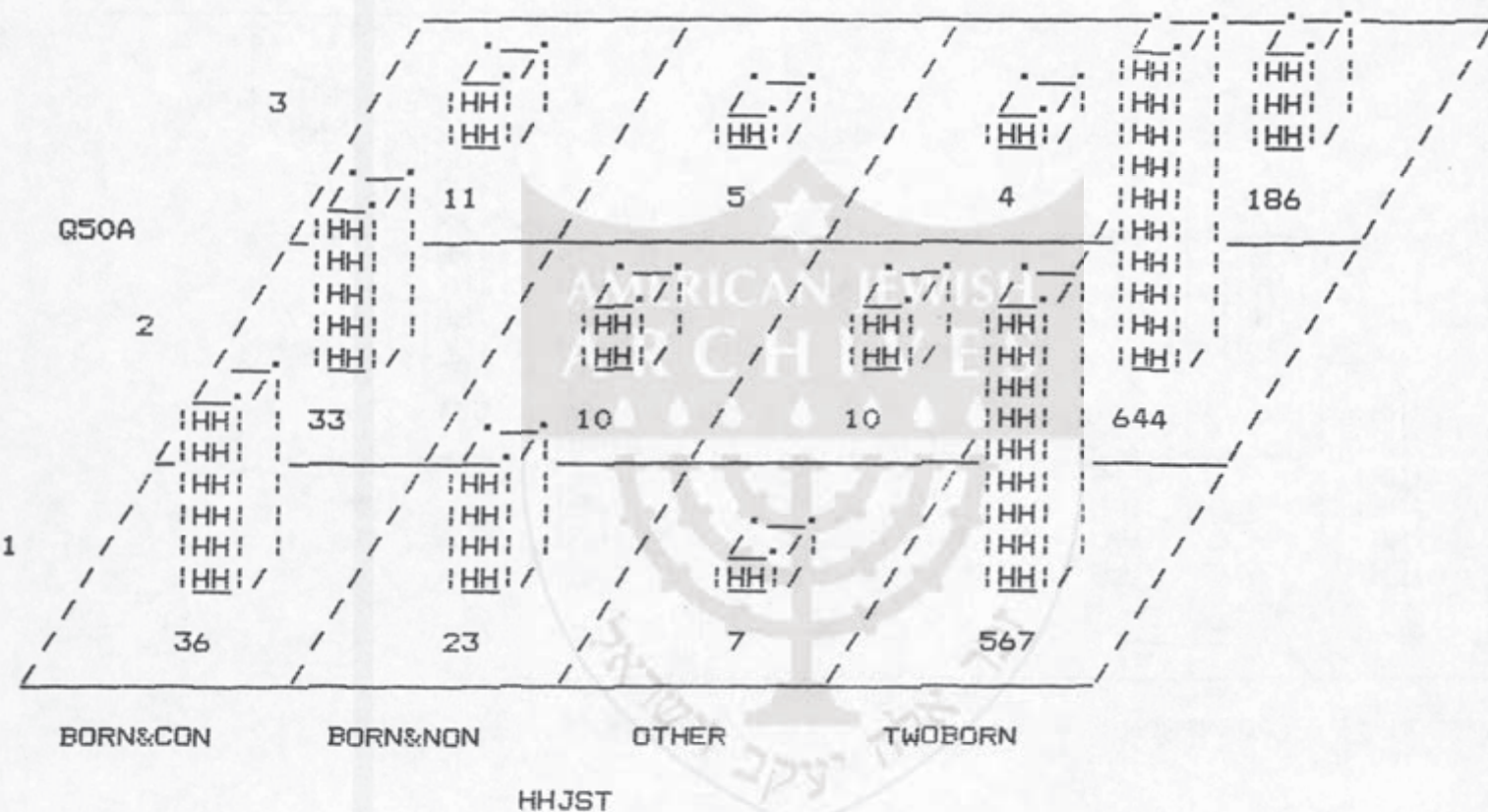

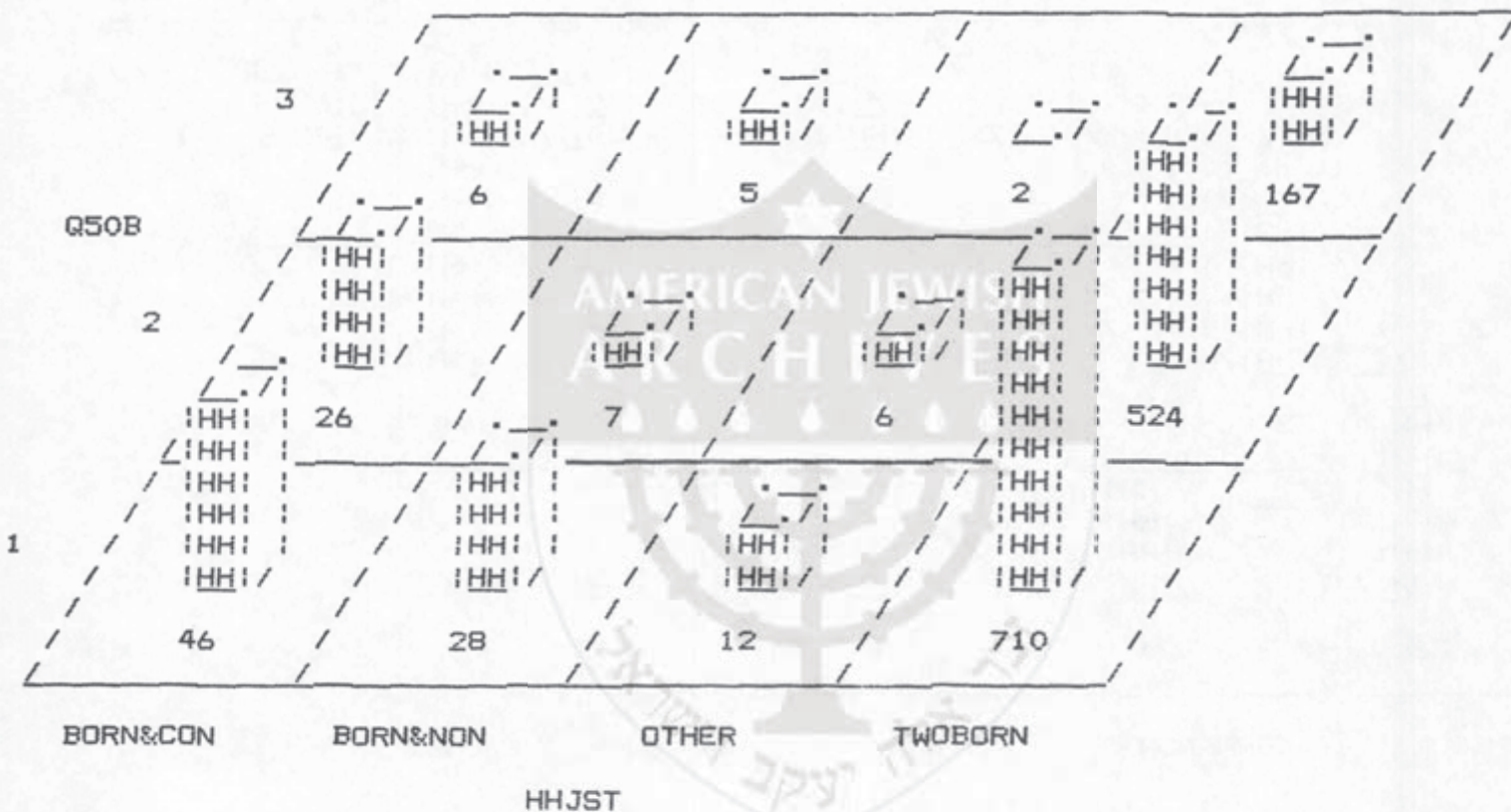




QUESTION 50B: A RABBI SHOULD OFFICIATE AT A MIXED MARRIAGE IF

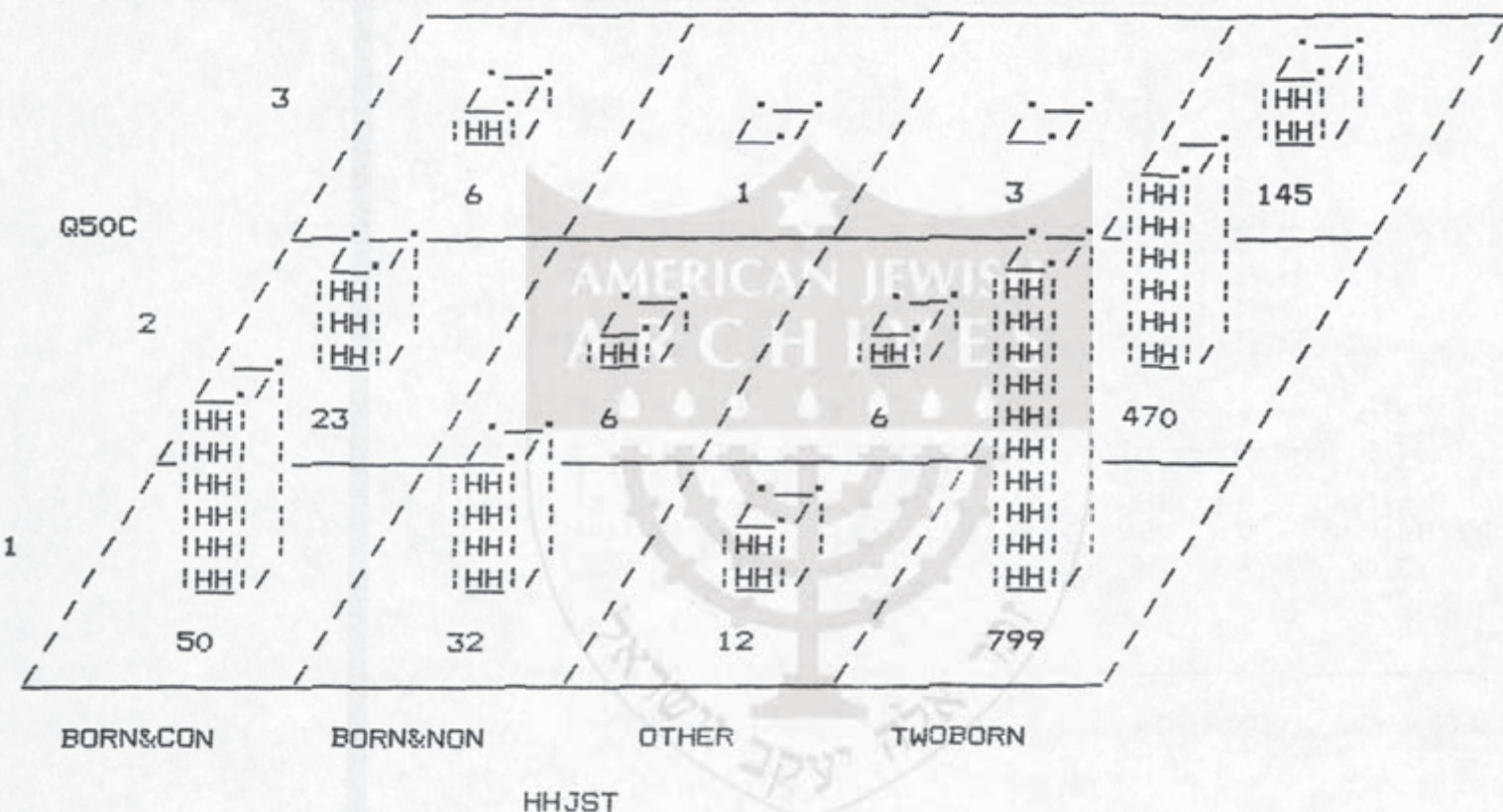




QUESTION 50C: A RABBI SHOULD OFFICIATE AT A MIXED MARRIAGE IF

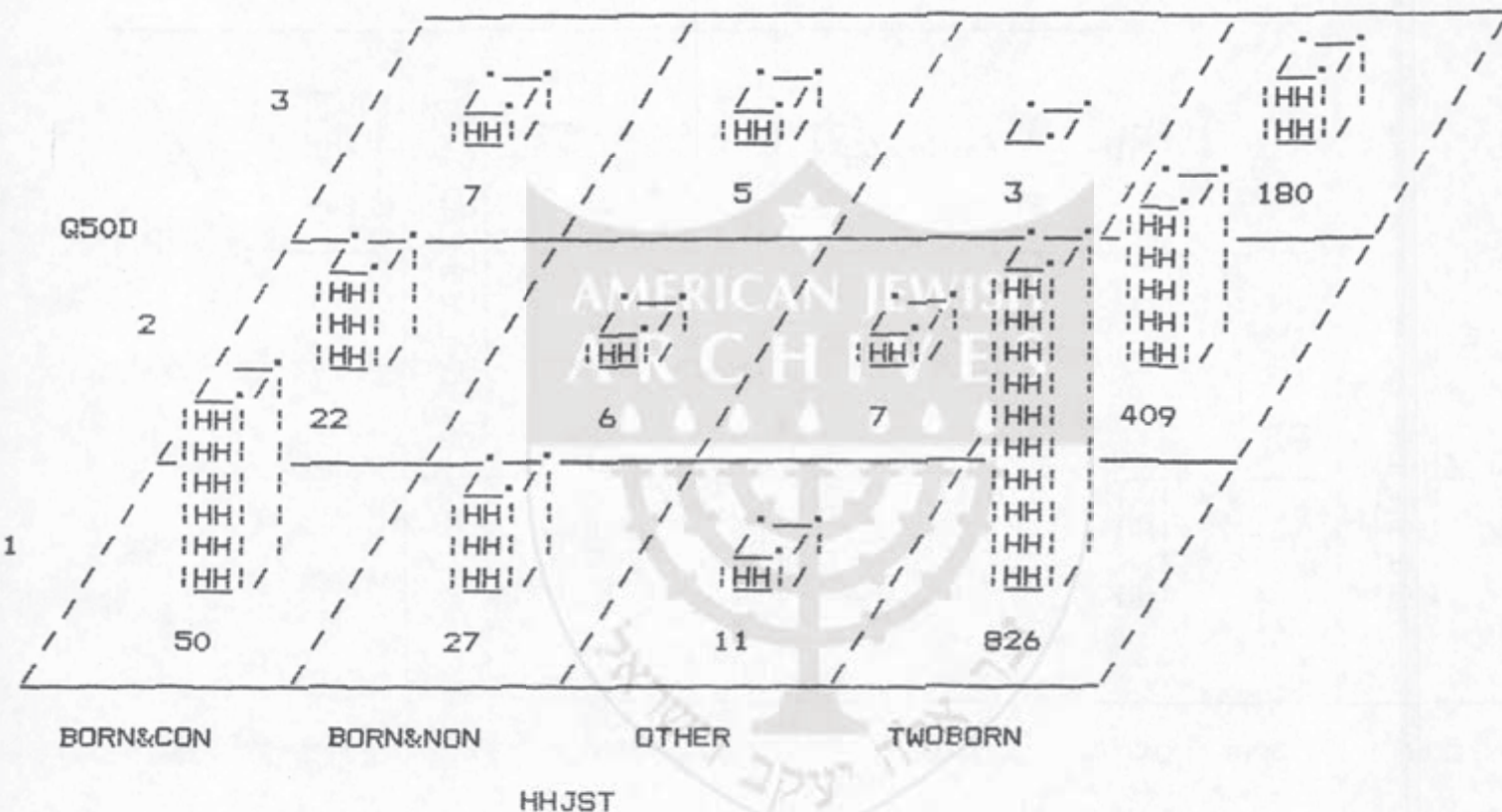

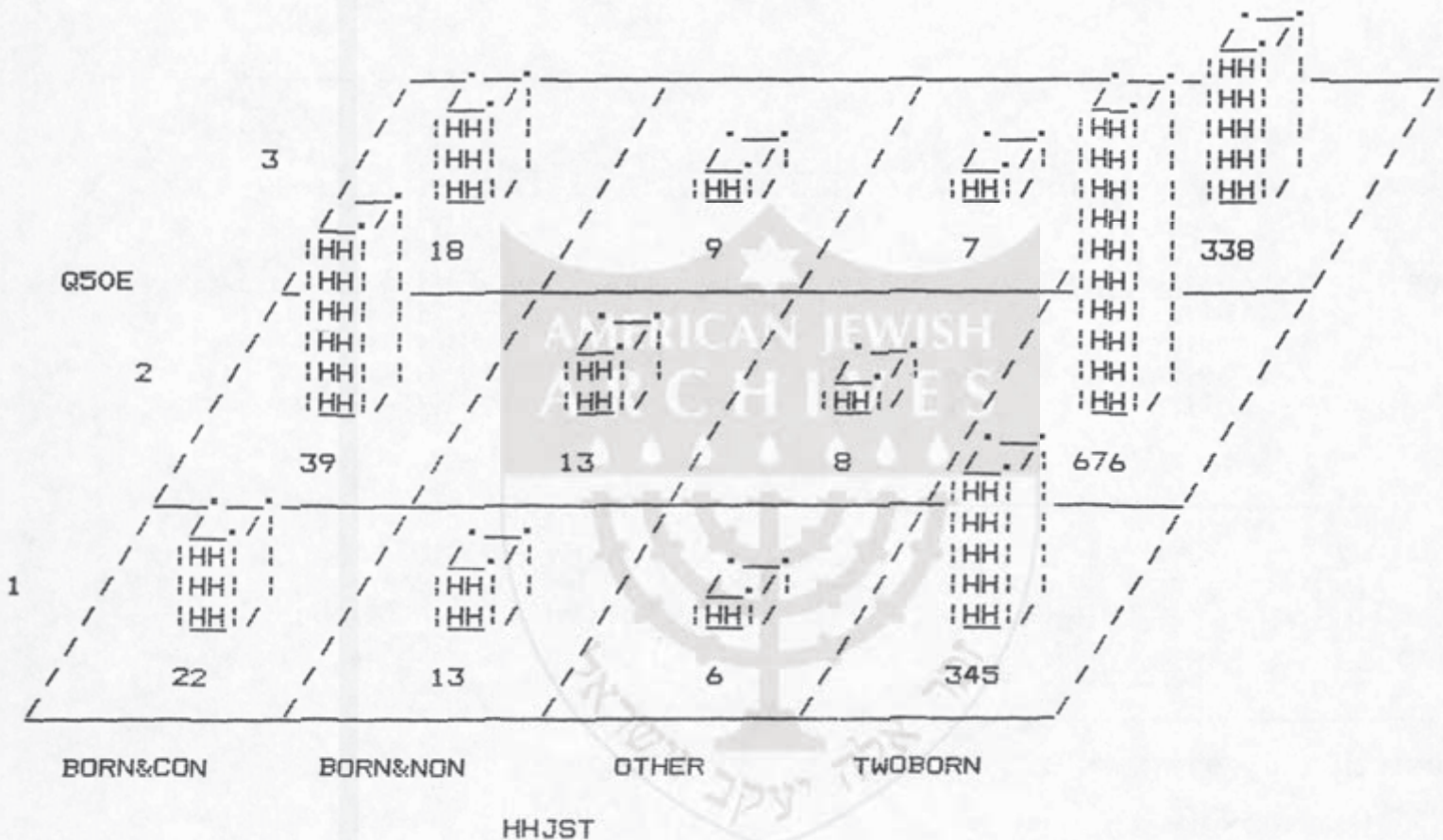




QUESTION 50E: A RABBI SHOULD OFFICIATE AT A MIXED MARRIAGE IF

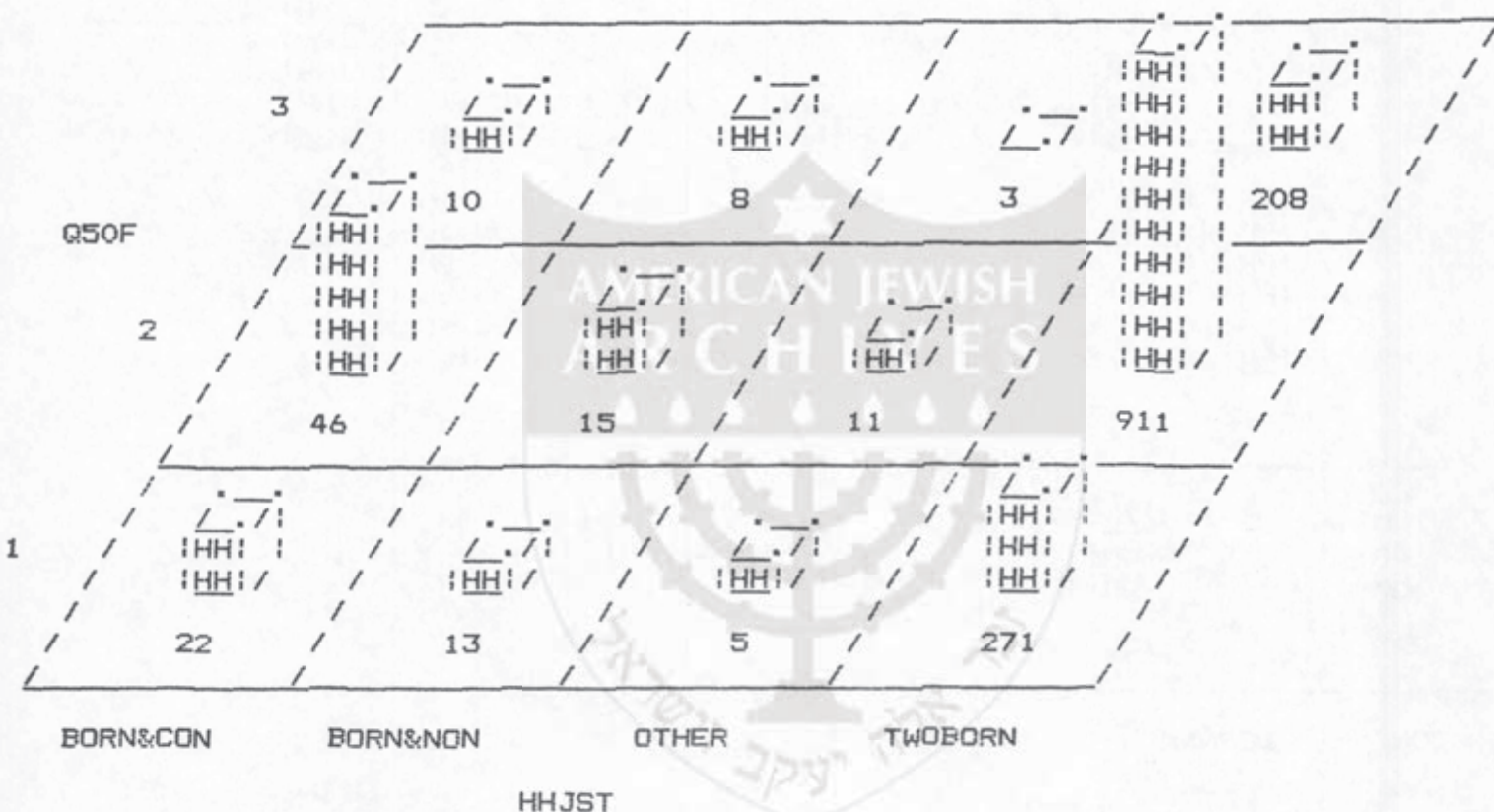




QUESTION 50F: A RABBI SHOULD OFFICIATE AT A MIXED MARRIAGE IF

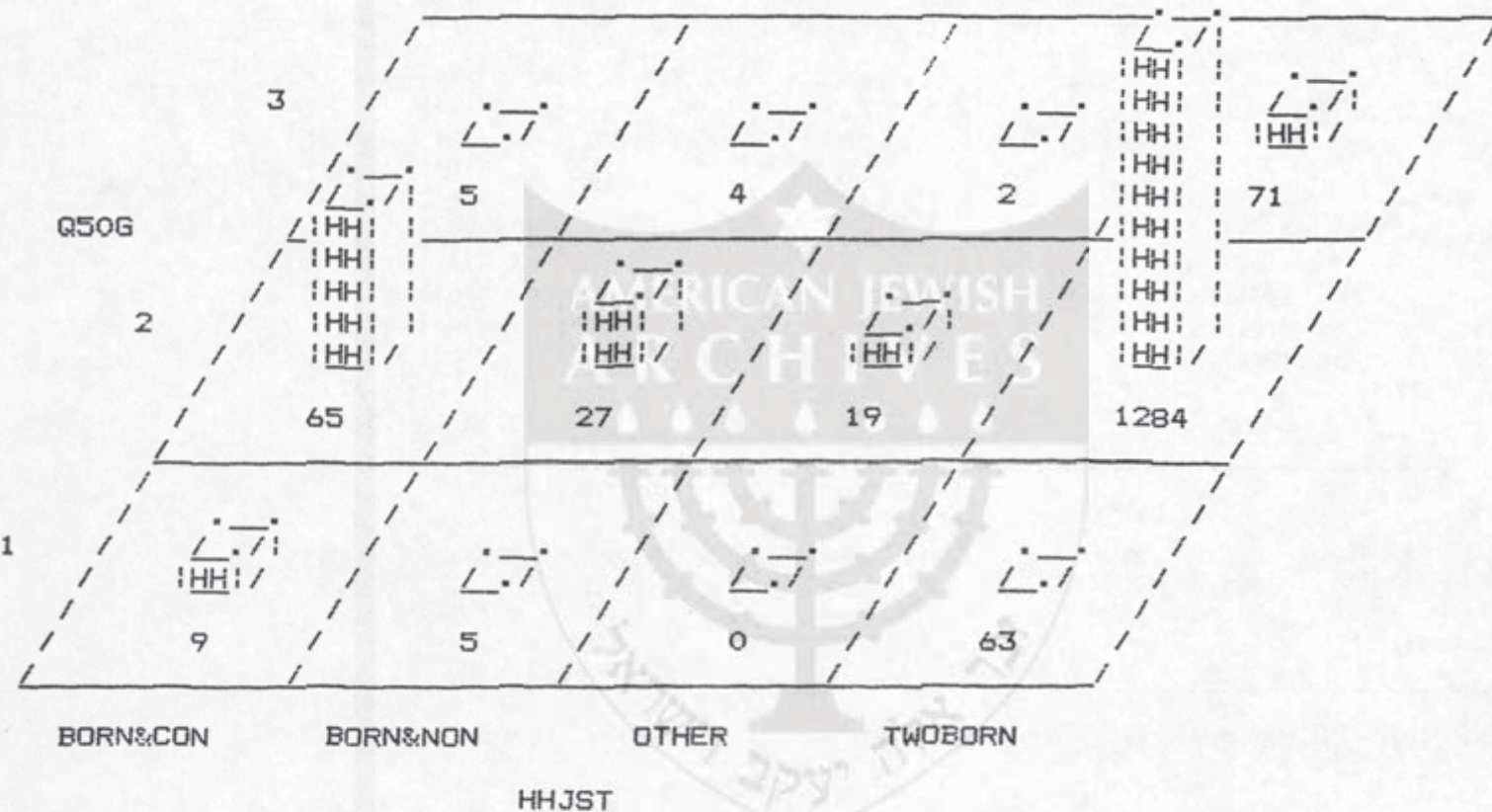

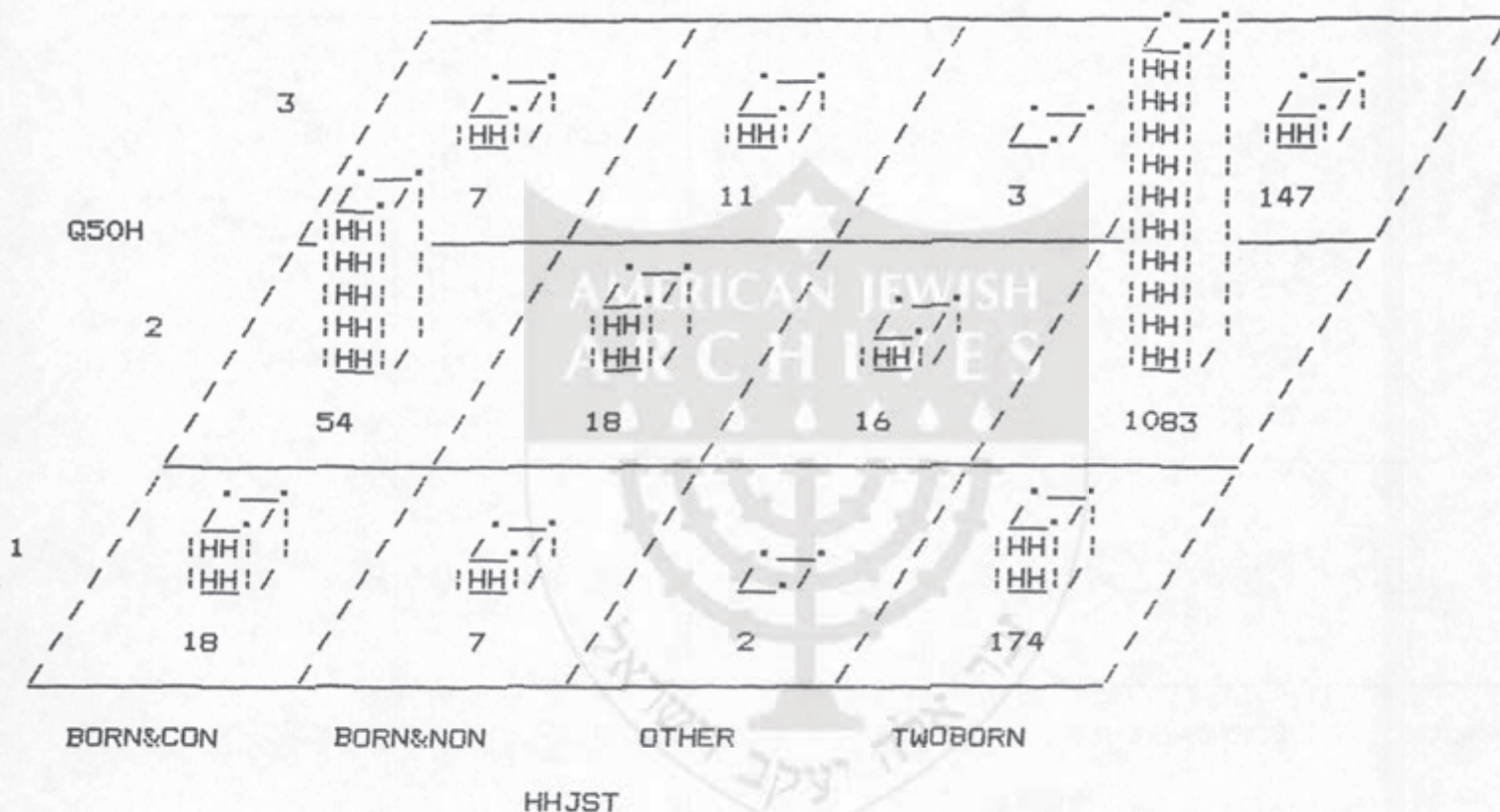




