



The attached lists indicate that 34 people purchased \$521,000 State of Israel Bonds in 1951. That year a total of \$1,229,750 was deposited.


Obviously, these 34 people sparked this magnificent effort and we would like to invite them to a dinner where we would thank them for having launched this Program.

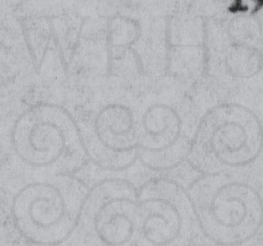


In behalf of all of us concerned with the June 6 Redemption Celebration Dinner, thank you for your generous contribution in time and work that meant so much to the success of this memorable event.
