TEL AVIV: ISRAEL'S CHIEF OF STAFF HAIM BAF LEV ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT HIS COUNTRY HAS PURCHASED A VARIETY OF ANTI-INFILTRATION DEVICES IN THE UNITED STATES AND ELSEWHERE. THE CHIEF OF STAFF INDICATED THAT THE NEW EQUIPMENT WILL BE UTILIZED IN INITIATING A WIDE SPECKTRUM OF NEW TACTICS AIMED AT LIMITING TERRORIST ACTIVITY AGAINST ISRAEL. NO FURTHER DETAILS WERE GIVEN.

THE CHIEF OF STAFF THOUGHT IT UNLIKELY THAT ANY MAJOR WORLD POWER WOULD ACTIVELY INTERVENE IN THE MISDDLE EAST.

NEWSPAPER AND POLITICAL OBSERVERS HAVE LAUDED ISRAEL(('S "HOT PURSUIT" TACTIC EXPLOYED AGAINST TERRORISTS FOR THE FIRST TIME ON MONDAY. THE OPSERVERS NOTED THAT THE RAID SUCCESSFULLY ACCOMPLISHED, ITS MILITARY OPJECTIVE WITHOUT COMPLICATING INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS. NO ISRAELI CASUALTIES WERE SUSTAINED, TERRORIST PLANS TO DISRUPT HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES WERE THWARTED. THERE WERS NO ENCOUNTER WITH REGULAR JOREDANIAN FORCES, AND THE AL RATAH DEGANIZATION WAS SHOWN THAT THEIR TERRORIST RASES IN JORDAN ARE NO LONGER A SAFE FREFUGE. FATAH ATTEMPTS TO ORGANIZE RESISTANCE AMONG ISRAELI ARABS IN THE HAIFA AREA WERE ALSO REPORTED FOOILED.

TEL AVIV: ISRAELI TROOPS TODAY CROSSED THE JORDAN FORDER BY HELICOPTER NEAR EIN YAHAV SOUTH OF THE DEAD SEA IN HOT PURSUIT OF ARAB SABOTEURS. SEVERAL ARAB SABOTEURS WERE KILLED IN THE EXCHANGE OF FIRE, A SABOTAGE SUPPLY HOUSE WAS BLOWN UP, TERRORIST ARMS AND DOCUMENTS WERE SEIZED. ALL ISRAELI FORCES, NUMBERING ONLY A FEW DOZEN SOLDIERS, RETURNED SAFELY TO ISRAEL TERRITORY.

THIS NEW DEFENSE TACTIC OF HELICOPTER OPERATIONS FOLLOWED AN INTENSIFIED TERRORIST CAMPAIGN IN THE ARAVA AND EILAT REGION WHERE SIXTEEN ACTS OF TERRORISM, SABOTAGE, MINELAYING, AND SHOOTING OF VEHICLES OCCURED SINCE THE FIRST OF THIS YEAR. THESE ACTIONS RESULTED IN THREE DEATHS, THIRTY SEVEN WOUNDED AND THE DESTRUCTION OF SEVEN VEHICLES BY MINES INCLUDING THE HERZLIA HIGH SCHOOL BUS. MANY OTHER MINES HAD BEEN FOUND IN THE AREA AND DISMANTLED WITHOUT CASUALTIES.

ISRAELI ARMY INTELLIGENCE SOURCES HAVE REVEALED THAT THE ARAVA-EILAT TERRORIST ACTIVITY WAS CONDUCTED BY INCREASED ARAB FORCES, INCLUDING TROOPS FROM THE 141ST EGYPTIAN COMMANDO BATTALION WHICH WAS TRANSFERRED TO JORDAN AND ACTS UNDER ORDERS FROM THE EGYPTIAN EMBASSY IN AMMAN. THESE FORCES ALSO INCLUDE LARGE NUMBERS OF SOLDIERS AND OFFICERS OF THE SYRIAN ARMY'S PALESTINE PATTALION. ISRAELI INTELLIGENCE UNCOVERED PLANS TO SABOTAGE INSTALLATIONS IN SDOW, TIMMA, EILAT AND ARAVA SETTLEMENTS, AS WELL AS FOR TERRORIZING TRAFFIC ON THE EILAT HIGH WAY.
