Text of Telex received at this Embassy from President Sadat for transmittal to Ambassador Shriver:

Dear Ambassador Shriver:

Ambassador Ghorbal brought to my attention, when I was at Camp David, your letter of September 1, 1978, with the message of hope expressed by a distinguished group of Muslim, Jewish and Christian religious leaders. That message, addressed to President Carter, to Prime Minister Begin and myself, was a source of great inspiration as well as support in the joint efforts we undertook for the cause of peace and humanity.

If we succeeded at Camp David to build a foundation of peace and hope in the Middle East for all its people, I am sure that the prayers of many, especially those of your friends the religious leaders of the three faiths, have been well heard and received.

Today, as we embark again on translating the Framework for Peace in the Middle East into a vehicle of action to make peace a reality, not only between Egypt and Israel, but also between Israel and all her Arab neighbors, including the people of Palestine, I feel we are sustained by the continuous support of those who care about true peace and love. With your permission, I am sending to each and every member who signed the joint document an expression of my gratitude and warm feelings.

May the God of Abraham, of Moses, of Jesus and Mohamed unite us all in this tremendous undertaking of creating that lasting structure of just and honorable peace.

WITH awe and gratitude we watched and listened to the bold meeting in Jerusalem last November, on a day when the name of Abraham gave a very special glow to the hope for peace, and for an end to human sacrifice. We saw and heard two men opening up new possibilities, liberated by their awareness of being in God's presence and seeking to do his will.

We write now to all three of you in the firm and grateful conviction that, as you gather at Camp David, you will find time and ways to lift up your hearts and minds to God, whose healing presence again and again can quicken your minds and again and again can reinforce your resolve toward peace -- in spite of all obstacles.

As Jews, Christians, and Muslims, belonging with you to the "Peoples of the Book," we write to you, driven by our faith. According to all our traditions peace is more than a dream and a hope. It is not one option among others. The relentless pursuit of peace is a command from God. As teachers of religion we know only too well how easily religions can be misused to build barricades of suspicion, fear, and hatred. Religions yes, but in a true sense God can never be misused, and His name is known among us as Peace.

We speak to you as to men known for courage. Now most especially we expect from you the perhaps greatest courage -- the courage for peace.

And we know that we speak for millions and millions of common people who hunger for peace. With them and for them we speak, and we have learned not to underestimate that hunger and the power of that hunger and of the spoken and unspoken prayers that rise to God out of it.

There can be no true peace without justice, security, and dignity for all. In a true and lasting peace there must be no victors and no vanquished. The dignity of all men and women must be held high. The Golden Rule is known to us all in many forms. One that seems especially timely reads "Let the honor of your neighbor be as precious to you as your own." We do not belittle the obstacles on the road towards such a peace. Nor do we belittle any of the many small steps that are so desperately needed for rebuilding trust which has been eroded by pain and war. On the contrary, we shall hail such steps as precious parts of the healing process towards peace and of your commitment to no more war.

Our three faiths all encourage their faithful to see that in a world like ours it would be unrealistic not to believe in miracles. Therefore, if in your deliberations the impasse seems beyond solution then we plead for one more attempt -- in the name of God who can break the paralysis of fear and even make most reasonable your commitment to no more war.

Dear Rabbi Schindler,

A week ago today I met for the first time the son of a former neighbor, 8 or 9-year-old Steve Leacock, who is, I believe, the best preserved Jewish type I ever came across, and I did come across quite a few, as I have Jewish in my own Family. Yet, little Steve is being brought up in the Catholic faith, only because his mother is Catholic and separated from his father, who is Jewish.

In short, the best preserved Jewish type must, in my opinion, return to the fold, and I telephoned four times his mother during the week, until I finally reached her yesterday afternoon in order to suggest to her that she brings there child to you in order to do all that is to be done for him. She rejected my suggestion at first, but I have reason to hope that she will accept it in the end, particularly because this afternoon I am going to telephone her again in order to tell her that, even if she won't let her perfectly Jewish looking son return to the faith of his paternal ancestors now, he himself will do this later on, as I am sure everybody will tell him always how very Jewish he looks and he will find it strange that he belongs to the Catholic Church.

