A Bond can be issued to more than one person. This means that if one dies the other is the complete owner. It is also possible to register Bonds in the form of "Albert Green OR Ruth Green."

It is very important to notice, however, that if Bonds are registered in this alternate form, both Albert Green and Ruth Green must sign the statement set forth below:

The Undersigned agree with each other that the State and the Fiscal Agent may treat either of them, or the survivor, as the sole owner hereof for all purposes and agree to indemnify the State and the Fiscal Agent from all liability resulting therefrom.

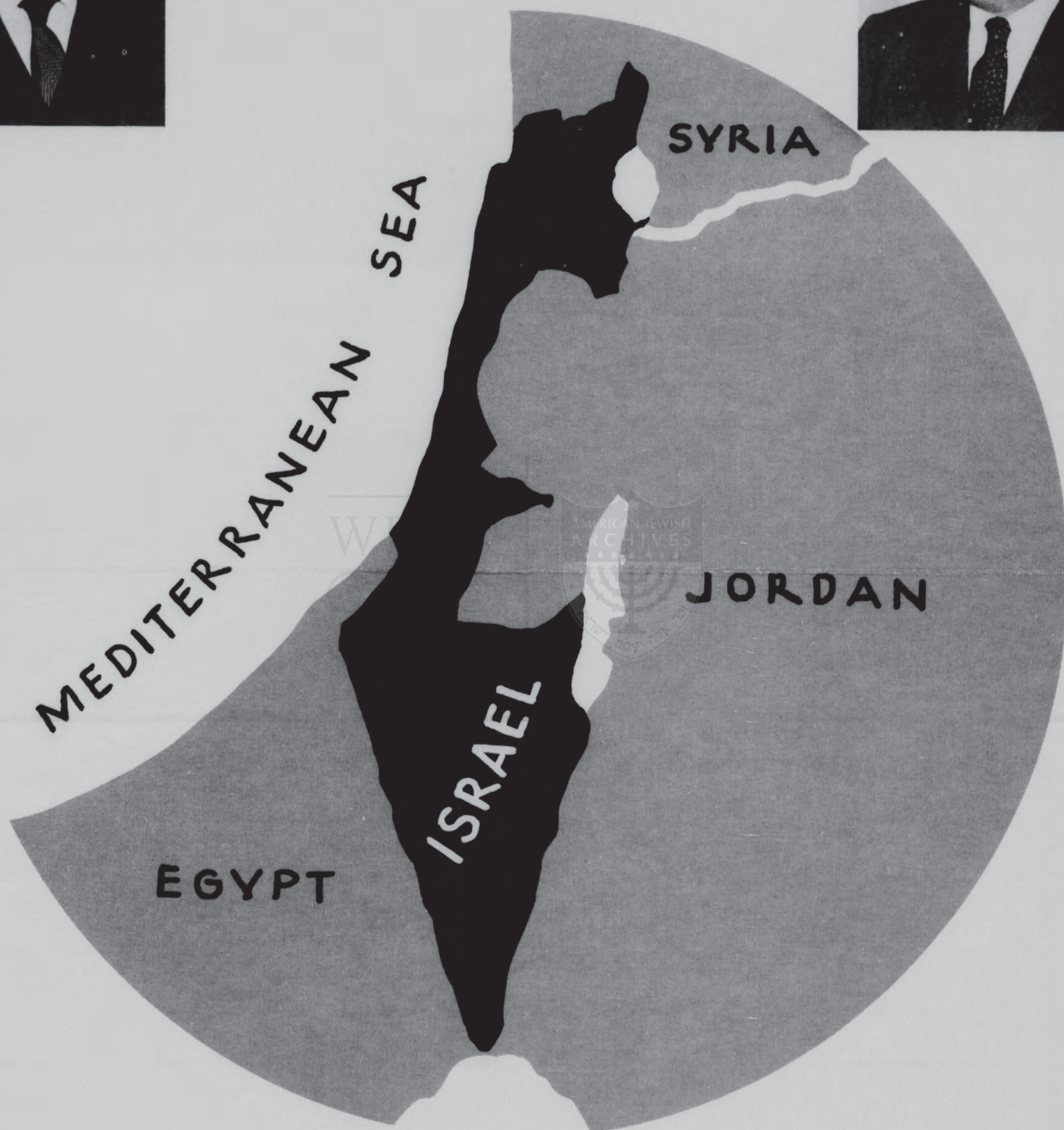

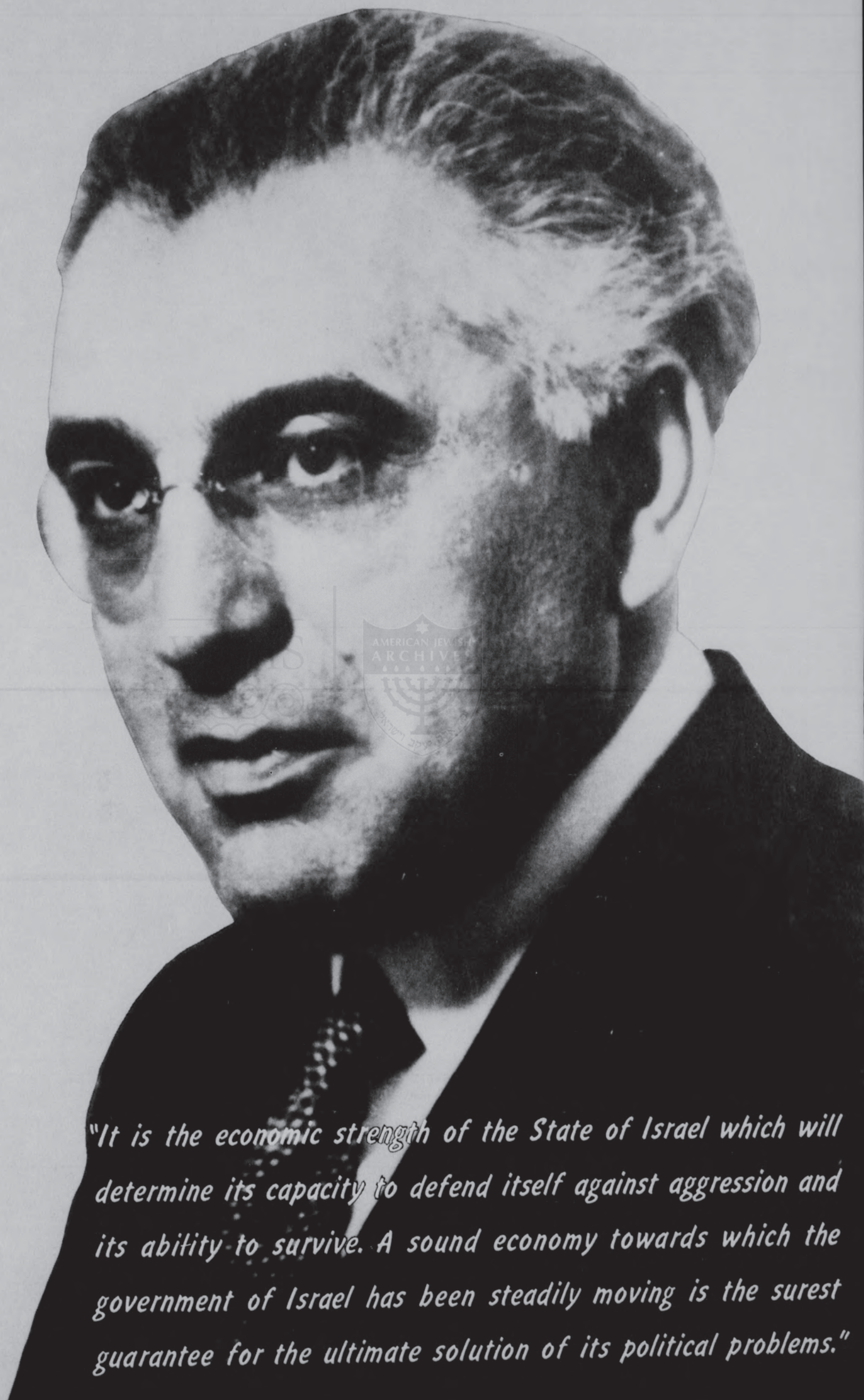

Jack N. Mandel and David I. Sindell have accepted the re-appointment as General Co-Chairmen of the Cleveland Committee for State of Israel Bonds, it was announced today by Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver, National Chairman of the Board of Governors of the Israel Bond Organization.

"Cleveland has made great progress during the past year under the guidance of these two dynamic leaders of our Israel Bond program," Rabbi Silver said. "A sound economy, toward which the Government of Israel has been steadily moving, is the surest guarantee for the ultimate solution of its political problems."

"Whatever support is given to the State of Israel through the purchase of Israel Bonds helps to under-gird its economy and to strengthen the hands of its defenders," the Rabbi continued.

