LOUIS E. LEVINTHAL 606 CITY HALL PHILADELPHIA April 6, 1948. Honorable J. Howard McGrath, United States Senate, Washington, D.C. Dear Senator McGrath: Many thanks for your letter of March 24th. I am aware of your genuine interest in the problem concerning which I wrote you. I fear, however, that unless something is done speedly to remedy the situation, it will be too Agte. I am enclosing copy of a letter I have written to my friend, David L. Lawrence Chairman of the Pennsylvania State Democratic Committee and I respectfully urge that you give consideration to the suggestion contained in it. Honorable David L. Lawrence, Mayor, City of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

Doar Dave:

I am grateful for your prompt deply to my letter, and I am aware of your genuine interest in the Pelestine problem, concerning which I wrote you. I fear, however, that time is really of the essence and if you intend to go over the subject with the President, you should do so in the next few days and defore our State Department commits itself any further to a mistaken policy.

I hope you will not aind my suggesting that what should be done at once in to ravoke the embargo on arms to the beleaguered Jers of Palestine, so that they may defend themselves against the aggression of the Mufti and his henchmen. Furtherware, in the Special Assembly of the United Nations called Now April 16th, our government should refrain from exerting any pressure on the delegates from other pations, and should make it clear that every member state of the United Nations is free to vote on the merits of the case I am convinced that if this be the attitude of our government, the decision of November 29th will not be reversed. Our government will in this way be credited with having fairly presented the issue to the Assembly and having permitted the Assembly to make its free decision, without any diplomatic or other pressure from it. If this be done, I am certain that more than one-third of the members of the United Nations will adhere to the decision of November 29th.

It is my personal opinion that if this be the outcome of the Special Assembly's deliberations, our government and its leaders will earn the grateful appreciation of not only the Jews of America, but of the hundreds of thousands of liberal, progressive Americans of all faiths the for more than twenty-five years have ardently supported the Zionist movement.
