Dear Rabbi Friedman,

I thought I would have an opportunity to speak with you for a few minutes at the Airport, and tell you what has, and is bothering me these past few weeks, but unfortunately there was too much excitment, too many people around - or rather I lacked the courage. Anyway I shall try to do my speaking - in writing, which is definitely not easy, but I do hope you will be able to understand me.

The week I worked together with you, I believe was the first real opportunity of working hand-in-hand and next to you, which gave me great pleasure and more so, had the chance to see, from close range, the way you manipulate your work in such a swift and efficient way.

I felt that I too had a part in helping in the most ingenious idea of yours, and its success of receiving such an important Mission to Israel - as the guests of the Prime Minister. While you had to conduct this tremendous event through the back door - behind the scenes - and others ran your show.

I was extremely hurt and terribly let down, when several weeks ago your decided to nominate Zelig Chinitz as your liaison officer in respect of this great idea of the Mission and Conference.

The belief was that this Conference would be a different kind with different approaches as well as different methods in handling it, etc. My one week working with you proved it wrong.

Zelig Chinitz is a very dear man and friend of yours and mine. Needless to say, he did an excellent job, but I hope you will understand me and the way I feel about this matter. Here I have been working hard for so many years to strive to reach a certain position, a certain status, and when a marvelous opportunity arises in fulfilling and being a part of an important mission, the head of your own Organization by-passes his own representative and the "koved" is handed over to someone else. I really cannot understand it.

By nominating Zelig Chinitz for this specific task, and having him handling the duties I usually perform, such as meeting with Ministry officials, El-Al people, Army, etc., put me in an akward position. I don't know how to express myself, but I have no doubt you understand me, it was like playing second fiddle in your own sphere of work, which you have been doing for so long. Anyway the real work began the day you arrived, and the help I gave you, but the damage was done.

I feel much better now that I have taken this off my chest, and sincerely hope you will understand me, as you always do, and be able to clarify this matter that is concerning and bothering me so much.

Dear Mr. Vinitsky,

I have again signed a number of copies of my Voice of Israel at your request for distribution to some of the U.J.A. leaders.

I should like to explain why I do not want to do this in the future.

The book under discussion was written thirteen years ago and republished with a few additions last year. It does not represent what I would now like to tell Jews across the world about Israel and the Jewish future. In other words, it is not a contemporary picture of my thinking. The book "My People", which is only three years old and whose eighth or ninth edition has recently been published, contains what I would now like to present to Jews and others as my current view on the Jewish destiny.

I know that there is a financial disparity between the two books, but I cannot imagine that this can preoccupy you in the context of honoring such generous contributors. If that is the reason for the choice, I am certain that an arrangement with the publishers could be made in your favor.

I fear that my delay in signing "Voice of Israel" sometimes arises from my own subconscious reservations towards it as something for me to give to Jewish friends today.