QUESTION 50H: A RABBI SHOULD OFFICIATE AT A MIXED MARRIAGE IF

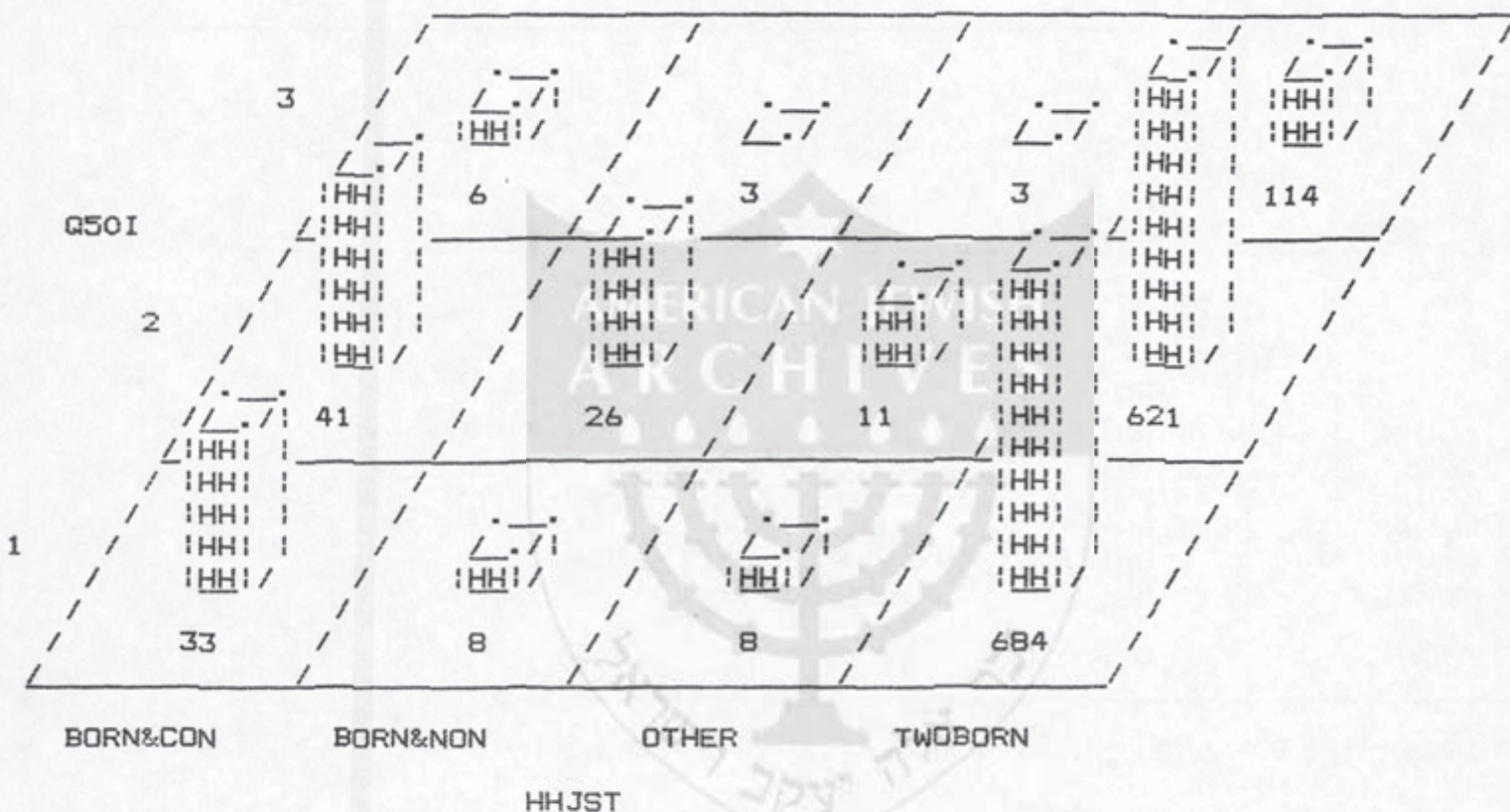

1=YES, 2=NO, 3=DONT KNOW

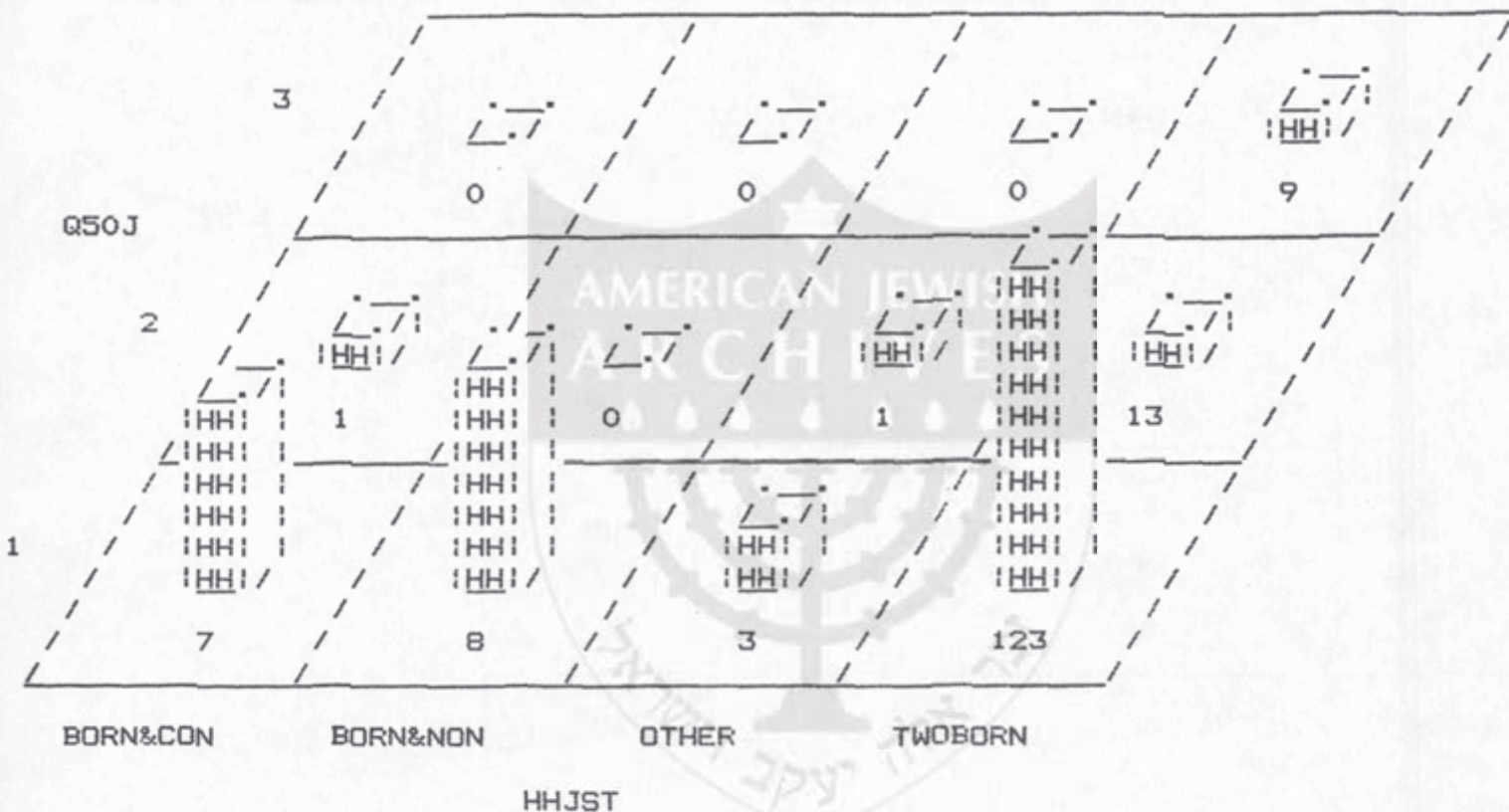

Subject Budget For Research

Alex and Bob: The question of Research Task Force budget projections in my other memo raises the more basic question of whether research should be accorded a place as a specific line item, as a departmental-programmatic aspect of UAHC activity or continue to be predicated upon successful fundraising endeavors. While I think the latter is essential, it seems to me that the role