Dear Doctor Silver:

Responding to your letter of June 9th asking for a contribution of \$6000 for the work of the American Zionist Emergency Council, I wish to inform you that I took the matter up at a meeting of the Bronx Region and the sentiments I express in this letter they join in.

We are all fully cognizant of the magnificent work already done under your leadership by the Council and of the unlimited effort and energy still to be expended. We know the dire need for the sum which you plan raising.

The situation in the Bronx is one with which you are pretty well familiar. The membership in the Region in seven months has been shot up from 1850 to 4250 and it has taken back-breaking work to do it. I personally, by putting in indescribably difficult work, managed to raise some \$1500 for a special fund for a promotional fund almost all of which has already been used up. Frankly an assignment for \$6000 to be collected by July 15th seems almost like a request for an amount equal to that deposited in the United States Treasury. I say this regretfully but it represents reality.

Rome was not built in a day and we have great hopes for a very substantial growth in membership with consequent interest and additions to revenue for all Zionist purposes but everything cannot be done at once. In retrospect what we have accomplished in the last seven or eight months seems almost miraculous in the light of twenty years of background of Zionist Organization membership and work in the Bronx.

Notwithstanding all of this the feeling was that we should exert ourselves to the limit to make some contribution. What it will come to I cannot now say. I am giving considerable thought to fund raising plans and I am hoping that in the course of months it will be possible not only to provide an amount indispensable for the minimum activities of the Region in order to have it function with at least reasonable efficiency but also to cover in addition some contribution to your work as well as to the work of the Council for Judaism or whatever the name is.

As you know we are just at the beginning of the formation of a Bronx Division of your Council and on Friday, the 23rd, we plan to have a meeting of the representatives of the Region, Hadassah, Mizrachi and Poale Zion. I shall bring this matter up for the attention of the body and will urge their going all out to help. I think in all candor I should add that I am not optimistic about the possible results certainly not as of July 15th but I will go the limit in trying to get the best possible results.

My dear Dr. Silver:

In reply to your second urgent request to have Los Angeles contribute \$5000 towards the contemplated radio program, I deeply regret to have to state that I am at a loss to know where the money will come from.

It takes \$400 a month to keep the Los Angeles Committee on Palestine going, and up to this day I have found it extremely difficult to raise the necessary funds. As you know we are now in the midst of a Welfare Fund campaign and, of course, no outsiders could be approached for any contributions. As usual the insiders of the Zionist Organization have responded and I hope we will find it possible, by receiving further contributions from a number of Zionists, to keep the Committee going until September when some kind of a function will be undertaken to raise a substantial sum of money for different emergency purposes.

Should such a function take place, and should it be very successful, I am reasonably certain that we will be able to contribute our share toward the expenses of the radio program. However, as much as I would like to, I cannot at this time give any assurance that the requested sum will be forthcoming.

I definitely feel that the contemplated radio program will be the most constructive and effective undertaking of the Emergency Committee, and I wonder whether I may boldly suggest that means should be found to finance it out of the present allocation of \$500,000.

I have spoken again this morning to Mr. Rossen and he assured me again of his willingness to help us in any way possible, as soon as he finds out in detail exactly what is expected from him.

I am sure you will be glad to learn that the co-chairman of our Committee, Mr. Manchester Boddy, is going to resign from the Emergency Committee to Save the Jewish People of Europe, and we shall send you a copy of his letter of resignation so you might use it if you find it necessary.