"Cleveland has accepted a quota of \$1,350,000 in State of Israel Bond sales for 1956," the co-chairmen said. "In 1955 our sales showed a 22 per cent increase over the previous year."

"Cleveland must enroll 35 Trustees, (purchasers of \$10,000 or more in Israel Bonds during 1956) 500 "Guardians of Israel", (buyers of \$1,000 or more in Development Bonds) and 250 National Women Sponsors (women bond buyers of \$1,000 during 1956) during the current year to reach our goal."

"As of this moment Cleveland is off to an excellent start with its renewal program. We have received pledges for 10 Trustees for this year to date. We also have renewed 61 "Shomrim" 'Guardians of Israel' and 18 National Women Sponsors.

"Israel Development Bonds," the chairmen continued, "provide the dollars which Israel needs to continue its large-scale program of economic development,

the continued expansion of industries and agriculture, the construction of roads, harbors and railways, the exploration and exploitation of its mineral resources and the further development of its export trade which has already substantially reduced its traditional foreign trade deficit."

In commenting on Dr. Silver's assumption of his new post, Moshe Sharett, Foreign Minister of the State of Israel said:

"I was happy to hear that Dr. Abba Hillel Silver has been named Chairman of the Board of Governors of the Israel Bond Drive. His dynamism

and drive played an outstanding part in the political struggle for the establishment of the State of Israel. As a way of making the approaching High Holy Day season "the occasion for an intensified effort to speed capital for Israel's growth," the Rabbis of Cleveland Jewish Congregations who are holding Appeals for the purchase of Israel Development Bonds during the forthcoming High Holy Days, today issued a joint statement urging the Jews in this community to purchase State of Israel Development Bonds, to give "the people of Israel the means to build a democratic nation."

Joining in the call for Israel Bond purchases during the most solemn Jewish Holy Days of the year were Rabbi Jack Herman of Community Temple, Rabbi Israel Porath of Heights Jewish Center, Rabbi Jacob Muskind of Kinsman Jewish Center, Rabbi Isaak Krisiev of Ohel Jacob Congregation, Rabbi Louis Engelberg of Taylor Road Synagogue, Rabbi Shubert Spero of Young Israel, Rabbi Benjamin Lapidus of Beth Hamedrosh Anshe Galicia, Rabbi Daniel B. Schur of Congregation Oer Chodosh Anshe Sfard, Rabbi Marcus Goldman of the Independent Ahavath Zion Congregation, Rabbi Benjamin Porath of Tetiever Congregation, Rabbi Herschell Saville of the *RABBI Hugo Klein of Boddy Road Synagogue* Marmarasher Congregation and Rabbi Sam Meyer of Audath B'nai Israel in Lorain, Ohio.

Emphasizing that the High Holy Days present the Jews in Cleveland with a unique opportunity to strengthen the democratic ideals with which the history of their religion is identified, the spiritual leaders stated that subscriptions to State of Israel Bonds represent "the application to modern times of principles which have been tested through the ages."

