My dear Rabbi Silver:-



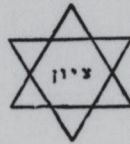

Undoubtedly you are aware of the central position which Palestine has come to occupy in the life of World Jewry. We are witnessing, in our own day, the rapid development of a flourishing civilization in Jewish Palestine.

An All-Jewish Palestine Conference has been arranged for January 20th and 21st, to be held in Washington, D.C. To this conference have been summoned the leaders and representatives of American Jewry. It is hoped that we may convoke a large assembly of the most representative Jews of America who will express their united support for a program of accelerating, intensifying and consolidating the forces which are building the Jewish Homeland in Palestine.

In order to discuss the plans for this forthcoming conference and with a view in mind of electing delegates to represent Cleveland Jewry at this Washington meeting, we have arranged for a local conference to be held at the Hotel Statler on Sunday, January 6th, at 3 P.M. May we ask you to be present, and to arrange to have as many delegates as you choose representing your organization at this meeting?

It is of utmost importance that Cleveland Jews join with their fellow Jews throughout the country in active support of this unparalleled demonstration of interest in this cause.

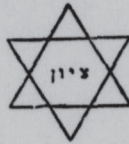

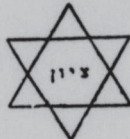