of research is sufficiently important to merit a more definitive place in our table of organization.

We are about to create a Task Force on the Jewish Family. This also will require budget. One of our goals is to undertake an indepth survey of congregations in an effort to ascertain what is the family structure of congregations. Although coming under the new Task Force's jurisdiction, it is also a matter of research and is not included in the projected expenditures listed in the other memo. I look forward to hearing from you regarding these matters.

The Union has expended, through the accounts receivable system, approximately \$11,000 to fund the Research Task Force for the period February 1, 1985 through June 30, 1985. Expenses are scheduled to continue up to an authorized limit of \$25,000.

Your January 2, 1985 memo to Sandy Seltzer, indicates that a special fund raising committee will raise the required \$25,000 or, failing that, the College-Institute, CCAR and the Union will equally share expenses. I have some questions concerning the project:

1. Has an effort been organized to raise the money? What is the time table? I presume Sandy is leading the fund raising effort, but his comments at the capital gifts meeting concerning the funding of this project were detached and not at all encouraging.
2. In what form is the cost sharing agreement between the Union, Conference and the College? Is there a letter agreement?

Assuming that the fund raising effort will not produce any significant income until year end at the earliest, can we request that our partners contribute their share, either in full, or at least in part, now?

Alex, let me know with whom I should speak, to ensure that the Research Task Force does not become an unfunded project.