"One of the finest expressions of our spiritual heritage is to be found in the close relationship which we as American Jews have built with our brothers and sisters in the State of Israel. Through our subscriptions to State of Israel Bonds, we are giving the people of Israel the means to build a democratic nation, representing the application to modern times of the principles which have been tested through the ages."

"As the New Year 5716 opens, we can look back on great achievements by Israel with the aid of our Bond investments. The flotation of Israel's new Development Bond Issue presents the opportunity to make certain that these achievements shall be the basis of even greater advances during the coming year."

It is uniquely fitting that we should make the High Holy Day season the occasion for an intensified effort to speed capital for Israel's growth through the Israel Bond drive. Your participation in this effort will give a deeper and more vital meaning to your observance of the most sacred period in our calendar.

Much has been said this evening, wisely said, and I do not wish to repeat what has already been said.

This hour I look upon as an hour of maximum mobilization on the part of American Jewry, maximum economic mobilization and, equally important, maximum political mobilization.

If we are to insure the uninterrupted progress of the State which we helped to create and if we are to defend it we must look upon it as such.

We all followed with keen interest, and I must say, with a measure of apprehension the discussions which took place quite recently in Washington between the Prime Minister of Great Britain and the Chief Executive and the Secretary of State of our own beloved country, touching many world problems but especially the problem which everyone seems to agree is at the moment the most pressing, potentially the most dangerous problem on the international scene.

I do not know what transpired at these conferences, what agreements were reached, what decisions were arrived at, but I do hope that those who participated in these very solemn deliberations asked themselves some very searching questions, some very sober, penetrating questions, and tried honestly to arrive at their correct answers; for this is the moment for farseeing statesmanship, not for the servants of expediency.

The free world as we see it is engaged in a prolonged historic struggle which will last, I believe, decades, the struggle between freedom and forms of human slavery, between the dignity and the sovereign stature of man and his subservience to the forms of mass or collective control. This struggle which has been developing for quite a number of years will not find an early or quick solution. It might take generations before that formula is finally discovered which will enable both sections of the world to live in peace on the same globe.

In this prolonged historic struggle the question that statesmanship ought to ask itself, especially now that the Near East has become the focal point of its attention, who will be the gainer if Israel is weakened or destroyed, who will defend the interests of the free world or who can be relied upon to defend not alone the interests of a democratic society, what we choose to call the American way of life, who can be relied upon to defend these sacred concepts of our free society in that part of the world?

Will those nations who quite recently supported the Axis powers, the forces of Fascism and Nazism, who sabotaged the Allied war effort on every occasion, who were pro-Vichy, who when they did help on rare occasions yielded their help only in those instances where force could compel or money could buy -- can these people be looked upon as the dependable bulwark when the hour of decision arrives?

Is it Egypt which but recently opened the doors for Communist penetration into the Middle East and brought about an almost total collapse of the policies of the free world in that region of the globe? Is that country to be looked upon as the citadel of defense of the free world? Are these nations who have constantly played and to this day are playing off the East against the West in a shameless game of diplomatic blackmail, -- are these nations to be depended upon by the free world?

Can the free world afford to undermine the relative defense potential of the one dependable free democratic people in that entire part of the world, whose democracy is not a matter of a phrase written in an official document or is part of propaganda, but whose democracy is rooted in the life and society of its people, its faith, its history, its experience born of its blood, born of its flesh?

Can the free world afford, in this period of trial which shall continue for years and decades to come, to undermine the strength of this one dependable outpost of freedom, to weaken it, to isolate it in a menacing world?

I think that is a fair question, and farseeing statesmanship should not only see the surface of things but look into the heart of things. We are thinking in terms of historic perspective when demanding that these leaders of the free world ought to ask themselves quite forthrightly and ought to give an honest and correct answer to this question.

