

By this time you undoubtedly are familiar with the resolutions adopted by the Convention of the National Labor Committee for Palestine dealing with the White Paper, the Commonwealth, the rescue work carried on by our fellow Jews of Palestine, and a number of other matters. Dear Dr. Silver:

In accordance with our telephone conversation of this afternoon, I am enclosing herewith your plane ticket for Sunday, April 9th. We had secured a reservation for the 3:06 P.M. flight, which will bring you to New York at 6:34 P.M. Although we were unable to secure priorities, we hope that your flight will be undisturbed so that you may be here on time to address the assembled delegates and guests at the THIRD SEDER and thus encourage them to greater efforts for the Histadrut and the upbuilding of our homeland.

We have already received close to 6,000 reservations coming from many labor and progressive organizations. No single hotel is large enough to accommodate our guests. We will therefore celebrate the Seder simultaneously in three halls. It will be the largest demonstration of Labor Zionism ever held in this country.

We shall make reservations for you at the Hotel Commodore, so that you may be able to remain in New York for Monday. We will then provide you with a return ticket any time you decide to leave.
