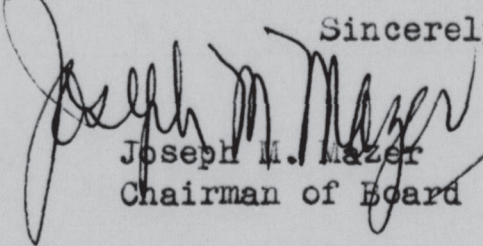

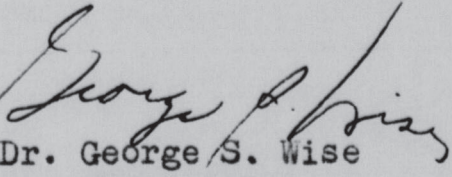
To facilitate matters, we have arranged for a group of select tables to be set aside for members of the Board and their friends and guests.