There is another question which they should ask themselves. The free world rightly or wrongly has been trying to build a ring of steel across the northern frontier of the Middle East as a defense against possible Soviet aggression, but it is relying upon the Arab States to be the chief link in that ring of steel. Unfortunately, these Arab States are forging a ring of steel of their own which is not at all aimed against the Soviet bloc but is aimed devotedly and confessedly and arrogantly proclaimed over and over again against Israel.

They are not interested in any military alliance against the Soviet. They rioted in Jordan because of the Baghdad Pact. There is a sharp difference of opinion and a sharp difference of objectives which creates inner contradictions which will make action at a decisive moment impossible.

One is looking toward one front and one is looking towards another front altogether. Who is using whom? Is it not clear that this first disillusionment which the Western World had with Egypt on the occasion of the purchase of vast arms from Czechoslovakia is not likely to be the last disillusionment and the last humiliation?

This calculated flirtation with the Soviet bloc is likely to go on because it pays handsome dividends to the Arab States who are playing it.

Egypt is not a democracy. Its recent Constitution clearly proves that. It is a dictatorship and dictatorships must in the last analysis find their support and strength in programs of expansionist adventures and in gaining prestige through military enterprises, successful, of course, military enterprises.

They are committed to no loyalty to the democratic world. They are committed to no humanitarian principles.

Is it upon these that the free world in its terrific struggle which confronts it intends to rely? Mr. Eden, never a great friend of Israel, would like to bring about peace in that part of the world because everybody wants peace in that part of the world, everyone in the free world, the Western world.

He would like to bring about peace in that part of the world by major concessions to the Arabs, not concessions made by Great Britain, mind you, but concessions to be made by the little State of Israel.

He is doing today or is trying to do today what one of his predecessors so tragically succeeded in doing in the case of Munich. "Why pressure Czechoslovakie to yield just a small part of its territory to the Sudetenland? Give it to the Nazis and we will have peace then in our lifetime." The Sudetenland was given to the Nazis, but there was no peace in our lifetime. The Nazis took over the whole of Czechoslovakia. They were not content with Czechoslovakia alone, and before long the whole world was plunged into the Second World War.

The Arabs do not need additional territory. My goodness, one million and a half to two million square miles of uninhabited land can be, through irrigation and through the application of modern agricultural methods, turned into land which would support ten times the present population of the Arab world.

They don't need a thousand square miles or five hundred square miles of additional territory carved out and by this process of carving, crippling the little State of Israel which has already been subjected to two partitions.

In 1922 three-fourths of the territory of Palestine, which was included in the terms of the Balfour Declaration, was cut away from the Jewish National Homeland

and by the terms of the action of the United Nations what remained was again partitioned and what is left is a little country which needs every inch of its territory, which is struggling desperately hard to convert every foot of land into productivity in order to support an increase in population.

The Arabs need to be helped, economically helped to develop their land to raise their standard of living and their statemanship, if they have men of vision and statesmanship ought to apply themselves to that task, how to make their country productive, how to lift the curse of poverty and misery and disease and illiteracy from their exploited people.

No, the needs of the Arabs will not be satisfied in any way, nor will the Arabs be helped in any way by territorial concessions to the part of Israel

The mistake of Munich may be repeated. I hope it will not be. The mistake of Spain may be repeated, and I hope that it will not be.

It was the free world, it was the United States and England and France who, you will recall in the days when the Fascist powers of Franco threatened the Spanish Republic, put down an embargo on arms so that the free Republic of Spain could not acquire arms to defend itself, while Hitler sent his airplanes and Mussolini sent his arms into Spain, and the Spanish Republic was strangled through the embargo placed on arms by the free world: and that was the prelude to the Second World War, that fed the appetites of the Nazis and the Fascists, that told them that they could outsmart the Western world and have it their own way.

I am wondering whether that mistake may not be repeated with equally disastrous results because there are no little wars any more in the world today, my good friends. There are no little wars. A little war embroils the whole world. I therefore say that this hour is an hour of maximum mobilization for the Jews of America.

I don't know whether you have been reading ex-President Truman's Memoirs which have been appearing in the New York Times and Life Magazine in recent weeks. I have read them with great interest, especially those parts which relate to the events which led up to the Proclamation of the State of Israel in which he played a great role.

