My dear Rabbi Silver:

The committee appointed to suggest nominees for the forthcoming election of the Zionist District has had several sessions and carefully considered a number of names. The committee was particularly careful in selecting the names for the Executive Committee, the purpose being to get together the strongest available group.

You have been nominated for a place on the Executive Committee, and it would give us great pleasure to have your formal acceptance. We feel certain that you can be of great service to the cause of Zionism by accepting a place on the governing committee of the District.

The election will take place in the near future, the date still to be announced. The ballots must be printed soon. May we ask you to be kind enough to send us your reply at your very earliest convenience.

If we do not hear from you to the contrary by the 12th of October, we shall assume that you accept the nomination and we shall proceed to print your name on the ballot.

It is scarcely necessary to remind you that recent political events have completely transformed the character of our movement and of our program for the future. It will be decidedly worth while to participate in the historic task that lies ahead of us.
