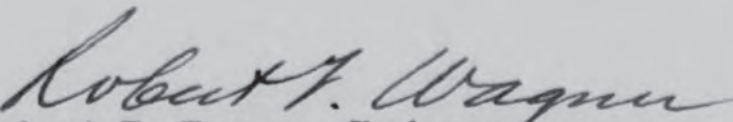

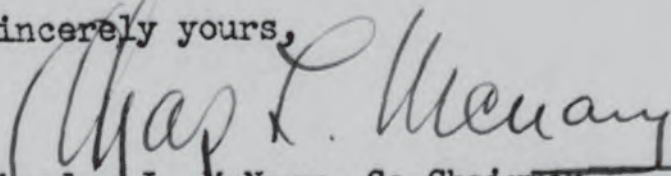
In the years between two world wars, the Jewish National Home has received moral and political support from the United States under successive administrations, regardless of party. The reasons which have led our people and government to favor this cause from the outset are still valid; but the case for the Jewish National Home is far stronger today. First, the resettlement of the Jews in Palestine is no longer a doubtful experiment but a convincing reality. 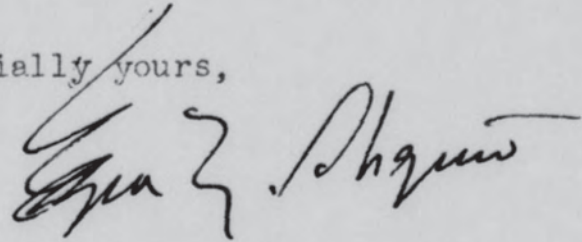
Dear Dr. Silver:

ANALYZING THE NEWS

By

Henry M. Busch

* * * * *

The Arab situation described on this program last Sunday erupted into the headlines the next day.

You recall that the Iraqis warned the United States Senate that if it passed the Wager-Taft Resolution, there might be bloodshed in Palestine.

The threat was strengthened when the Emir of Trans-Jordan and the Iraqi Parliament sent messages to Speaker Rayburn and Vice-President Wallace, informing them that the passage of the Wager-Taft Resolution was equivalent to "a request that the United States of America declare war on the Arabs of Palestine."

Senator Wagner replied that for over one hundred years the Senate of the United States had been making its own decisions without advice from the outside.

Here is the background. The Wagner-Taft Resolution in the Senate and the Wright-Compton Resolution in the House re-affirmed the Joint Resolution adopted by Congress in 1922 and signed by President Harding, favoring "the establishment in Palestine of a National Home for the Jewish people."

As a result of Anglo-American collaboration, on November 2, 1917, the British Government issued the Balfour Declaration, pledging itself "to facilitate the establishment in Palestine of a National Home for the Jewish people."

In 1919 President Wilson revealed that "the Allied Nations, with the fullest concurrence of our Government and people, are agreed that in Palestine shall be laid the foundations of a Jewish Commonwealth."

The Allied Supreme Council, meeting at San Remo, on April 25, 1920, gave Great Britain a mandate for Palestine, expressly for the purpose of putting the Balfour Declaration into effect. Fifty-two nations, including the United States, formally approved the Balfour Declaration. The Arabs officially accepted, and their delegation signed the agreements establishing the Jewish homeland.

Because the United States had helped originate and was deeply interested in the Palestine Mandate, after the San Remo Conference we were given the right to pass on the terms of the mandate, and in order to aid the new development, we relinquished certain economic rights which we had obtained in Palestine.

Then, in 1924, Congress ratified a treaty with Great Britain, setting forth the terms of the mandate. Article One of the treaty says that no modifications may be made unless they shall first have been assented to by the United States.

Under the mandate and the principles of the Balfour Declaration, the Jews began to develop Palestine.

They had clung tenaciously to their land throughout all the nineteen centuries since the Romans had smashed the Jewish state.

Now they developed Palestine, turning it from a barren waste of sand, swamp, and rocks into a land of three hundred agricultural colonies able to support ~~was~~ a million and a half people where less than half a million had been hardly able to exist before.

Then came the intrigue and propaganda of the fascists among the Arabs. First Mussolini proclaimed himself the protector of Islam; then came Hitler.

The Arabs, who had no homeland before 1918, and who got a million square miles from the Allies, now under Italian and Nazi prompting began to agitate against the Jews, who got only nine thousand square miles in Palestine.

Thoroughly scared by the Axis, Chamberlain made his Munichs, and in May of 1939 he issued the White Paper, abrogating the terms of the Mandate and the Balfour Declaration, and illegally limiting Jewish immigration to Palestine for the next five years, and proposing to stop it completely after March 31 of this year.

