Nevertheless, I hope it will turn out to be a worthy affair in Miami, and I send you all my good wishes for its success. From everybody, and especially from Ehud, who told me about his conversations with you in San Francisco, I hear that American Jewry is regarding the latest eyents connected with our people in Russia and other communist countries rather seriously, which seriousness is expressing itself in all ways, and especially in immediate positive action for the U.J.A. Naturally, all these things are uppermost in the minus of everyone here, and each day seems to make matters even more serious and complicated.