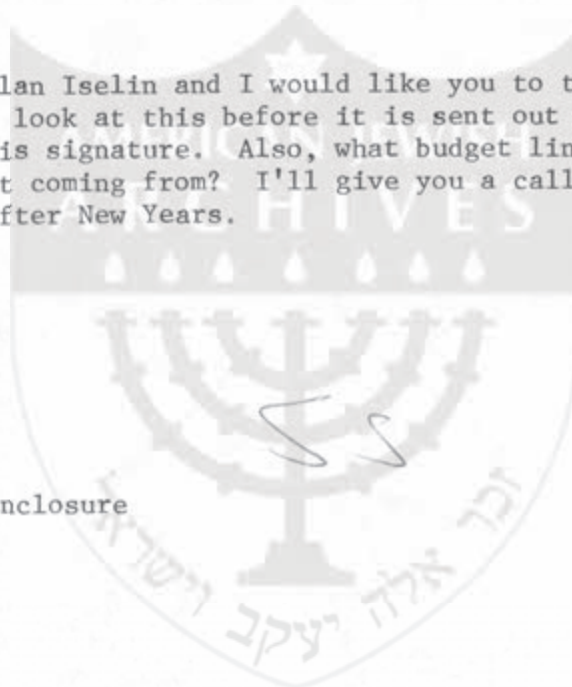

I am delighted to inform you that the Research Task Force Steering Committee has unanimously approved your appointment as Project Director for our projected study on Interfaith Marriage. In said capacity, your responsibilities would include a) compiling an up-to-date bibliography of all available information regarding interfaith marriage and its implications for Reform Judaism, b) guiding and coordinating the efforts of the design subcommittee in setting the parameters for the research to be done, c) developing an appropriate survey questionnaire along with other components of the design instrument, d) writing the research proposal to be presented to the full Research Task Force at its forthcoming June meeting.

The Steering Committee has approved the following financial arrangement: A stipend not to exceed \$12,000 as your salary and a sum not to exceed \$13,000 for expenses incurred in the course of your research. The latter would include employing a research assistant, telephone, computer, travel, etc.

The above arrangement will conclude with the 1985 UAHC Biennial Convention in Los Angeles, October 31-November 5, 1985 in the course of which you would present the full Research proposal to the Biennial for its approval. In response to your letter of April 20, I, too, am sorry that we didn't have a chance to see each other the week before last at the Task Force meeting.

As for the question you raise, I don't think that a general rule can be established. This will have to be decided on an ad hoc basis. There is certain information which will be sought which must perforce remain in the hands of the Task Force for final disposition. For instance, if we should determine to investigate what the effects of the rabbi's participation or non-participation in a mixed marriage are, the results of such a study should certainly remain in the hands of the Task Force; it is the Task Force which will decide whether to release these results publicly and what to do about them. The results of other studies can well be shared by the Task Force on the one hand and the scholars doing the research on the other.

Upon my return home last night we were pleased to receive your greeting for Yom Tov contained on the telephone tape. Dee and I heartily reciprocate your and Rhea's kind wishes.

I missed you by minutes at the Task Force meeting but got a good synoptic view of what transpired, and several of us stayed on to work out some other details. I now understand why you wrote your letter to me. I am somewhat concerned by some of the unresolved questions that need to be addressed, such as structure, budget, and dynamics of function. While we worked on some of the questions over lunch, I believe a great deal more needs to be done; otherwise, confusion will reign. The foremost question that needs to be answered is whether the research team is to address itself to questions that need to be resolved, or merely to research problems to which others will address themselves. In other words, does the team have a vested interest in the solution of the questions that they are researching, or are they only a fact-finding group which will remit their findings to another body for resolution. Since we are at this stage mixed together, with the exception of an Executive Operating Committee, this problem may resolve itself in a functional way, but then again it may not. In any event, it needs to be watched.

As the Executive Committee of the Union Board meeting ended, I came across Gunther Plaut and Mel Merians discussing a discussion guide for the listening post project which had been bruited about at the Task Force on Outreach last year. These listening posts were supposed to be set up around the country to have people come in and talk about mixed marriage and in the process, discussions on rabbinic officiation were to take place. I am sure you recall the proposal.

It soon became clear that Mel believes that this process is to take place under the jurisdiction of the Commission on Outreach, and I immediately attempted to set about disabusing him of that notion, maintaining that the whole subject of mixed marriage had been delegated to the new Task Force on Mixed Marriage which is soon to begin its study under the chairmanship of Alan Iselin, and that the Commission on Outreach was to have nothing more to do with the subject. He disagreed, maintaining that that was not his understanding.

Since you, after consultation with me, were the one who made the proposal both to the Task Force on Outreach and to the CCAR Executive Board that this division take place, you are in the best position to interpret to Mel the meaning of this division, and I hope that you will do so in writing so that the record will be clear.

I won't like to see this cloud return to the outreach work so that the Commission can become fully operational without being hampered by these nagging doubts regarding the question of rabbinic officiation. The obvious place to have these hearings is in the context of the objective inquiry which is going to be made by the study group on mixed marriage in general and rabbinic officiation in particular.

## Studies In Modern Jewish Identity

### Rabbinic Officiation At Mixed Marriages: Implications Regarding Judaism and Jewish Practice On the Part of Mixed Married Couples and Their Children

#### I Overview

This study proposes to examine the effects of rabbinic solemnization of mixed marriages on the subsequent attitudes and religious behavior patterns of Jews and non-Jews who marry and elect to retain their individual religious identities. Recent estimates indicate that upwards of 280,000 Jews marry exogamously.<sup>1</sup> Jewish law (Halacha) expressly forbids rabbis to officiate at such marriages. The Central Conference of American Rabbis, the rabbinic body of American Reform Judaism, has consistently frowned upon its members officiating at such marriages and has called upon reform rabbis not to do so. It has, however, reserved the decision to the individual conscience and interpretation of Judaism of each of its members.

Proponents of rabbinic officiation insist that when a Jew and a non-Jew desiring it are married by a rabbi, the family is saved for Judaism. Its advocates assert further that the refusal of a rabbi to officiate drives a family away from Judaism. But no comprehensive assessment of these claims has ever been undertaken. Critics reply that such actions not only violate traditional Jewish religious standards, thereby creating a further wedge between the reform Jewish community and the remainder of the Jewish people, but that in according official Jewish religious sanction to such marriages, exogamy on the part of Jews is encouraged and assimilation is the logical outgrowth of such practices. Again, no data exist to either corroborate or refute these contentions.

#### II Studies of Exogamous Marriages

Many researchers and sociologists of religion have noted the dearth of information dealing with interfaith marriages and their impact upon the family structure. Thus, Greely writes: "In recent years, little research has been done on either religious identification or religious exogamy."<sup>2</sup> Elsewhere he wonders "whether the maintenance of high levels of denominational homogeneity in marriage has any specifically religious or doctrinal



significance."<sup>3</sup> Alston, McIntosh and Wright, in a survey of their own, confirm Greeley's findings.<sup>4</sup> Those studies that do exist focus primarily upon Protestant - Catholic marriages confirming Joseph Maier's observation that the "consequences of interfaith marriages have not been thoroughly studied. This is true of Jewish - Gentile marriages in particular."<sup>5</sup>

Why the avoidance of the subject in the Jewish academy merits some passing reference. The historic Jewish aversion to mixed marriage may in no small measure account for the situation, a phenomenon that is no longer consonant with Christian ecumenical endeavors, particularly since Vatican II.<sup>6</sup> It may also be reflective of the overall deemphasis of research as a vital tool for needs assessment in the Jewish community. Himmelfarb, for example, comments on the lack of a "single controlled study of a Jewish school innovation or curriculum design which shows that one approach to Jewish instruction is more effective than the other."<sup>7</sup> Huberman puts it even more succinctly: "Unlike pure or basic research, most Jewish communal research takes place in action setting; we are not simply doing research."<sup>9</sup>

Investigations of Protestant - Catholic marriages have shed some light on the religious identities of the children of these marriages. Whether conclusions regarding children of Christian - Jewish marriages can be derived from these findings are potential areas of additional scrutiny. Salisbury reports that children of Catholic - Protestant marriages tend to identify as Catholics by a two to one margin. His research further reveals that children were prone to follow the religion of the mother if she were Catholic rather than Protestant.<sup>9</sup> Saunders found a direct correlation between the rate of mixed marriage within particular Protestant denominations and that denomination's stance on the subject of ecumenism.<sup>10</sup> In their study of religious attitudes among Catholics, Hoge, McGuire and Stratman caution that children of mixed marriages are more likely to enter such marriages themselves in adulthood.<sup>11</sup>

In a survey of 218 Episcopal - Roman Catholic marriages, the respondents reported that "unlike their parents, the children have no background roots to identity and are less able to find a real spiritual home in either church."<sup>12</sup> By contrast, Baber reports that in Jewish - Gentile marriages, children are raised as Jews in far greater numbers than either as Protestants or Catholics. "Does this," he asks, "mean that the father prevails on the assumption that the Jewish partner is more often the husband?"<sup>13</sup>

In none of the aforementioned studies, however, is any reference made to the role of the clergyperson officiating at the couple's wedding as a determinant of subsequent religious attitudes.

