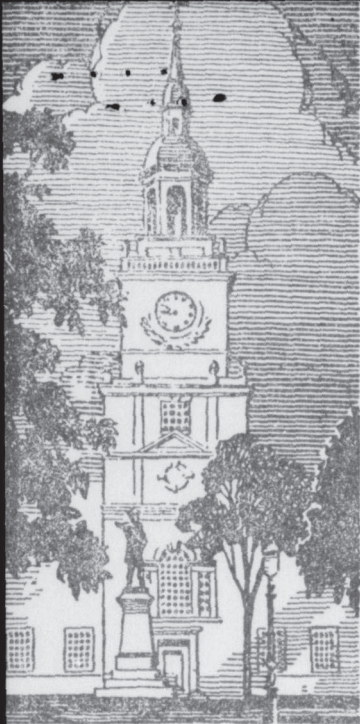


Dear Mrs. May:

TYPES OF TRAINING OFFERED

RABBINIC COLLEGE

DOCTORAL COURSES

The California School offers courses leading to the degree of Doctor of Hebrew Letters (DHL). Holders of the Bachelors degree need 60 additional credit hours for the DHL degree. Holders of a Masters degree in Judaica or the equivalent need 32 additional credit hours for the DHL degree.

•

RABBINIC DEPARTMENT

The California School offers a two-year full-time program (18 credit hours per semester) leading to the degree of Bachelor of Hebrew Letters (BHL). Students of the California School will complete two years work in California and then transfer to Cincinnati for the remaining three years of the Rabbinic course.



UNDERGRADUATE RABBINIC PROGRAM

A program of courses, equivalent to the first year of the B.H.L. program is given at the California School. Placement in this program depends upon the proficiency of the student in Hebrew studies. An undergraduate student studying at a local University may take approximately 7 credits at the California School each semester to be applied towards the first year of the B.H.L. program. Credits in Hebrew Language and Literature are transferrable for University credit.

•

PRE-RABBINIC DEPARTMENT

These courses are designed for High School seniors who are considering the Rabbinate as a career.

An enrichment program for students interested in Jewish studies will be offered. Sessions will be conducted on a monthly basis. College Faculty and guest lecturers will conduct this program.

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION

MASTER OF ARTS IN JEWISH EDUCATION

Candidates must hold an A.B. degree or its equivalent from an accredited College or University. As many as 42 credits may be transferred from accredited general or Jewish institutions of higher learning. A minimum of 30 credits in residence are required for the MA degree.

The MA program consists of 72 units, distributed among these subjects: Hebrew, Education, Psychology or Human Relations, Bible, Post-Biblical Literature, Jewish History, Judaism and Philosophy . . . plus Masters' Dissertation and Comprehensive Examination.

•

BACHELOR OF JEWISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Candidates must be High School graduates. Up to 60 credits may be transferred from an accredited College or University. Credits earned at a recognized Jewish College or University may also be applied towards the degree.

The BJRE program consists of 60 units of liberal arts subjects. Jewish subjects, totaling 60 units, will include Hebrew, Bible, Jewish Literature, Jewish History, Judaism and Jewish Education. A total of 120 units is required for the BJRE degree.

•

SCHOOL OF SACRED MUSIC

This Department stresses training for the position of Cantor and is supplemented by some courses in education. Approximately two years of training is offered in the California School, plus in-service courses leading to Cantorial Certification. Classes in this department are held on Tuesdays and Thursdays, day and evening.

EXTENSION DIVISION

Extension courses are being offered at Hillel Foundation, 900 Hilgard Avenue, Los Angeles 24, and University Religious Conference Bldg., 4665 Willowbrook Ave., Los Angeles.

The one-time registration fee for degree courses is Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars. The tuition fee for degree courses is Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars per credit hour (15 weeks). No tuition is charged in the Pre-Rabbinic Department or Enrichment Program.

Student Loan funds are available to worthy rabbinic and degree candidates.
