WASHINGTON, Saurday. Despite Washington's chilly preoccupation with General MacArthur's accusations before the Senate Armed Services Committee, Mr. Ben Gurion's visit has already succeeded in engendering genuine warmth in the highest Gov-ernment circles.

General MacArthur's flight from New York a few minutes before the Israel Premier's arrival on Thursday immediately threw a cloud over all other events in the capital, but Mr. Ben Gurion succeeded in breaking through the crisis atmosphere, bringing a message of good-will from Israel, and the response at the White House as well as everywhere else has been genuinely of the warmest. The message from President Weizmann, for example, wasn't just a formal state greeting but a sincere expression of mutual friendship.

The Premier has now com-pleted the first round of his visit, talking to President Truman, Mr. Acheson, General Marshall, and Mr. Harriman, and tomorrow begins sight-seeing with a T.V.A. tour seeing with a T.V.A. tour conducted by Mr. Gordon Clapp prior to his first public appearance, which is schedulfor Tuesday. el

while the same time, At the Premier is engaged in po-licy discussions here, hundreds of Jewish communities throughout the country are feverishly engaged in collect-ing commitments for bond purchases to swell the total to be announced at a Madison Square Garden rally on Thursday. Bond selling has already become a new phenomenon in American - Jewish community life—both Zionist and non-Zionist. Observers of the American-Jewish scene, with all its divisions and quarrels, are enthusiastic about the manifestations of new har-mony—with the Z.O.A. harnessing all its resources to the bond campaign. Israel Ministers Kaplan, Myerson and Jo-seph, are working their hardest, fighting through a gruelling schedule of meetings and con-ferences to mobilize at least 50 millions' worth of initial sales before Thursday's deadline, and Z.O.A. President Browdy is is personally leading an all-out Zionist effort which deserves special mention as contrasted with Dr. Aba Hillel Silver, now politically barnstorming 1,000 miles away from home. special with now It is no secret that Dr. Silver was officially approached by the bond-drivers to cooperate but failed to respond.


