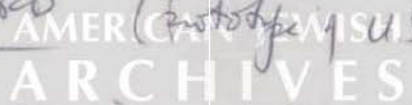

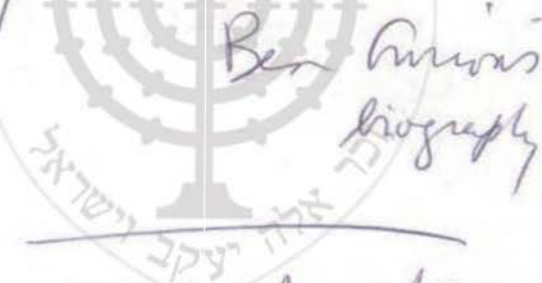

at Bandung

Dr. Fadhil al-Jamali of Iraq spoke against  
Colonialism, Zionism & Communism as evils that  
disturbed world peace and harmony.

He called Zionism "the worst offspring of imperialism."  
He said he hoped the conference would brand  
Israel an illegitimate state and an aggressor  
and see to it that "Arab rights in their own  
home in Palestine are recognized and restored."

He also made a bitter attack against French  
policy in North Africa.

Col. Nasser of Egypt affirmed his country's faith  
in the UN but accused the UN of a  
failure to act in accordance with human  
rights with regard to North Africa & Israel.

He said the establishment of Israel  
"under the eyes of the UN and with her  
help and sanction" was a "brutal and  
immoral violation of human principles."

Taking stock today is not such an unpleasant business as it was in the past.

1. Mass immigration has been absorbed without a markedly large number of people being unemployed.
2. Housing still insufficient, but amounts necessary for housing have been brought down to manageable proportions.
3. Inflation has not only been brought under control but definitely halted. 30% of the currency is now backed by gold and foreign currency.
4. Israel's prestige abroad in financial and commercial matters has risen considerably.

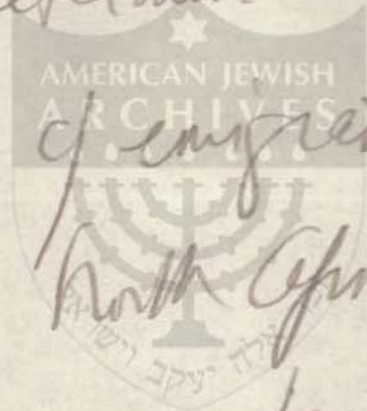

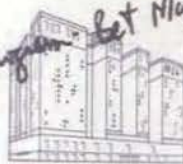
