Dear Rabbi Silver:-

I had hoped to see you last week but since this was not possible I am writing instead to bring to your attention the matter of Child Labor week-end - January 28th and 29th. We feel that there will be real value in having some notice taken of these dates in as many churches and synagogues as possible. Ohio's child labor standards are exceedingly high but there are certain definite lacks in the law itself, and in its enforcement, which ought to be brought to the attention of the public. Moreover, there is great need to keep the law and to defend it against the efforts which are being made to reduce its standards.

I am sending you tomorrow a bulletin containing some special material on child labor which you may find useful.

I hope very much that you will find it possible to bring this to the attention of your people.