The White Paper forbids Jews henceforth to buy land in Palestine, despite the treaty provision that no person may be denied any civil rights in Palestine because of his race or religion.

So, in the ancient land of the Jews, in the homeland of Jesus and Paul, in the country which fifty-two nations covenanted to protect, Chamberlain by his White Paper established the first open, avowedly anti-Semitic government outside of the Axis.

Hitler now had the Jews of Europe trapped at home, and the door of escape closed to them in Palestine.

No wonder Churchill, in a speech in the House of Commons on May 22, 1939, said, "This is a melancholy occasion ... the provision that Jewish immigration can be stopped in five years' time . . . is a plain breach of a solemn obligation."

Mr. Churchill continued: "This pledge of a home of refuge, of an asylum, was not made to the Jews in Palestine, but to the Jews outside of Palestine, to that vast, unhappy mass of scattered, persecuted, wandering Jews whose intense, unchanging, unconquerable desire has been for a National Home. That is the pledge which was given, and that is the pledge which we are now asked to break."

Mr. Churchill asked, "What will the world think about it? What will our friends say? What will be the opinion of the United States of America?"

He then made the startling prediction that long before the five years were up, during which the British hoped to gain an advantage by appeasing the Arabs, Europe would be at war; and he added, "either there will be a Britain which knows how to keep its word on the Balfour Declaration, and is not afraid to do so, or we shall find ourselves relieved of many overseas responsibilities other than those comprised within the Palestine Mandate."

What Mr. Churchill said in 1939 is true today. If he is seeking a lead on policy, the way was shown for him on Thursday, when President Roosevelt authorized the statement "that the American government has never given its approval to the White Paper of 1939. The President is happy that doors of Palestine are today open to Jewish refugees, and that when future decisions are reached, full justice will be done to those who seek a Jewish national home, for which our government and the American people have always had the deepest sympathy, and today more than ever, in view of the tragic plight of hundreds of thousands of homeless Jewish refugees."

The President released this statement to the American Conference on Palestine which met in Washington on Thursday.

This conference, which included two hundred outstanding Christian leaders in all walks of life, was unanimous in its condemnation of the White Paper and in its support of the Wagner-Taft Resolution.

All of these Gentiles felt a sickening sense of shame that the horrible outrages to which the Jews of Europe have been subjected, have aroused so little protest among those who claim devotion to the ideals of the Palestinian prophet whose spiritual roots struck deeply into the religious culture of his Jewish forebears.

All of them knew that the Jewish homeland in Palestine had been endorsed by Lord Cecil, Woodrow Wilson, General Jan Smuts, Lloyd George, Churchill, and in recent days by Roosevelt and Wallace and Willkie.

They knew when they listened to the clear-cut speech of Senator Robert Taft that this is no partisan matter.

They learned from one of their fellow-Christian delegates, Dr. Walter Lowdermilk, the great conservation specialist, that there is no basis for the statement that Palestine cannot support any more people.

Dr. Lowdermilk says that Palestine can support 2,400,000 people on a good standard of living by agriculture alone, and an additional 1,116,000 in Trans-Jordan if that country follows the development plan of Palestine. Dr. Lowdermilk, who has studied the soil problems of Palestine and the Near East through many months of residence there, has set forth his viewpoint in his very excellent book, just published, Palestine: Land of Promise.

Every soil and agricultural specialist who has studied the problem agrees with Dr. Lowdermilk, and most of them believe that with a mixed economy of agriculture, industry, trade and commerce, Palestine can afford a good living to more than five million people.

Dr. Lowdermilk, an enthusiastic Zionist, gives new meaning to John Dewey's phrase, "I have seen the future and it works."

The future will work for the good of mankind, if the United Nations will accept and follow a straight-forward policy of fulfilling our honor obligations, of rewarding our friends, of resisting our enemies, and making no concessions to those who threaten us.

The Palestine problem is no mere Jewish problem. It is the present test of Christian compassion; of democratic aspiration; of international good faith.

As Churchill said in 1939, "The Jewish colonists . . . have made the desert bloom. They have started a score of thriving industries . . . They have founded a great city on the barren shore. They have harnessed the Jordan and spread its electricity throughout the land. So far from being persecuted, the Arabs have crowded into the country and multiplied till their population has increased more than even all world Jewry could lift up the Jewish population. Now we are asked to decree that all this is to stop, and all this is to come to an end. We are asked to submit - and this is what rankles most with me - to an agitation which is fed with foreign money and ceaselessly inflamed by Nazi and Fascist propaganda."

The Churchill who so clearly saw and stated the issues in 1939 is now in a position to lead the British people in repudiating the White Paper and upholding their honor by defending the Balfour Declaration.