As you know, I am neither Jewish, nor Catholic, but Romanian-Orthodox. My only concern is that this very good Jewish child will go through too much drama later on, and this can be easily avoided if his mother will let him be what he actually is, right now. I find it totally ridiculous that in our age a perfectly Jewish looking child is being taken every Sunday to the Catholic church, while in fact his plage is in the Jewish synagogue.

1 do hope that one day, years from now, Steve Leacock will have a few words of thanks for me, if we will succeed in bringing him up in the Jewish faith to which he actually belongs.

Dear Rabbi Schindler,

Senator Javits is now doing for my Program what you used to do for it last winter. As you know from Time Magazine of last July 3rd and from other sources, the Senator is very much involved in the USA-Israel problems, and it is obvious that only my Program will actually solve most, if not all problems in this world, which is why the Senator is so very interested in my Program.

For many years now, I worked on a book dealing with the unique contribution made by the Jews to Mankind, and the fact that the Jews are the only people who contributed to it constantly, even in the darkest periods of their history, while other great peoples, like the Greeks for instance, contributed only in certain periods of their history. The above makes the Jews a unique people in this whole wide world. Absolutely unique.

However, both my help to Israel with my unique historic Program for All Nations and my aforementioned book dealing with the uniqueness of the Jewish People are very much in danger because of my Jewish landlord, Edward Pornof and brothers, who own Lincoln square Hotel of the aforementioned address, and who are by all means the worst people anyone could possibly ever come across: For more than two months now, my letters and the letters of this USA-owned Foundation have been stolen, and the manager of the hotel, who is a Christian, UNIN fat. doesn't make any secret that he hates me and that he has my letters and the letters of this Foundation and can do whatever he pleases with them. These letters come from The Trilateral Commission and from all foreign Governments that wrote to me during the recent Special Session on Disarmament at the United Nations Organization. All of them never reached me, and the landlord, instead of firing his aforementioned mentally derranged manager, is actually letting him harass me, steal my mails, be rude with me; and even make the other employees act against me all the time, as a gang set out to terrorize me. ALL tenants are very much against this landlord, who four years ago had an employee, one Jackson, who killed 7 or 8 old women in an-other hotel of his, Park Royal of West 77th Street in Manhattan, as everyone read in the newspapers. Such a landlord should never be allowed to conduct business in any country, and the above attitude toward me only proves that he is actually guilty for having had a monster killer like Jackson in his employ, the same way he is keeping new on the job another montally demanded apployee as mentioned now on the job another mentally derranged employee, as mentioned above. Unless you will ask Edward Pornof's rabbi to explain to him that USA is not the jungle he believes it is, all my years-long work in favor of Israel and USA and the Jews everywhere will come to noin USA thing. Edward Pornof's telephone here at this hotel is: TR 3.3000. His rabbi will most probably find a way to convince him that he will end up very very badly if he goes on like this, and that he will do a great deal of damage to All Jews everywhere. 

Dear Mr. Edwards:

Thank you for sharing with me your proposal for a program of "new strategic and tactifal methods of readically reducing assimiliation." I am grateful for your concern and for the outline of your plan.

The American Jewish community is a complex one with a number of "umbrella" organizations which deal with particular areas of Jewish life and concern. In seeking to maintain Judaism and enrich and enhance the Jewish knowledge and commitment of our people I believe that the synagogue is the central body to undertake the task and another "super agency" is not, to my mind, a viable approach. Indeed, many of the projects you outline are extant within the religious community and individual synagogues, as well as organizations such as the Union of American Hebrew Congregations for the Reform Movement, through youth and college programs, adult aducation, camping, etc. Many secular Jewish organizations also have fine programs geared to education, camping experiences and the like. But I am firm in my commitment to the centrality of the synagogue to Jewish life and thought.

Dear Rabbi Schindler,

Attached is the bare outline of that 'major operational proposal....outlining totally new strategic and tactical methods of radically reducing assimilation' I referred to in my March 16th letter to you.

To tackle the problem of reducing assimilation does not lie in my simply 'writing a book' or an article. It involves a comprehensive development program, following through on the project much in the manner and function of management consultants, though the problem itself is far more complex and difficult than any business question. It means working closely with the existing leadership and organization structures of the American and world Jewish communities, assisting them in developing an operational plan to initiate and sustain the changes necessary to achieve a major strengthening of the American Jewish community's strategic position in the United States, and stopping the hemorrhage of assimilation.

