Thank you for calling two items to my attention that are outstanding.

With regard to Jewish appointees to the Cabinet and at sub-Cabinet levels, we have not undertaken any substantive search for them. However, I am enclosing a list of those people in the National Security area in which we have a direct interest who are of the Jewish persuasion. I should add, however, that you don't have to be Jewish to love Israel.

With regard to the second item, I do not feel it would be worth the chip I would have to expend to put in a meaningful pitch for a personnel assignment. Also, with some quarters in the State Department any indication of my own interest in a personnel assignment to Israel would be a kiss of death.

Please convey these thoughts to Alex.

Dear Rabbi Schindler:

We were very disappointed that you did not come to Warsaw during the 100 year anniversary of the Jewish Theater. We were looking forward to seeing you and Rea. Szurmiej explained the situation and told us he saw you later at the conference in Spain.

Things here in Warsaw are about the same, although it is rather quiet this month. All of this will change I am sure now that we have a new President and Cabinet. I have not as yet been assigned a new post, and being still very much desirous of an assignment in Tel Aviv, I am wondering, with the takeover of the new Administration, if you still have any influence on matters such as these, i.e., helping me to get a post in Tel Aviv. I would very much appreciate any help you may be able to give me in this regard. We are scheduled to leave Warsaw around August of this year, and hope to see you here before we depart.

The anniversary of the Jewish Theater went off in full style. There was quite a number of Jewish people (most of them older, of course) who showed up for the ten porformances ... we attended all of them. We also had the privilege of meeting the Chief Rabbi of Hungary, along with several other notable Jewish persons from other Eastern European countries. It was guite an experience.

Well, I shall close this letter for now, hoping to hear from you soon and taking this opportunity to wish you and your family, and the Hellmans, a very happy New Year.