### III Methodology

An appropriate questionnaire will be designed in accordance with prescribed sociological standards and in consultation with recognized experts in the field. The instrument will be modeled on examples already available in the Jewish and non-Jewish communities. Rabbis who officiate at mixed marriages will be asked to submit the names of couples whom they have married. No less than 50 and no more than 300 couples so designated will be sent the questionnaire. A like number of mixed married couples will be recruited randomly in the community.

Each partner in the marriage will be asked to respond individually to the questionnaire. Responses will be collated and measured in accordance with appropriate statistical procedures. In addition to the written questionnaire, individual and conjoint interviews will also be scheduled. These will be conducted in participant's homes employing requisite interview protocols. Interviewers will consist of one male and one female who have had previous training and experience in the techniques of interviewing. Once the questionnaire and the personal interviews have been completed and evaluated, the results will be published as part of the Studies In Modern Jewish Identity Series.

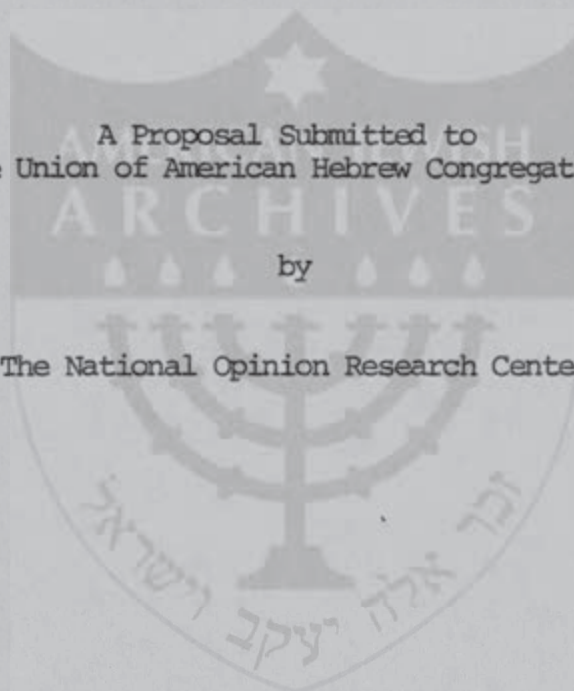

## I. RATIONALE FOR A STUDY OF JEWISH INTERMARRIAGE

Although there have been many hypotheses concerning the effects of intermarriage on the state of Jewish culture and identity within contemporary society, there has been little empirical data against which to examine these hypotheses. One of the principal drawbacks of the usual kind of sample, is that it severely under-represents those who are unconnected and distant from the Jewish community. In order to analyze the impact of various aspects of intermarriage it is necessary to have a large enough sample of respondents, including those who may be quite alienated from their tradition. To this end we are proposing to collect data from a sample of 500 intermarried couples who are living in one or more North American metropolitan area.

This study is being proposed as a pilot project with two goals. First, to be able to examine empirically the effect of intermarriage upon the retention and support for Jewish culture and identity, and second to design a methodology for studying intermarriage that can be used in other metropolitan areas where Jewish communities may be interested in studying the effects of this increasingly common occurrence.

At least four important characteristics of these intermarriages will be examined to test some of the more prevalent hypotheses about the dynamic and effects of mixed marriages. First, the effect of having or not having a rabbi

officiate at the marriage will be statistically examined by comparison of the population as divided into these two groups. It has been hypothesized that having a rabbi officiate is an important factor in the retention of Jewish culture and identity. Marriages that have had rabbis officiate are speculated to be those in which the family will be more supportive of Judaism as the children grow, and all in all will provide a more supportive atmosphere for the continuation of Jewish culture. Or to state the hypothesis in the negative, since approximately 40 percent of marriages involving Jews are mixed, the policy of not having rabbinic officiation at such marriages is actually counter-productive to the retention and nurturance of Jewish culture. Since our sampling will be sufficiently large to allow us to have a subgroup of people whose marriages were not presided over by a rabbi, we will be able to ascertain with both objective and subjective measures the differential impact of having a rabbi present or not having a rabbi present at the ceremony. We will also be able to discover whether any other religious functionary officiated together with or instead of a rabbi and whether that factor made any difference. A salient question is whether the couple was already well away from being in contact with Judaism and therefore did not seek a rabbi, and would not even if they could have - or whether the difficulty in having a rabbi present was in itself a factor in their moving away from Jewish identification.

Second there will be a section of items concerning the respondent couple's social and religious background. This will include items about family characteristics of each of the spouses, especially parent characteristics. In addition there will be data gathered about the contextual factors surrounding the way in which the couple met and went through their courtship period. The kinds of obstacles they had to face or the feelings



about their relationship which emanated from their families, will also be examined. We will try to establish whether there was a positive or negative or neutral context associated with the way in which the mixed marriage started off. This is an important variable in estimating how the mixed religious nature of the marriage affects the retention of Jewish culture and identity.

Third there will be items about the couples' attitudes and feelings about Judaism which will allow us to find out if these factors have changed over the course of the marriage. This can be done in two ways. One is to ask retrospective questions about people's feelings and behavior before they were married or while they were adolescents, and compare those responses with their current attitudes. A second way is to compare those in the sample who have been married for only a short while with those who have been married longer, to see the effects of duration on the issues of culture and identity. The principal advantage for having a large sample for this type of analysis is that we will be able to use both approaches in analyzing this important issue. Methodologically this allows for a convergence of research findings which enables us to produce stronger interpretations.

Finally there will be questions about the couple's attitudes and behaviors concerning the rearing of their children. These items will focus on the ways in which Jewish culture and identity are considered within the family and whether or not there is any attempt to pass them along to the next generation. Salient questions would be "under what circumstances of mixed marriage do people still feel the desire for transmitting their culture to their children." One methodological consideration would be to select the sample in such a way as to have a sizeable group of couples old enough to have children. We have done this before with family samples and it is a very successful technique for generating cross-generational data.

## II. METHODOLOGY

### A. Overview


This study will emphasize instrument development and the analysis of the dynamics of intermarriage rather than the prevalence and incidence of mixed marriages for two reasons. First, the cost of assessing incidence and prevalence would be prohibitive and probably unjustified since the methodology for the instrumentation is as yet undeveloped. Second, the crucial questions to be asked right now are not especially those of generalized incidence and prevalence of mixed marriages, but rather those which will allow us to assess the 'meaning' of mixed marriages for the future. How do people deal with their religious and cultural differences within these intimate relationships? What is the implication of that for their own value system as well as that of their children? These are questions of the dynamic that must be assessed before a more general study can be done, which is the limited goal of this pilot project. To accomplish this goal we propose to do a mail survey, preceded by a telephone induction interview.

### B. Sampling

Considerable thought has been given to the sampling strategy for this study. A random-digit-dialing screening interview administered to adults at computer selected telephone numbers would be the most accurate estimating tool, but in order to find mixed marriages we would have to screen too many numbers for the design to be within reasonable cost as a pilot study. (We estimate telephone charges alone to be about \$42,000 using WATS lines, for such a design.) Self-selected respondents from lists or from youth groups have the liability of possibly containing biases that can not be controlled. The alternative is a 'snowball' sample by which intermarried couples will be



recruited into the study by other respondents and informants. Jewish outreach groups in the test area(s) will be the initial starting point. A list of 200 known mixed marriages will be developed with the assistance of UAHC and contacted by telephone. If a respondent couple is successfully recruited into the sample they will then be asked to recommend other couples for the study. In order to maximize diversity of the sample, we can ask for example "how do you happen to know this couple?" and provide a pre-coded list developed on the basis of the pretest. This list might include:



Relative  
Neighbor  
School  
Work place  
Voluntary association  
Church or Synagogue, etc.

We could then develop a hierarchy in terms of "closeness" and select on the basis of social distance. An additional question might be the approximate age group of the couple within 20 years, i.e. 20-40, 40-60, and 60 +. The ability to select both older and younger couples will enable analysis in terms of inter-generational issues. The snowball sample technique has all the problems of self-selection, but has the advantage of generating a sample of mixed marriages quite efficiently. For purposes of this pilot study we plan on completing interviews with a sample of approximately 500 couples. The sample will be followed up in order to obtain a response rate of approximately 80 percent.

The table below indicates our assumptions: We start with a list of 200 intermarried couples and complete 80 percent, to yield 160 cases. This group is asked to identify other intermarried couples and we assume that they identify an average of two such couples each, which yields 320 additional couples. Of this group we again complete 80 percent, which yields 256 more cases. This group in turn identifies an average of two couples for a total of 512 couples, of which we complete 80 percent or 409 cases. If none of these couples named each other, this would yield 825 couples. Clearly this is unlikely to occur. Assuming an overall overlap of 25 percent, or 1 in 4, we will identify 619 unique couples to complete 500 cases at a response rate of 80.1 percent.

#### C. Instrument Development

A pretest sample of approximately 25 couples will be selected from outreach programs or other group contacts and will be given the interview



schedule to complete to test the instrumentation as well as the underlying hypotheses of the study. A few such couples, diverse in demographic characteristics, will be asked to participate in a debriefing with the research team, comprising the principal investigators as well as client consultants. The comments and reactions of the pretest couples are likely to provide invaluable feedback concerning the way in which the crucial issues of the study are being approached.

D. Data Analysis

The final report of the project will consist of a monograph of 75 to 100 pages and an executive summary of 15 to 20 pages containing the highlights of the findings. The final report will be delivered 12 months after the beginning of the project and a preliminary report will be available within approximately 10 months. The final report will be organized around the four central issues of rabbinic officiation, social and religious background, attitudes toward Judaism, and transmission of cultural and religious values.

### III. INSTRUMENT DEVELOPMENT AND PRETESTING

#### A. Introduction

Successful execution of the proposed study will depend heavily upon the instrument and procedures that are employed. The instruments must be designed to elicit data that are complete, accurate and unambiguous.

Instrument design will be based on the hypotheses to be examined, and will draw on previously tested questions where appropriate, with careful attention to principles of design and wording of questions.

#### B. Instruments

Three instruments will be developed:

##### 1. Telephone Induction Questionnaire

A brief telephone induction questionnaire to be administered in all initial sample households as well as newly identified households. This questionnaire will introduce the sponsoring organization (NORC), briefly describe the study and ask whether there is a married couple in the household consisting of a Jewish and non-Jewish spouse, and whether they would agree to participate in the study. If so, we will ask for name, address and telephone number.

##### 2. Born Jewish Spouse Questionnaire

This will be a self-administered mail-questionnaire dealing with general aspects of intermarriage but containing some questions that are relevant only to respondents who were born Jews.



### 3. Born Non-Jewish Spouse Questionnaire

This will in most respects be the identical questionnaire as the one for the born Jewish spouse, but containing some questions relevant only to respondents who were born non-Jewish.

### C. Instrument Design Process

There are several steps that will be followed in the instrument design process:

1. Review of prior instrumentation. To ensure that the proposed project makes full use of previous research, the instrument development staff will review questions developed in other projects--both NORC instruments and those developed by others. Making certain data items equivalent with previous work will increase the utility and comparability of project findings.

2. Design and wording of questions. NORC questionnaire design is based on the principle that the instrument should be as simple, logical and self-explanatory as possible and that the purpose of each question has been carefully thought through. To insure valid and reliable data, it is essential that all respondents readily and uniformly understand questions and answer categories.

In designing questionnaires, it is NORC policy also to meet the needs of data processing. To this end, data processing personnel participate in instrument development and review the questionnaire to make data processing easier and more efficient.

3. Dealing with sensitive questions. NORC has developed methods for "de-fusing" questions about potentially sensitive areas such as feelings about the meaning of intermarriage, attitudes about religious belief, income and the

like. One technique is to sequence questions in such a way that the respondent will naturally be led to thinking about the answers by the logical flow of questions, so that a sensitive area is approached in a neutral and matter-of-fact manner.

Methodological research and NORC's experience both indicate that certain kinds of neutral declarative lead-ins to questions can help clarify the focus of a question, give the respondent time to think out the answer, and help soften the impact of a question about a potentially sensitive subject.

#### D. The Pretest

The pretest will be conducted out of NORC's New York office using the Metropolitan area of New York as the field test site for the interviews. Selection of cases will be consistent with the sampling plan developed for the main survey, within the obvious limitations of scale. Supervision of the pretest will be carried out by the same person who will oversee data collection for the main survey.

In general, the pretest will focus on three areas of concern:

- o Sample Identification
- o Questionnaire content, and
- o Response Rate

##### 1. Sample Identification

We plan to ask individuals whether they themselves are partners of an intermarriage and once their completed cases have been received we will contact respondents again and ask whether they know of other couples who may be partners of a Jewish/non-Jewish marriage. While a skillfully designed induction instrument administered by trained telephone interviewers is likely to be able to identify the sample, we expect to learn from the pretest whether



our suppositions regarding the take-rate are accurate, and whether respondents have any concerns about identifying themselves or their relatives and friends as intermarried couples.

## 2. Questionnaire Content

Pre-testing the contents of self-administered instruments poses some special problems which we will approach as follows: after contacting eligible respondent couples by telephone we will make an appointment for an interviewer to visit their home and hand them the questionnaires for self-administration. The interviewer will then observe the respondents completing the instrument while encouraging them to ask if either questions or skip instructions are unclear. The interviewer herself will take notes on problem questions or areas. After the questionnaires are filled out the interviewer will encourage the respondents to discuss the questionnaire in terms of overall reaction, ambiguity, level of difficulty and the like.

Pretesting is done only by the most experienced NORC interviewers who are sensitive to the subtlest nuances of questionnaire structure, design and content. It is not unusual also for the survey director in charge of instrument development to complete some interviews or do some field observations in order to catch every possible design problem. We will complete 10 "in-person" pretest cases of the mail-out questionnaire.

## 3. Response Rate

We will define a completed case as comprising two interviews, that is, one completed by the born Jewish spouse and one completed by the born non-Jewish spouse. For the main study we are postulating an 80 percent response rate -- that is, we will continue induction screening until we have identified 619 intermarried couples, from whom we expect to receive 500 completed cases (1000 interviews).

To test the mail response rate in the pretest we will mail out 20 sets of questionnaires with the expectation of having 16 cases completed by mail.

Based on past experience we regard our expectations of an 80 percent response rate to the mail questionnaire as realistic. Although mail surveys are notorious for their low-return rate, we feel that a combination of factors will enable us to achieve our goal of 80 percent. The target population is likely to be disproportionately well-educated -- dealing with a complex set of instructions does not appear forbidding to this group; the topic has high salience for many intermarried couples; the sponsor of the survey is a university based, not-for-profit research center; and, ultimately we will use all our considerable techniques of persuasion, from making reminder phone calls, to sending out new questionnaires, and if all else fails, completing some of the interviews by telephone. For budgeting purposes we have estimated that 60 percent of the 619 cases will be completed by mail and 20 percent by telephone.

The pretest will help establish the right combination of procedures and techniques to be employed in the main survey to achieve the desired response rate.

#### E. Debriefing

A formal debriefing session will be held following the pretest attended by the principal investigators, client consultants and the survey operations staff, as well as four pretest couples who will be offered a token respondent fee of \$25.00. At the debriefing session the data collection instruments will be reviewed. The debriefing will also be a thorough discussion among all staff involved in the pretest focusing on the utility of the data collection instruments, administrative forms and procedures, as well as the level of



cooperation by respondents. Particular attention will be paid to the timing of the various sections of the questionnaire, sequencing of data items and appropriateness of question wording, particularly for questions newly developed for the proposed survey.

Based upon the pretest experience, the survey instruments will be revised. Revisions will take the form of reordering data items, adding or revising code categories, rewording questions for clarity or to reduce respondent effects, and clarifying questionnaire instructions. Such revisions will be undertaken in consultation with and subject to the review of the principal investigators and the client.

#### F. Procedural Manuals

The pretest will also supply material suitable for inclusion in the interviewer specifications and in the training materials for the main survey. The interviewer manual will include two principal sections: administrative procedures and question-by-question specifications.

The administrative procedures section will cover all major topics pertinent to the study, such as the purpose of the study, sampling design, materials to be used by the interviewer, as well as describe and explain interviewer assignment procedures, editing instructions, reporting procedures, and related forms and documents.

Question-by-question specifications will instruct the interviewer on the purpose of the individual questions and highlight specific skip patterns and interviewing instructions. This information will be useful for those cases that will be administered by phone, and for data retrieval of incomplete questionnaires. The manual is used as an ongoing reference during the field period.