The years spent in an advisory capacity to the Prime Minister, among other matters connected with the Arab/Israeli conflict, were financed by myself and amounted to a very considerable sum. Therefore, if this project is to be pursued outside funding will now have to be obtained.

The question to be answered is this: would you be willing to introduce me to an individual(s) who would be in a position to fund this project. As I wrote in my letter. 'I am aware of the generally institutional and structured nature of Jewish support and funding - and that usually most men of substance who give of their treasure to Israel and to other areas of importance to the Jewish community are already 'fully committed' as far as they had planned. Yet this project warrants an exception.' For it appears that 'truly effective long-term actions that really would come to grips with the assimilation problem have not yet been put forward.'

To protect my proprietary interest in this proposal would you consider the outline confidential and not let it out of your hands. It is submitted to you for evaluation only at this stage, to determine whether you will recommend this project to private sources for funding. After my work has been funded, an expanded and detailed

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proposal will then be available for submission to the Jewish leadership.

The proposal is highly unconventional but it is no academic exercise. It is a carefully constructed and deeply thought through practical program intended for specific action and based upon deep-rooted Jewish national/religious/political/emotional needs and Jewish strategic goals.

I am aware of the many demands on your time yet I hope you will be able to read the outline in its entirety yourself. For it is your perceptions, judgment and support that is sought.

Having worked directly with Yitzhak Rabin for some years designing unconventional yet wholly pragmatic solutions to the Arab/Israeli conflict, among other matters also connected with the conflict, and having talked about the subject of this letter with him late last October, it has been recommended that I meet with you to discuss how a major operational proposal that I have constructed, outlining totally new strategic and tactical methods for radically reducing assimilation, can be funded. It was your broad acquaintance with the American Jewish community and the respect in which you are held by it that prompted this recommendation.

A series of proposals designed for action now in the formative stages - has been developed out of research undertaken for my main work with the Arab/ Israeli conflict these past eight years. They concern a specific practical program of change in the American Jewish community geared to improve the strategic position of that community and reverse the continuing and increasing trend toward assimilation which is fast approaching crisis proportions. The problem of assimilation leading to a severe erosion of the Jewish population in America has been eloquently described in many forums yet it would appear that truly effective long-term actions that really would come to grips with the problem have not yet been put forward.

It has been suggested that the work necessary for this to be fully developed and effectively pursued can best be facilitated through a wealthy individual(s) with a profound interest in this crucial problem facing American Jewry. I am aware of the generally institutional and structured nature of Jewish support and funding and that usually most men of substance who give of their treasure to Israel and to other areas of importance to the Jewish community are already 'fully committed' as far as they had planned. The Guests leaving the theater: They will meet again in the foyer of the theater and comment to each other on the Play itself.

The Reception offered by us in honor of all Heads of State. Ray Charles and Jose Feliciano, the two great blind singers, symbolising the entire mankind that goes on piling bombs upon bombs, will sing "THE IMPOSSIBLE DREAM" in all languages, mean-ing the dream of all Mankind. Other top entertainers, Frank Sinatra, Bing Crosby, Bob Hope will join the two blind singers in a truly entertaining and deeply meaningful evening which will be shown on the screen as much as possible. be shown on the screen as much as possible.

The other three unique historical World Summits will be done on the same TV-Format as above. A great deal of quick, deep comments or laughs, often deep, will be heard all throughout. A United Nations address will take place in each World Summit . / Mar Mart

I am enclosing a peace plan that I will predict can heal the rift between Israel and America-if it is does not then it is fairly obvious that America has more important things to wo**rry** about than the security of Israel; in which case Mr, Menachem Begin is completely correct to maintain his hard-line policy as the only one that can ensure the security of the State of Israel.In the meantime I think that a lot could be achieved by the disdussion of this plan to clear some of the misunderstandings that seem to have arisen between Israel and the States.My best wishes to you in this and all your endeavours for the sake of Israel and the Jewish people.

Alternative plan to resolve the Mid-East Impasse.

