Instructions for Voting

PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE MARKING YOUR BALLOT

Put the figure 1 opposite the name of your first choice, the figure 2 opposite the name of your second choice, the figure 3 opposite the name of your third choice, the figure 4 after thename of your fourth choice, etc. In this way you may express as many choices as you please. There are 25 candidates to be nominated, and it is important that you vote for approximately that number of candidates.

This ballot will not be counted for your second choice unless it is found that it cannot help your first choice; it will not be counted for your third choice unless it is found that it cannot help your first or second choice, etc.

The ballot is spoiled if the figure 1 is put opposite more than one name. Be sure before you mail the ballot that you have not invalidated your ballot in this way. You may make erasures and changes upon the ballot if necessary, but be sure before mailing the ballot that your choices are definitely designated.
