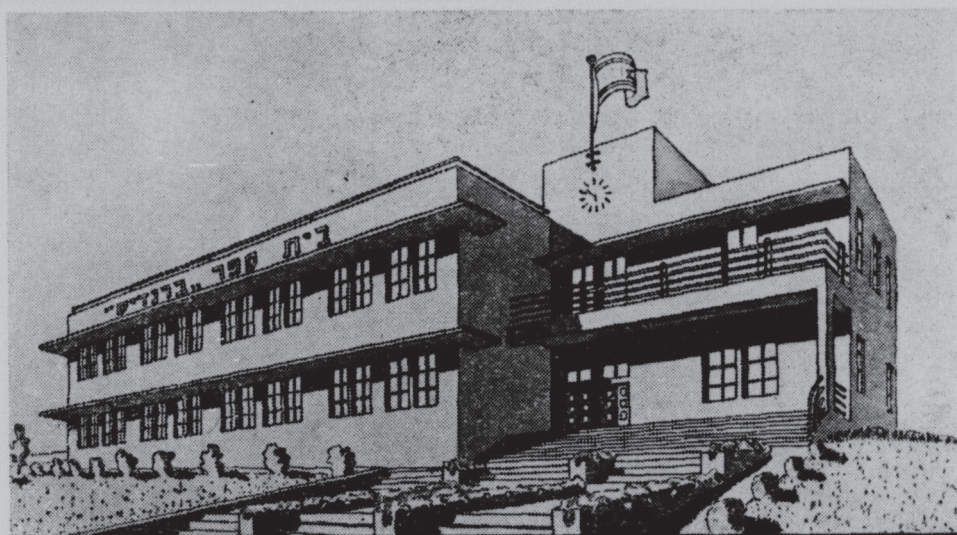

Dear Rabbi Silver,

I take pleasure in inviting you to participate in the dedication ceremony of the Brandeis School in Herzlia during the coming Passover, Monday, April 18th, 1938, on the occasion of the eighty-first birthday of Justice Louis D. Brandeis. This represents conclusion of eighteen years of American Zionist efforts of colonization in Palestine beginning with the first settlement established by the American Zion Commonwealth in Balfouria and followed by the highly successful colony of Herzlia now having the population of over 5000.

We would welcome some expression from you on the occasion of the opening of the school and the exercises connected therewith, in which all prominent American Zionists resided here will participate and which we hope will be graced by the presence of the American Consul General and the High Commissioner for Palestine.