Principles on which it is based:

Firstly; That the only basis for a peace treaty is that both parties to the dispute make mutual concessions, and that these concessions involve both parties in sacrifices that are seen to be equally significant by both sides. Secondly; Since the concern of the Arabs is the return of the disputed territories

to them, while the Israelis are concerned with their security without these disputed territories in their possession any longer, that these mutual concessions ensure the satisfaction of both parties.

Thirdly; That it be agreed that any withdrawal by Israel from the disputed lands will be followed by:

a) Total demilitarisation of these disputed lands.

- b)Monitoring of this by satellite, UN fordes on the ground and by the parties themselves.
- c)Any breach of this demilitarised status to be followed by immediate Israeli re-occupation of the territory.
- d) Any terrorist attack launched against Israel from any of the returned territories, including Jerusalem, will be met by immediate Israeli retaliation within this territory. This Israeli action to receive full support and co-operation of the government in power at the time. Any resistance offered to this action by anybody in this territory, including the ruling or administrative power, will justify Israel to take any steps necessary to safeguard her security, including the re-occupation of this land.
 - e) That these conditions remain in effect for the next twenty-five years, after which they can be re-negotiated-if no agreement is then reached the original agreement will remain in effect indefinitely.
- Fourthly; In view of the special status of Jerusalem and the fact that it is not strategically that important, it be resolved that it becomes the first international city under UN trusteeship, with the citizens administering

the city under the aegis of the UN, who might also establish their head-quarters there.It will remain the administrative capital of Israel, while also being available to the Arabs should they wish to use it as the administrative capital of any Arab state there. However in the case of Jerusalem and district, none of the new housing and industrial development established there since the 1967 war will be handed back or given up, as would be the case for all the other territories returned, except for some minor border adjustments.

Finally it be resolved that as a result of the establishment of the State of Israel an exchange of populations has taken place that is non-negotiable and permanent, thus accepting the reason for the existence of Israel and not just t that Israel exists for the moment.

Israel will expect America to come to her assistance if she is attacked by any power other than those she signed the peace treaty with,or if the troops of any other power use the land of the states she has signed treaties with to attack her. In addition she will expect America to keep her military preparedness on a par with the forces of Saudi-Arabia, Syria, Egypt, Jordan and Lebanon. Should nuclear weapons be introduced into the area, America will immediately supply Israel with the same, even before negotiations are begun to get them removed from the area.

Dear Rabbi Schindler:

I am sending you the enclosed paper IDEA FOR PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST at the suggestion of our mutual friend, Gunther Lawrence. When Gunther and I discussed this on Friday (23rd) our first impulse was to send it directly to your home in Westport because of the rapid pace history is now being made in the Mid East. Hoping that a miracle might happen in Ismailia during the past weekend we decided, on Saturday morning, to defer sending this to you until today.

Unfortunately, according to today's press, the miracle we hoped for did not occur and reading "between the lines" it is obvious that important differences yet remain. It is becoming increasingly obvious that without Syrian co-operation it will be impossible to ever achieve complete concord in the Mid East. It is also apparent that as Syria goes so will Jordon. For these reasons the enclosed plan, devised for the purpose of pacifying Syria, is most timely. It is just possible that President Hafez al-Assad will soon recognize the enormous benefits his country woul gain by the implementation of this plan in addition to regaining "title" to the Golan Heights. More important he must realize that by accepting this plan he will become the "benefactor" to all Mid Eastern countries because of the wide spread of benefits all countries in that region will achieve when the plan is in operation. Although not mentioned in the plan, it is quite possible that the acute problem of the Palestiniams can be ameliorated to some degree by their absorpttion in the vast undertaking, that will go on for decades, as described in my outline for Peace

AN IDEA FOR PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST

by Donald Flamm

The three most difficult problems facing the Middle East today are the P.L.O., the destiny of Jerusalem and the Golan Heights. By comparison, all other issues can be readily resolved if both sides engage in face-to-face negotiations with a genuine desire to achieve concord. Of the three enumerated problems, only one presents an almost insoluble dilemma: what to do about the Golan Heights. This issue falls into the category of "what happens when an irresistible force meets an immovable object" and seemingly defies the judgment of a contemporary objective Solomon.

From the Syrian viewpoint, the Golan Heights belong to Syria and that government has made it abundantly clear that nothing but the complete return of their property is essential as a prerequisite to the establishment of peace in the Middle East area. Yes, there are other issues the Syrians would like resolved before actual peace could be achieved, such as the P.L.O. and Jerusalem, but the return of the Golan Heights is the predominant item on their agenda at the peace conference if and when it ever takes place.

The Golan Heights plateau, 67 kms. long and 25 kms. wide, is not really that important to Syria from either an agricultural

or urbanization standpoint. Topographically, the area is characterized by volcanic terrain of basalt stone, and deep, lush wadis bordered by steep inclines. National pride in retrieving what they believe rightfully belongs to them, which, of course, involves understandable "face-saving", is the compelling motivation for Syria's implacable determination to retrieve her property. So, for perfectly understandable reasons, Syria falls into the role of the "immovable object". An objective analysis of the Israeli point of view with respect to their necessity of retaining the Golan Heights also presents an apparent case of absolute necessity. Despite their 1948 armistice agreement with Israel, the Syrians heavily fortified the region and used the Heights' advantageous position overlooking the Hula Valley and the northern Galilee portion of Israel for placing artillery batteries which posed a constant threat to the Israeli villages below. It is difficult for the inhabitants of those villages to forget their nightmarish experience that preceded the Six-Day-War in 1967 when their homes, farms and villages were frequently destroyed by Syrian shelling from guns pointing down on them from the Heights above. The Syrian targets included the fishermen on Lake Kinneret. In addition, Israel remembers the effort on the part of Syria to divert the headwaters of the Jordan River, a life-line to Israel insofar as it channels a large part of Israel's water supply into the Kinneret Lake. It is factual to the people of Israel that Syria has always been the most bellicose of all her

Arab neighbors as well as the most intransigent and it, therefore, follows that with the Golan Heights back in Syrian control, their pre-1967 ordeal may very well be resumed. Because of past experience, the Israelis have very little faith in U.N. patrolled "buffer zones", or, for that matter, any form of so-called "no man's land". With the area wide open, despite the most vigilant control by peace-keeping forces, life for all Israelis living within the range of the Golan Heights would be a nightmare akin to the predicament of living with a sword of Damocles hanging over their heads.

Since 1967, the Golan Heights have been under Israeli Military Government, responsible for dispensing services and for the welfare of the area's approximate 10,000 inhabitants consisting mainly of Druze farmers centered in four villages and about 500 Moslems. About seventeen Israeli settlements have been established on the Golan Heights, most of them initially as para-military outposts by the Nahal (Young Pioneer) branch of the armed forces. There are about one thousand Israelis settled in the area. Obviously, this must be a frustrating thorn in the side of the Syrians and it is understandable that they want to remove it as quickly and as thoroughly as possible. In

that sense, the Syrians are as immovable in their determination to re-occupy the Golan Heights as the Israelis are inflexible in their belief that only a continuing irresistible force on their part in occupying the Golan Heights will keep Israel from being destroyed. How can these two diametrically opposite goals be reconciled and precious peace be achieved? I believe there is a formula and it can be made to work!

Let us start with basics: Syria wants back its land. Israel demands a status quo that will be permanent, inviolable and so morally perfect that neither side would dare violate its terms without incurring the displeasure, if not the wrath, of the rest of the world. Is such a plan possible? I think it is and herewith shall attempt to outline the general idea, a skeleton plan that will require fleshing out by the world's leading experts in many varied professions and fields of endeavor.

Let us begin with the moral (and possibly legal) requirement that Israel must return the Golan Heights to Syria. But it must be done in such fashion that the end result will give Israel complete confidence in her future security for all time insofar as Syria and the Golan Heights are concerned. This can be accomplished by the return of the Golan Heights to Syria provided the following plan is

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agreed to in advance by Syria, Israel and a special agency representing the U.N. It will provide for the immediate leasing of the entire Golan Heights area to a special agency that can best be described as the Mideast Cultural/ Medical/Educational Center that will consist of a select group of the foremost Syrian, Jordanian, Lebanese and Israeli authorities on educational, medical and cultural matters. The foremost architects, builders, artists and administrators within these four countries that border the Golan Heights should be assigned the task of creating the most advanced, complete, practical and exciting comprehensive center in the world for the advancement of education, medical research and care for the indigent of the Middle East area. In addition to the educational and medical facilities to be provided, the area is sufficiently large to contain an international airport that will bring visitors from all parts of the world. For that reason, an international bazaar (restricted only to Middle East countries) should be included in the overall plan as an added attraction. Each of the participating Middle East countries will thus be able to demonstrate to the world a glimpse of their culture, way of life, their special accomplishments in food, clothing, etc., in the same fashion that all countries do when they participate in world fairs and/or expositions wherever and whenever they take place. Since Syria will be the host country, the net revenue,

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after all expenses have been met, should permit a substantial income for that country. The terms, method of payment, etc., should be worked out carefully in advance in order to avoid future disagreement.

