A Bond can be issued to more than one person. This can be done by joining the names by "AND"; for example, if Bond is made out in the names of "Albert Green AND Ruth Green," they will be joint tenants with right of survivorship. This means that if one dies the other is the complete owner. It is also possible to register Bonds in the form of "Albert Green OR Ruth Green."

It is very important to notice, however, that if Bonds are registered in this alternate form, both Albert Green and Ruth Green must sign the statement set forth below:

The Undersigned agree with each other that the State and the Fiscal Agent may treat either of them, or the survivor, as the sole owner hereof for all purposes and agree to indemnify the State and the Fiscal Agent from all liability resulting therefrom.





Cleveland's Jewish community will celebrate the third anniversary of the founding of its local chapter of "Guardians of Israel" with a "Guardians" dinner for Israel Bonds, honoring Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver, on Thursday, June 21st. The event, to be held at the Hollenden Hotel ballroom, where prominent business, communal and religious leaders of Cleveland will hear an address by the Honorable Abba Eban, Israel's ambassador to the United States.

Mr. Eban is not only his country's Ambassador to the United States, but also serves as Israel's permanent representative to the United States, in whose councils he plays an important role. He first achieved world-wide prominence as official liaison between the Jewish community of Palestine and the United Nations committees which deliberated the Palestine problem in Geneva and at Lake Success. This will be the first appearance of Ambassador Eban in Cleveland.

The announcement of this celebration was made by A. M. Luntz, Chairman of the Guardians' Dinner Committee to honor Rabbi Silver, who asserted: "It is particularly fitting that we pay tribute to Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver, in recognition of the historic contribution which he has made to the establishment of the State of Israel, and his vigorous efforts and leadership in its economic development through the sale of Israel Bonds."

Jack N. Mandel, General Co-Chairman of the Cleveland Israel
Bond Committee, emphasized that the "Guardians" Dinner honoring
Rabbi Silver on Thursday, June 21st, will focus attention on Cleveland's
goal of \$750,000 in Israel Development Bond sales for the first half of
1956. The chairman indicated that special efforts will be made to enroll
new, and re-enlist old, members of the Trustees, Guardians of Israel
and National Sponsors. Those who purchase \$10,000 or more in Israel
Bonds in 1956 are eligible to become Trustees; men and women who purchase \$1,000 or more in Israel Bonds in 1956 become Guardians of Israel
and National Sponsors, respectively.

"During the past eight years, practically every field of endeavor in Israel has been stimulated and encouraged by the flow of Israel Bond investment capital," Mr. David I. Sindell, Cleveland's other Co-Chairman for Israel Bonds, stressed. He cited among the major examples, an increase in annual agricultural production, excluding citriculture, from \$75,800,000 to more than \$180,000,000; in electric power usage from 260,000,000 kilowatt-hours to nearly one billion kilowatt-hours; in annual industrial production from \$226,600 to over \$760,000,000, as well as a rise in the quantity and variety of exports and the development of the country's minerals and ores.
