New York, June 17, 1919. Dear Herzlite:-This invitation will recall to you fond recollections of years gone by. The inseparable friends of the Dr. Herzl Zion Club will meet again at a reunion to celebrate: a) the safe return of our boys from "over there" and "over here", and b) the FIFTEENTH anniversary of the Herzl Club. At this reunion all old - but ever new - Herzl friends will meet again and once more will we altogether join in singing the Herzl hymns, the songs of our Hebrew performances. That evening we shall again be carried back to those memorable days of our youth - the happiest days in our lives. All our Rabbis, Rabbi Samuel J. Abrams, Rabbi Benj Freedman, Rabbi Abe Silver who is leaving for Palestine July 3rd, and Rabbi Maxwell Silver, all our Lieutenants, Top Sergeants, and privates will be present. Come, Herzlite meet your friends and comrades and spend a most enjoyable evening. The reunion will be in the form of a dinner and will be held at the "Juliette", 103 West 117th Street, Saturday evening, June 28th, at 7:30 P.M. The fee is \$3.00 per plate or \$6.00 per couple.