The Israeli and the Jewish people throughout the world will forever be grateful to Mr. Truman for the tremendous help which he gave to their cause in the decisive hour and for having been a consistent friend of the State of Israel ever since.

Mr. Truman refers in his Memoirs rather deprecatorily to that he calls the extreme Zionists. I don't know what he means by extreme Zionists. Presumably the reference is to those Zionists who worked for the establishment of an independent Jewish State, who urged our Government to assist in this work and to grant recognition to the State of Israel once it was established.

This is extreme Zionism. Beyond that there is no Zionism. The State of Israel was established and our Government did recognize. In fact, it was Mr. Truman himself who as President of the United States gave the first recognition to the new State, but in so doing Mr. Truman clearly endorsed the position taken by those whom he now calls extreme Zionists.

What was extreme about these Zionists? It was their unrelenting persistence and unflagging efforts without which their cause might never have succeeded.

Mr. Truman also calls attention in these Memoirs to the fact that the specialists on the Near East -- he calls them that -- in our State Department were "... almost without exception unfriendly to the idea of a Jewish State." That is his own State Department. He said he is sorry to report "... that there were some among them who were also inclined to be anti-Semitic and that they almost succeeded in putting it over" on him.

When we told the same thing to Mr. Truman when he was President of the United States, why, he said it couldn't be, that we are maligning these people in the State Department. They responsible Zionist leaders suspected this along. They knew the powerful forces which were lined up against them and the extent to which they would go to defeat the great moral force which had received the endorsement of both political parties of our country and which was overwhelmingly approved by the American people.

That is why we had to assert ourselves unflinchingly and relentlessly in our efforts to achieve what we had to achieve. That is why we were extreme when under pressure from the same sources our Government reversed itself in March, 1948, a few months after the United Nations had voted the partition scheme which involved the establishment of an independent Jewish State. When our Government, under the Presidency of Mr. Truman, reversed itself in March of 1948 and requested a special session of the Assembly of the United Nations in order to impose what they called, in those days, a temporary trusteeship of Palestine, it was these same extreme Zionists who, by their redoubled efforts and powerful appeal to the citizens of our country, averted what might have become a major political disaster and brought the policy of the Truman administration back to its sound and just cause.

Why am I saying this at this time? Because our State Department at the present time still harbors the same specialists and they are still almost without exception unfriendly to the idea of a Jewish State, even though the Jewish state is now in existence.

And I am afraid, I don't know but I suspect and I have a nose for these suspicions, that these same people are trying to put it over on the President of the United States today and on the Secretary of State.

Therefore, there is a call today for extreme Zionists, good Americans but also extreme Zionists. The State of Israel was established in spite of the unfriendly attitude of these people in Government, in spite of the violent opposition and sabotage of Great Britain and the armed attacks of the Arab Governments, and I am strongly of the belief that the State of Israel which is soon to celebrate its Eighth Anniversary will, in spite of the present continuing opposition and conspiracies, continue to grow and prosper.

Its people are firm in their moral integrity and in their resolve to defend themselves and their country. They are steadily building for strength and for security while at all times seeking the ways of peace. They are learning that it is very difficult for a young country to learn that which must be learned: how to exercise maximum restraint in the face of constant provocation, and how to keep on building, to keep on building under the most severe threats and dangers.

There is a beautiful sentence in our Book of Psalms: "Much have they afflicted me from my youth, saith Israel, but they will not prevail against me."

I want to close with this word, my good friends. The speaker who preceded me referred to the correct fact that Israel has never defaulted on any of its financial obligations. I am thinking in larger terms. Israel has not defaulted on any of its historic promises. Israel has made good on all of its pledges. Israel said that if given the powers of a free and independent Government they would empty the concentration camps of Europe and bring forth from the ten thousand hells of Hitler's Europe the broken and the beaten of our people, bring them into Israel and give them a new life and a new home -- that was its pledge made to the world -- and in seven short years, in spite of economic difficulties, it did empty those camps, it did open its doors and invited all those upon whose backs the plow of terror and hate and persecution has passed, to come into a new home, a haven, a sanctuary.