Obviously, a tremendous amount of money will be necessary for the accomplishment of this objective. The "seed money", the funds needed immediately for the preliminary planning, should be provided by the four participating members of the Mideast C/M/E authority with "matching funds" to be provided by a special agency appointed by the U.N. Each of the four Golan Heights' border countries (Lebanon, Syria, Jordan and Israel) should contribute their most outstanding personalities whose quality of mind and heart equal their leadership in their respective fields of endeavor. These men and/or women should accept their responsibility with the understanding that in their hands rests the destiny of the Middle East, that they are to create a master plan that will hopefully not only bring peace to that area, but prosperity and all the obvious benefits of medical science, educational centers and cultural activities as well. Hopefully, the master plan should be well under way within a two-year period. As soon as full agreement has been reached and financing has been arranged,

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the actual transfer of the Golan Heights region from Israel to Syria should take place on the very day that ground is broken for the beginning of this vast undertaking.

It is guite likely that the actual budget may run into the billions of dollars. But if that effort had no other purpose than to defuse the seemingly hopeless impasse between Syria and Israel that eixts today, it would be money well spent and much cheaper in the long run than if war should take place. Of course, the four Golan Heights border countries alone could not possibly take on such an enormous financial burden. The creation of the Mideast Cultural/Medical/Educational Center should properly be the concern and financial responsibility of all the "have" countries of the world. With expert planning and successful completion, it is well within the realm of possibility that such an undertaking might become quite successful and not only bring peace and prosperity to the entire Middle East, as well as desperately needed medical and educational assistance, but also generate sufficient funds to pay Syria a satisfying "rental" each year and, in time, return to the donor nations their investments for "peace in the Middle East".

That, briefly, is the bare outline of an idea that might resolve the current seemingly hopeless impasse between

Syria and Israel. There are obviously many difficult problems such as "who rules the Golan Heights while all the planning and building goes on?" Who will "run" the Middle East Cultural/Medical/Educational Center after it is completed? etc. But if there is a genuine will for peace and a final resolution of the continuing tenuous "peace", all problems can and will be resolved by men and/or women who are determined to achieve that result. The fulfillment of this plan will not only restore peace to the Middle East, but will also result in a tremendously revived interest on the part of the rest of the world to visit the Middle East, not only Egypt and Israel, but Jordan, Syria and Lebanon as well since all these important countries will then become part of the new Middle East "grand tour". It is a dream to be seriously contemplated by all the leaders and people of the involved countries as well as the rest of the world!

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ADDENDUM TO: AN IDEA FOR PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST December 14, 1977

Since formulating AN IDEA FOR PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST (written last summer) dramatic and mind-boggling events have taken place that hopefully will soon result in a successful peace finding effort. But recent events have also dismally confirmed my premise that Syria's cooperation is essential and that without it the road to peace can be very difficult. Indeed, at this moment in Middle East history, Syria is the one important obstacle to a full scale peace conference in Cairo. With respect to Jordon, it is abundantly clear that King Hussein waits on the side line for a signal from President Hafez Al-Assad of Syria. With Syria and Jordon at the conference table in Cairo with Egypt and Israel, all problems, including the PLO and Jerusalem, can be eventually resolved. It is therefore of paramount importance at this time to present an accommodation to Syria of such attractive dimension that President Al-Assad will expediently and gladly agree to a permanent and equitable peace agreement at the Cairo conference.

I believe the plan I have described in my paper AN IDEA FOR PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST offers just that kind of accommodation. It not only provides for the eventual return of the Golan Heights to Syria but, much more important, it will give Syria tremendous economic lift. It will provide thousands of jobs for indigent Palestinians and others in the area for a decade or more and will make available sorely needed medical, educational and cultural facilities for the vast masses of under-privileged The International Bazaar with exhibits by all Middle East living in that area. countries should attract visitors from all over the world especially since a vast, international airport is part of the project. This should be of inestimable value to all the participating Middle East countries from standpoint of tourism and the resulting economic benefits.

One important additional note: On December 10, 1977, the NEW YORK TIMES printed a story headlined: U.N. UNIT WILL BUILD WEST AFRICAN ROADS. The sub-head: "Development Program's Effort Is Intended to Aid Food and Relief Measures in 8 Countries". According to the story, the U.N. Development Program announced an unusual departure from its traditional practice by building \$100 million worth of roads in Western Africa and that the principal contributors to the fund were Canada, the Netherlands, Norway and Saudi Arabia. (My point is that if the U.N. can spend \$100 million to build roads in 8 African countries is it not possible to raise and spend whatever is necessary to avert possible conflagration in the Middle East by restoring immediate Time is now of the essence. By winning over Syria (and that also and lasting peace? includes Jordan) the world may soon witness the dawn of peace in that vastly troubled area sof the world. AN IDEA FOR PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST may just be the panacea that Syria is waiting for.

Dear Friend:

I have been thinking, as many of us have been thinking, of the problem of peace between Israel and the Arabs. The establishment of a Palestinian state within the borders of Israel is impossible from the Israeli point of view. It would be a dagger pointed to the heart of all the Israeli cities.

On the other hand, Israel <u>must</u> give up some land for the sake of peace and the problem is, how can it do that and yet remain safe? You, who have been in the midst of all the discussion, please tell me what you think of the following suggestion which I thought of one night:

On the northeast border of Israel where Syria joins and also Lebanon meets (or are near each other) let Israel give a small bit of land. This in itself will be insufficient for a Palestinian state, but let Israel give it on condition that Syria, Jordan, and maybe Lebanon give an adjoining tract of the same size. Together this would amount to a viable basis for the Palestine state.

If the Arab states refuse, then the onus is on them and it will prove how hollow is their solicitude for the Palestinian refugees. If they consent, then not only will there be a viable Palestine state which does not subtract much from Israel, but it will be a state achieved through a cooperative effort of the Arab states and Israel, which is in itself a good omen for the future.

The only fault that I see with the scheme is that if Israel proposed it, it would be immediately rejected. I wish our State Department would suggest it to Sadat.

The case of Jerusalem is a separate matter for separate discussion.

I would like, first of all, to express my deepest gratitude for your interest in my project, "Bud of the Earth," the monument to the victims of the Holocaust. On July 12, 1978, when, at the invitation of the wife of the Prime Minister of Israel, Mrs. Aliza Begin, you were shown the plans and the working model, I regret that I was unable to be present and to explain the project myself; I trust, however, that Mr. Hayoun, who represented me at the time, provided you with an adequate explanation of the project. Mrs. Begin, upon returning from Camp David, expressed to Mr. Hayoun her support of the project and briefed him on conversations she had had concerning it in the United States. She also conveyed the contents of the letter that she had received from you regarding the Presidential Commission that was being formed.

I now understand from a further message left by Mrs. Begin two days ago, that you are deeply concerned about the delay in the receipt of materials requested from Mr. Hayoun; I must note here that I was not informed of the urgency of the request and as I had been continuously working on improving the plans I thought only to send you the most up-to-date version. At the same time, from bitter experience I have learned not to send such important documents by ordinary mail since they frequently arrive damaged no matter how well they are packed and, especially given the succession of postal strikes over the past three months, the risk was even greater. I thought only to send the documents with a person I could trust. Therefore it is fortunate that Rabbi Zelig Chinitz, a friend of mine and General Director of the United Israel Appeal, and also a strong supporter of the project, offered to deliver the materials to you in person upon his visit to the States. I am sure that Rabbi Chinitz will brief you on recent developments concerning the project.

