Dear Governor Dewey,

The Government of Israel has heard with pleasure of the prospect that you will be travelling in our vicinity within the coming few weeks.

The Prime Minister authorises me to extend to you a cordial invitation to visit Israel as the guest of the Government during such time as you may be able to spare in the course of your trip.

In extending this invitation my Government is deeply conscious of the steadfast support that you have always given to the establishment of Israel's statehood and its consolidation. Your active sympathy has, on many occasions, had a historic effect on our peopled's fortunes.

I am certain that in your visit to Israel you will find tangible vindication of the hopes and ideals which have inspired you in giving your support to this cause.