The young State of Israel said, if given an opportunity, to build a free and democratic country, and it has not defaulted, it has built one of the loveliest and

the finest democratic societies in the world today. The State of Israel said to us: "Once we are established something miraculous will happen to the status of the Jews the world over, something real, even if not palpable, that somehow the pail of the galuth will be lifted from the hearts and spirits of our people everywhere, that a new dignity and a new confidence and a new self-respect and a new joy of living will come to the Jews everywhere, and that our youths and our sons and daughters will be able to face the world quite differently than their forefathers had been able to face the world in thousands of years."

Israel has not defaulted in that promise. This is a new people seven years after the establishment of the State of Israel and, my good friends, this people in Israel, this people throughout the world, one people indivisible, will not permit these conspirators, these adventurers, these dictators to undo what we have done in such a short time.

What kind of a people do they think we are? We will put our hands to the plow. We will follow it through down to the end. We have not built a state for seven years. We have built a state forever.

Why am I so confident? Only because I know the Jews in Israel, the quality of their life, their spirit which is so beautifully spoken of by the representatives of the Government of Israel who spoke so eloquently here this evening, not only because I know them, their youth and their old, but because I know the 5,000,000 Jews in America. I lived among them. I worked among them. I worked with them during the months of crisis. I know how they rise to the challenge of a great hour, and with what generosity they pour out their substance, their generosity, their loyalty because they know what is involved, and because I know the Jews of the world and I know their history and I know their pride, their indefatigable pride and their stiff-neckedness in the face of unfair opposition.

I know that they will rise at this hour which is a grave hour, not a desperate hour. I don't want you to feel that Israel is facing at the moment life or death. It is facing a grave crisis which many young states have to face, a serious crisis but still with intelligence, with devotion, with economic aid which is all-important, because in the last analysis the capacity of the young State will depend upon its economic power to defend itself, its resources, -- if we marshal and mobilize all that we have in our minds, in our souls and in our possessions at this hour, and if we exercise our rights as free citizens in a free democracy to make our voice heard in the councils of the governments, who should listen -- I am quite sure that Israel

will come through the grave menace of hits hour and come through tempered by fire and stronger to carry on its great purpose in history. For in that regard I am a mystic about Israel, I am strongly of the faith, - though I do not know - that some day these free people with their ancient historic site and scene, that is a challenge to their greatness, these people who have brought from their Old World such a determination to make good, to vindicate themselves and their people in the eyes of the world, to link up again with the great historic Zion that came forth in the world of law and out of Jerusalem, -- that these people may again be a banner and a light, a guidance to the world.

That is my faith, good friends, and I draw great inspiration and confidence when I see an assembly of this kind, American Jews of their own free will gathered. Gathered to what purpose? Gathered here to seek through and to complete a great historic enterprise, to make the young State of Israel secure in the world.

At a Dinner Cabinet meeting held at The Temple on September 4th,
David N. Myers, Chairman, announced that the cabinet has set a goal
of \$250,000 in the sale of Israel Bonds. In making the announcement,
Mr. Myers said, "We already have \$60,000 sold and we are anticipating
that our goal of a quarter-of-a-million dollars for Israel will be
reached long before the dinner itself."

Rabbi Silver addressed the cabinet members and recalled his
recent visit to Israel where he observed firsthand the achievements
that have been made with the help of the Israel Bond dollars. "I
was told at that time," he stated, "that there is a possibility
Israel may become economically self-sufficient in three years.
When this happens, it will have occurred through the assistance
provided by Israel Bonds."

Rabbi Silver said that since the inception of the Israel Bond
program in 1951 the congregations have been playing an ever-increasing
role in mobilizing support for the Bond effort. In Cleveland, the
congregational participation now provides more than half of the
yearly goals.


Dear Rabbi Silver:
