

At my suggestion Eliahu Ben-Horin contacted you in the matter of the committee which is being organized in the United States for the relief of Arab refugees. I have long felt that we ought to do something about it, too, as part of a humanitarian effort. Mr. Shertok has been contacted and he, too, feels that it would be desirable for American Jewry to be represented on the relief group, assuming that it bears a purely humanitarian character, and he, too, strongly endorsed my choice that the B'nai Brith be the body to represent Jewry on this committee. I trust that you will find your way to do so.
