"Nachlath" is a Hebrew word connoting "heritage" and is employed to describe a Palestine land tract which will bear the name of Dr. Abba Hillel Silver and which will be acquired by the Jewish National Fund with the aid of gifts given by Cleveland Zionists to provide the foundation upon which one of the new settlements is to be built.