I understand that the Presidential Committee of twentyfour members, headed by Mr. Elie Wiesel, has now been established to present a recommendation to President Carter on the subject of a fitting memorial to the Six Million so that "We, in the United States, shall never forget." A presentation to the committee would seem a logical next step. For this purpose, I am prepared to come to the States at any time with the model and other relevant materials in order to render a formal presentation. I understand that in addition to the materials being sent, you wish also to have the model. Please let me know if you urgently need the model, or if it can wait until such time as the committee asks for a presentation, in which I should be present to fully explain the model. I should add that the title of the project is tentative and some modifications in the text describing my conception of the monument may be forthcoming.

At this time I would like to record my sincere gratitude to Mrs. Aliza Begin for her profound sensitivity and understanding towards the project and her generosity in her support of it. I regret that I have not yet had the opportunity to meet you and hope that such an opportunity will soon present itself in Jerusalem or the United States.

In closing allow me a personal note. I was impelled to come to Israel twelve years ago to help in the building of a nation that had so recently been all but destroyed. I have spent the last ten years in agonizing reflection and confrontation with the problem of designing a monument to the victims of a calamity which defies any effort to enclose it in words, space or time. But I know that despite these inherent difficulties we must try to find ways to commemorate the inexpressible, to ensure the many different ways through which especially the young who were born after will be able to become engaged. I can only pray that despite all odds we will succeed in carrying out these sacred tasks.

Dear Elle:

Congratulations on being named Chairman of the U.S. Commission on the Holocaust. This development in American life is long past due and I am delighted that you will be heading the Commission as it determines a proper and meaningful American Memorial to the victims of the Holocaust.

Some time ago, Mrs. Menachem Begin called to my attention plans for a Holocaust Memorial created by an Israeli architect. I've called it to the attention of The White House and have asked Mrs. Begin to see that some renderings and sketches are forwarded for perusal by the Commission. A copy of the proposal for "Bud of the Earth" is enclosed herewith.

This proposal envisages not a "dead memorial," but rather a living memorial which includes museums, places for archival materials, study areas, etc. The renderings I saw show great imagination in every way. Just as soon as I have sketches, I will forward them to you.

This leads me to the second suggestion I want to make. I hear via the grapevine, though I have not seen it with my own eyes, that YIVO has fallen upon hard times. While they now have quite a few young people working on their staff, I am told the books and documents are beginning to deteriorate because of lack of proper care due to a shortage of resources. It occurred to me, when I discussed this with someone just last week, that perhaps YIVO could be included in the kind of living memorial which I envisage, be it the design of the israeli architect or not.

Be that as it may, I am confident that you and the members of the Commission will seek to create a Memorial of beauty and meaning which will help the generations to come. Jews as well as non-Jews, to realize the depth and scope of the Holocaust, the darkest page in the history of our people, indeed in the history of all humankind. Rabbi Albert Goldman of Cincinnati heard me lecture at a conference in New York City last March and invited me to come to Cincinnati to lecture next fall (cf. enclosures). The subject of my lecture there will be "Prelude to the Holocaust: the Evian Conference and Crystal Night." Presently, I am writing a book on the Evian Conference and Crystal Night.

I was a correspondent for "The New York Times" in Berlin from spring, 1937, until October, 1941. At midnight November 9, 1938, I was tipped off that a pogrom (Kristallnacht) would begin at 2 a.m. of the tenth at the corner of Friedrichstrasse and Leipzigerstrasse. I was there when it began. I followed the pogromists until 8:30 a.m., when they set fire to the synagogue in the Fasananstrasse.

My story appeared in "The Times" the morning of November tenth and was a world "beat".

I shall be speaking in Cincinnati on November third. I would like to arrange speaking engagements in other Ohio cities (Toledo, Cleveland, Akron, Youngstown, Columbus, Dayton) for the end of October and the first, second, fourth, and fifth of November.

Have you affiliated congregations in any or all of these cities to whom I could write? If you do, I would like to have the names of the rabbis or other individuals to whom I might address myself. From November sixth through tenth I shall be a Scholar-Participant at the International Scholars Symposium on the Holocaust sponsored by the Institute for the Study of Contemporary Social Problems at the University of Washington in Seattle.

I would like to get some speaking dates in the Pacific Northwest area following the Seattle conference. Have you affiliated congregations in Washington, Oregon and California that might be interested in having me lecture?

I make all my lecturing arrangements myself. My fee is \$400 plus expenses. Any suggestions you can give me will be deeply appreciated..
